HAPPINESS CARDS



1. Write a friendly message on the back of a Happiness Card and fold it in half.

2. Thread a bracelet through the slot so the beads and charms are shown on the front of the card. Fold up the rest of the bracelet and use a sticker to hold it to the inside of the card

3. Fold the card and use a sticker to hold it together.



When you are finished, share them with your friends, family and anyone who needs an extra boost of kindness and positivity.

FRIENDSHIP BRACELETS

Spread a little HAPPY with hand-crafted friendship bracelets! Featuring colorful cord, sweet charms, 2 secret message lockets, and happy notes to share with friends.

USING THE RAINBOW



1. Place the rainbow between your knees so the sun is up and the cloud is down.

2. Place the loop of the bracelet into one of the slots between the sun rays. The strings will fit snugly at first. After repeat use, the strings will be easier to insert.

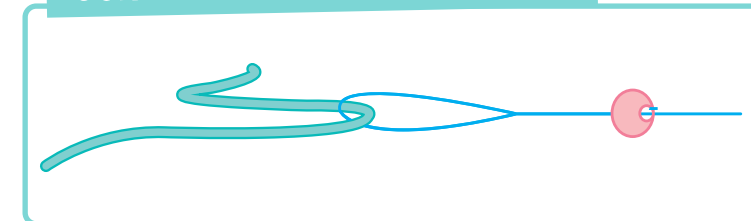
3. Hold the thread in your hands and braid.

DISPLAY



Add a thread to the top of the Rainbow Displayer to hang. Add your finished bracelets to the slots between the sun rays and cloud bumps.

USING THE BEAD THREADER



Use the bead threader to pull threads through a bead, charm, clasp or locket.

NOTE: You can tie a knot in the thread so the bead doesn't fall off. If braiding beads on, do not tie a knot, continuing to braid will keep the bead on.

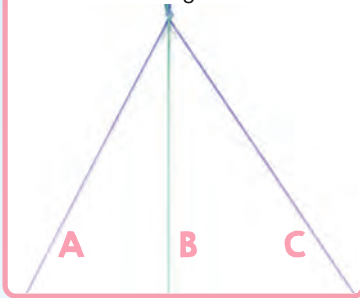
BEAUTIFUL BRAIDS



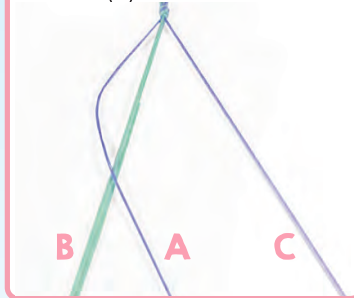
BASIC BRAID

Choose 2 colors of thread and fold each in half. Tie together to create a loop at the fold. Slide the loop side into the Rainbow Maker.

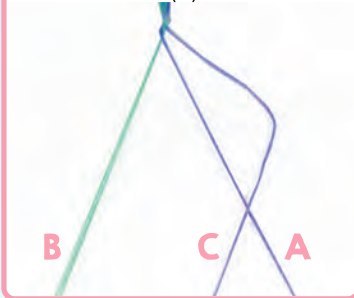
1. Separate your thread into thirds, so the 2 middle threads will need to be gathered.



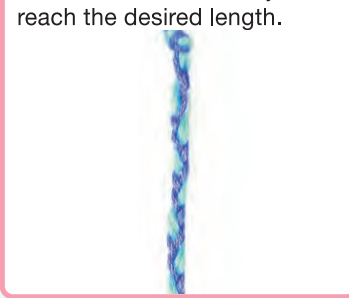
1. Take the left thread (A) and place it over the now center threads (B)



2. Take the right thread (C) and place it over the now center thread (A)



3. Continue this pattern placing the outer threads over the center thread, until you reach the desired length.



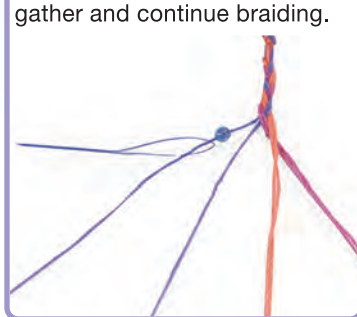
Tie a knot to secure the threads.

BEADED BRAID

1. Follow the steps above to start a basic braid.



2. Use the bead threader to add an accent bead to one strand, gather and continue braiding.



3. Keep braiding and beading until the design reaches around your wrist. Tie a knot to secure the threads.



ROPE BRAID

Follow the steps for the basic braid, but use 4 threads instead of 2. Fold the 4 threads in half and tie a loop at the fold.

1. Put 4 threads in the middle and 2 threads on each side.



2. Do a basic braid until you reach a length that goes around your wrist comfortably.



3. Tie a knot to secure the threads.



TRY THIS!

Follow the instructions for the rope braid but use 5 threads. Then put 8 threads in the middle and 1 thread on each side.

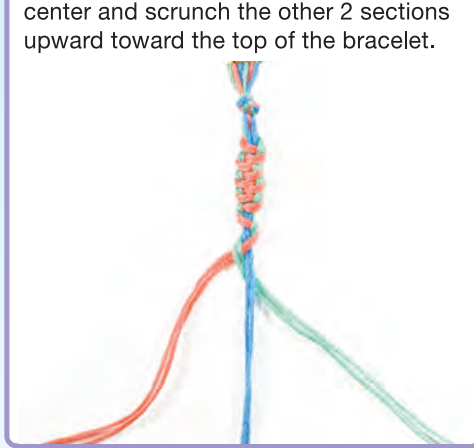
SCRUNCHY BRAID

Choose 3 threads. Fold in half and tie a loop. Slide the loop side into the Rainbow Maker. Separate your thread into thirds.

1. Do a basic braid. Do not pull the threads too tight.

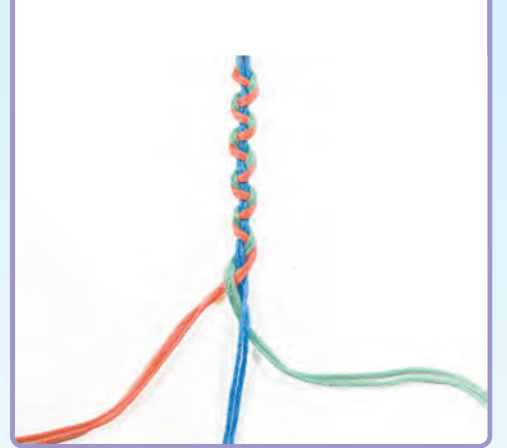


2. Once the braid is long enough to go around your wrist, hold 2 threads in the center and scrunch the other 2 sections upward toward the top of the bracelet.



PRO - TIP: Keep the scrunch loops equal on both sides for the best look!

3. Pull the scrunch down until you get the look you want.



4. Continue the basic braid and scrunch until the design is long enough to fit around your wrist. Tie a knot to secure the thread ends as shown.



ACCESSORIZE

BEADS, CHARMS, LOCKETS, AND CLASPS

1. Using the threader, add beads, charms, lockets or clasps to the loose threads. Double knot the threads so they stay on tight.

2. Ready to wear? Hook the clasp onto the loop as shown. You can also feed a charm or beads through the top loop. Ask an adult or older friend if you need help. **Helpful Hint:** Add a drop of glue to the knots to keep them from unraveling.

3. Best Friends Forever? Some people like to tie the bracelet directly onto their wrist. To do this, tie the threads onto the loop.
