#### Upland Pinot Noir

Our 2019 Upland Pinot Noir is wild in nature with primordial tactility and rings heavy with dark *funky bass music*.

With a mild, slightly warm start to the 2019 growing season, bloom occurred June 7th followed by a good fruit set. Rains began in late June and continued into July. August provided a break with warm sunny days. September arrived with cooler temperatures and more rain. Cool wet weather continued into October. This cooler harvest allowed fully ripe fruit at 21 brix and a perfect amount of acid.

#### OUR VINEYARD

Nestled in the eastern foothills of Oregon's Coastal Range, on the wild western edge of the Yamhill-Carlton AVA, the range's peaks to the west and south buffer maritime winds and rain from the Pacific Ocean, creating a more temperate growing season distinct from neighboring vineyard sites. Planted in 2005-2006 to Pinot Noir and Chardonnay Dijon clones, the I94-acre vineyard perches in thin marine sedimentary soils, and diversity of block exposures and elevation offer a diverse palette for our farming and winemaking team.
