Rock Snakes are a fun collaborative art project. Perfect for families, schools, local parks or your own neighborhood.

The Glow in the Dark rock snake kit comes with 20 rocks, transfers, sponges, weather resistant paint, glow-in-the dark paint, and paint brushes.

Getting Started

You will need scissors, paper towels and a cup of water. Cover your work surface with paper towels. This paint may stain. Wear old clothes and clean up any spills while the paint is still wet. Paint can separate over time. Mix each color before you begin. Before changing colors, rinse and dry your brush. Formed by nature, each rock has its own unique shape. Look at your rocks and let the shape inspire your creativity.

Paint

- For better coverage, add a layer of white paint first.
- To deepen colors, add an extra coat of paint.
- Allow the paint to dry between coats.

Pro Tip:

Use the handle of your paint brush to make dots or small areas.

Applying Transfers

Make sure the paint is completely dry before applying a transfer. You can also use the transfers directly on the bare rock.

- 1. Cut transfer to fit rock, cut excess paper.
- 2. Peel off clear film. Place the picture side down on rock.
- 3. With a wet sponge press the back of the transfer against rock
- 4. Peel the corner to make sure the design is adhered. If not, use a bit more water.



Add Glow Paint

When the paint and transfers are dry, add fun glowing accents to your rock snake.

Display

Once the glow paint is dry, it's time to line them up to create your own rock snake. Continue to add more painted rocks to grow your snake!
