

## 2023 PINOT NOIR

RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY

Jackson Estate wines showcase our cherished vineyard estate properties located on rare, coastal California terroir of mountain tops, ridges, hillsides and raised benchland soils. This limited release allows our winemakers to emphasize the extraordinary terroir of our unique properties and craft very small lots for refined palates.

## **THREE VISTAS**

This estate overlooks the original Trace, or Settler's path, linking Sonoma County to Lake County. The Russian River Valley AVA is one of the world's premier wine-growing regions. A unique element of the area is the Pacific Ocean's maritime influence, which moderates the warm days of the growing season allowing grapes to ripen and develop slowly. The unique weather patterns combined with a diversity of well-draining soils make the appellation well suited to produce cool-climate Chardonnay and Pinot Noir.

## **KEY POINTS**

Elevation: 100 - 150 feet

Soil: Fine Yolo silt and clay loam, over alluvial riverbeds.

Climate: Cool, foggy mornings lead into warm afternoons, allowing the grapes to fully develop their flavors over a

long growing season.

**Profile:** Aromas of red and black fruit show through on the nose, with a concentrated, well-balanced palate loaded with strawberries, blackberries, and a touch of vanilla rounded out out by silky tannins and a long, lush finish.
