#### TOOLS REQUIRED

Allen Wrench

### **Installation Steps:**

- 1. Remove the old overflow trim with an Allen wrench. Insert Allen wrench inside the rectangular hole then slowly pull the overflow trim on its left and right corner of the rectangular hole.
- 2. After the old overflow trim is removed from the tub, clean the surface around the overflow hole with a damp cloth.
- 3. Insert the new overflow trim onto the tub. Slowly and carefully push it all the way inside and make sure it fits tightly.
