Sensery Bin BAKE SHOP

Enjoy hours of imaginative play! Create and decorate play & pretend treats in your sensory bin.

CARE AND SAFETY

- · To keep the sensory bin clean, wash hands before use.
- · Children should be supervised during play not suitable for children under 3.
- Prepare the area under the bin with a towel or table cover to collect any spills.
- · Dough is not edible. Do not eat or place in eyes, nose or mouth.
- · Wash the accessories as needed with warm soapy water.

IMPORTANT: How do I make my dough last longer?

- Always put dough in the sealed bag after play. Squeeze air out and zip up the bag completely.
 When exposed to air, the dough will eventually dry out and harden.
- · Keep the sensory bin closed when not in use.
- Additional dough may be found at a craft store or an online store that you trust.

Assemble

Start by decorating the bin sides with the colorful clings. It is best to add these before you play with the dough. **Note:** If you are having a hard time rearranging the clings later, wipe down the clings and bin sides with a damp cloth to remove dough residue.

Next, empty some or all of the scented dough into the bin. Arrange all other items in the bin. Children may need help arranging the clings and opening the dough.



Play!

Roll, shape and decorate! Have fun making batches of cookies and cakes using the rolling pin and cookie cutters. Add accents by squishing small amounts of dough into the mold and pressing them onto your cookies. Top off your treats with pom pom sprinkles and frosting decorations.

Note to Parents - Playing with the dough and tools in this kit is a calming sensory activity that helps your child practice fine motor skills and hand-eye coordination.





Fun things to try:

- · Count the items inside the bin.
- · Name each yummy treat on the clings.
- · Make up a story about what you are baking in your bake shop.
- · What happens when you mix the blue and pink dough?



- · Memory game: Parents Remove a tool from the bin. Have your child guess what is missing.
- Close your eyes and grab an item from the bin. See if you can identify it using your sense of touch.
- Smell each dough color what do they smell like? Each dough has a different fruity scent!
