WALL MOUNTING ASSEMBLY

For added safety and stability, it is recommended that the wall mounting hardware be installed. For safe mounting, it is essential to use wall anchors appropriate to your wall type (i.e. plaster, drywall, concrete, etc.). Mount to wood studs whenever possible.

Use a 1/4"(6.5mm) drill bit to pilot the hole. If mounting to plaster, wood panels, brick or other drywall please consult a qualified professional.

Please make sure you use the right hardware for your wall type for your safety.










Do not drill an oversized hole or the wall anchor will not hold tightly into the wall.

Tap wall anchor into hole.

Secure product to wall with screw "E" through Plastic strap and into wall anchor.
