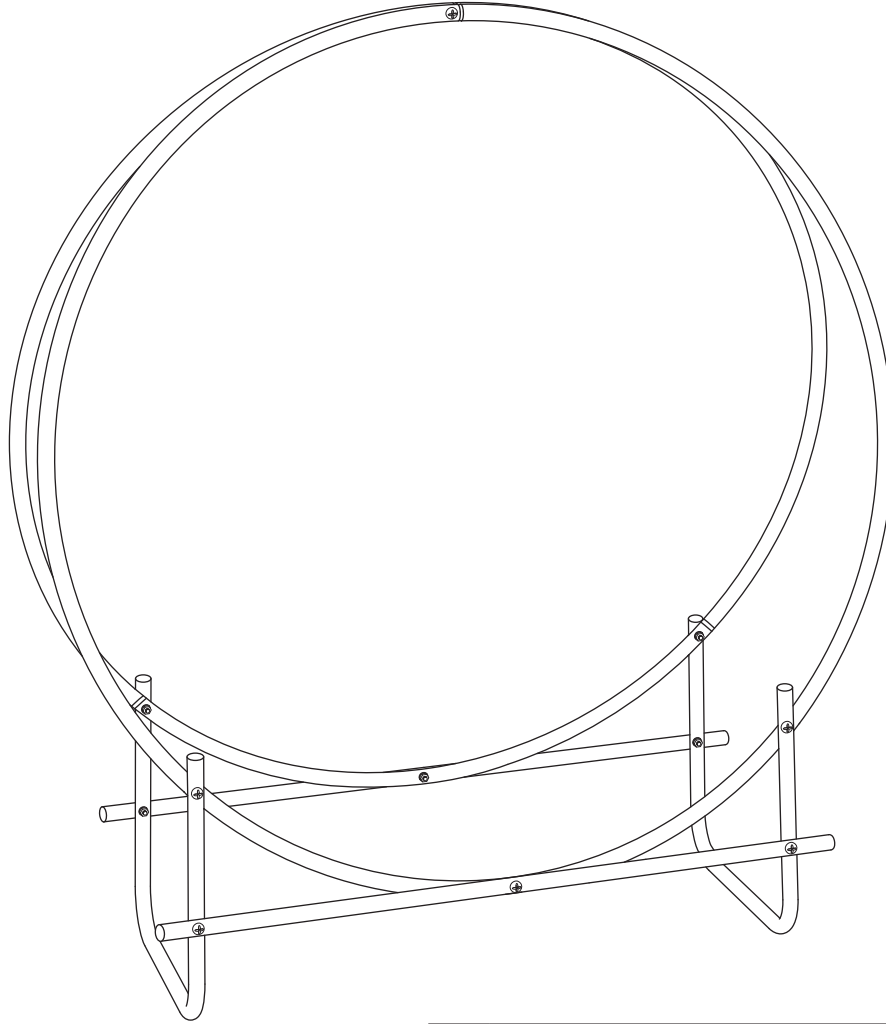








LOG HOOP

Review all assembly and care information carefully before using this product. Save this manual for future reference.
Assemble components on a soft, clean surface to avoid damaging the finish.



Inspect packaging to ensure all parts are accounted for before disposing of packing materials.
Save the packing slip.

ASSEMBLY

Review all steps and understand assembly before beginning.

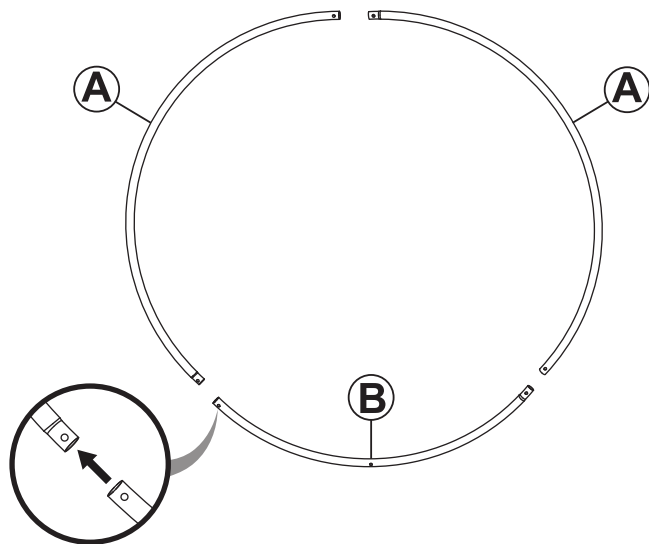
Do not fully tighten hardware until all components have been loosely assembled.

STEP 1

A: 4

B: 2

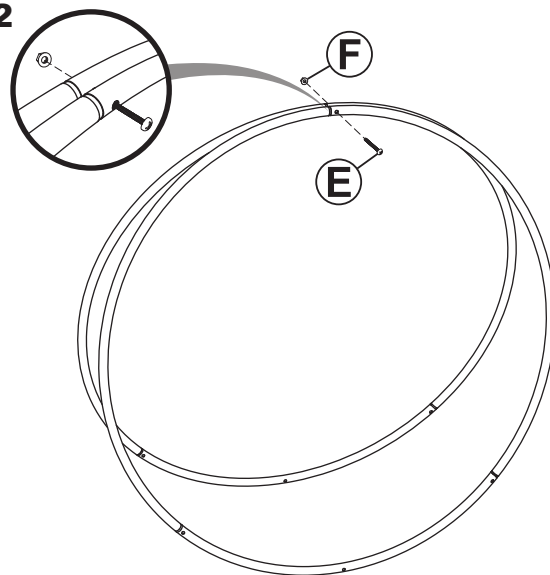
Align the mounting holes of two Upper Tubes (A) with one Lower Tube (B).

Repeat with the remaining upper and lower tubes.

STEP 2

E: 1

F: 1



NOTE: The top of each log hoop has one mounting hole, the bottom of the log hoop has 3 holes.

Loosely secure the top of the assembled tubes using one M6x37mm Bolt (E) and one Flange Nut (F).

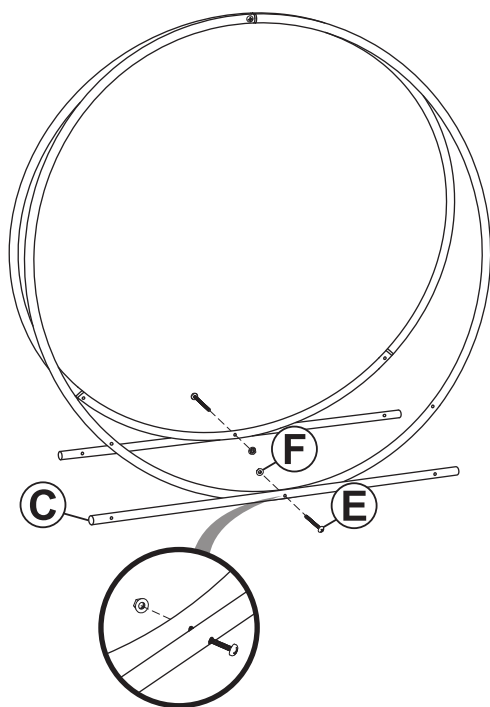
Do not fully tighten hardware until after Step 4 is completed.

STEP 3

C: 2

E: 2

F: 2



Loosely secure two Stretchers (C) to bottom, outer side of each log hoop using Bolts (E) and Nuts (F), as shown.

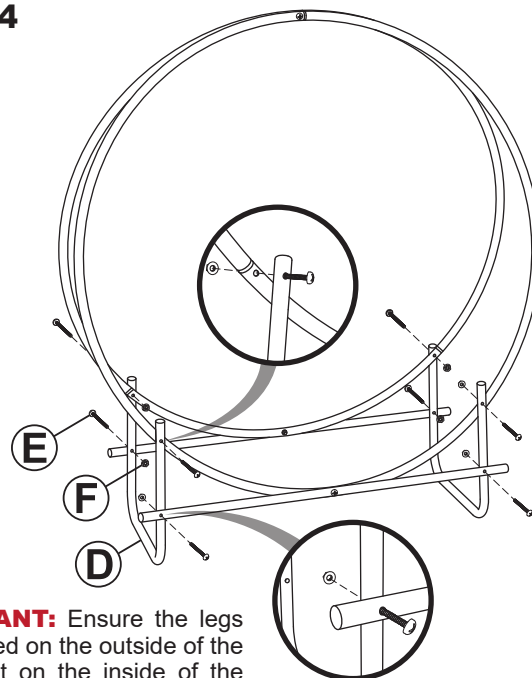
Do not fully tighten hardware until after Step 4 is completed.

STEP 4

D: 2

E: 8

F: 8



IMPORTANT: Ensure the legs are installed on the outside of the hoops, but on the inside of the stretchers, as shown.

Align Legs (D) with the hoops and stretchers and loosely secure using four Bolts (E) and Nuts (F).

Repeat to secure the remaining leg.

Fully tighten all hardware after this step is complete.

Care & Maintenance

SAFE USE: Only use on a flat, level surface.

INSPECT: Periodically check assembly points and tighten fittings as necessary.

CLEANING: Use a damp cloth to clean. Do not use abrasive cleaners as doing so may cause parts to tarnish or rust.

SAFETY STATEMENTS & WARNINGS

- Place log rack on a hard, dry surface.
- Do not overload the log rack.
- Ensure fittings are tight before use. Periodically check and tighten hardware as necessary.
- Protect the unit from outdoor elements with a cover. Cover not included.
- Do not allow children to play with or around the log rack.

Any modification to the product or failure to follow recommended care will void the product warranty.
