ASSEMBLY&INSTALLATION

Please read carefully and save these instructions, as you may need them a later date.

CAUTION

Turn off the main power at the circuit breaker before installing the fixture, in order to prevent possible shock.

GENERAL


All electrical connections must be in accordance with local and National Electrical Code(N.E.C) standards. If you are unfamiliar with proper electrical wiring connections obtain the services of a qualified electrician.

Remove the fixture and the mounting package from the box and make sure that no parts are missing by referencing the illustrations on the installation instructions.

ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION

- 1. Carefully unpack the fixture, lay out all parts on a clean surface.
- 2. Thread column (14) to the nipple of the fixture (15). Connect the stems (13) (12)(11) (depending on desired height). Attach them to the nipple on the top of the column (14), then thread the stem into the swivel (11).
- 3. Attach mounting plate (7) to outlet box (1) using two outlet box screws (10).
- 4. Pull out the outlet wire and ground wire from the outlet box, make wire connections with wire nut (6) as follow:
 - --Connect the smooth-coated wire (marking) or Black wire from fixture to the Black wire (3) from power source.
 - -- Connect the ribbed-coated wire (w/o marking) or White wire from fixture to the White wire (2) from power source.
 - --Attach the fixture ground wire to mounting plate (7) with the ground screw (8). Connect it to the house ground wire (4) with the wire nut (6).
- 5. Align the fixture canopy to the outlet box (1), then secure it to the mounting plate (7) with the mounting screws (5).
- 6. Install the bulbs (not included). Make sure they do not exceed the maximum wattage specified on the fixture's wattage rating label.
- 7. Turn on the power.
