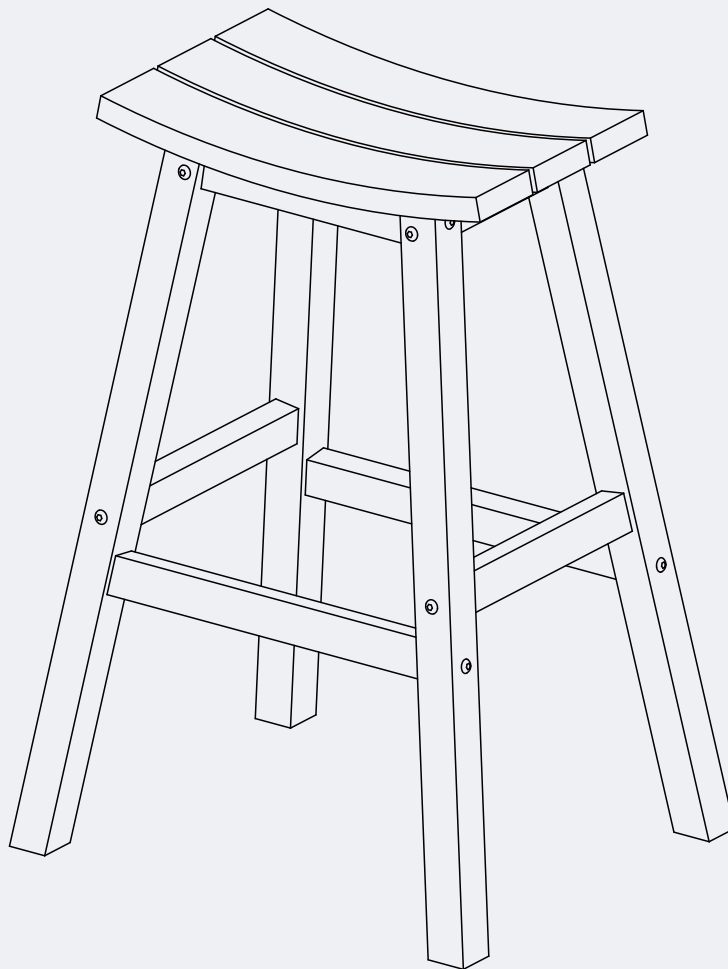

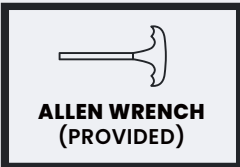

! CARE & MAINTENANCE

Do not overtighten screws. (Insert all screws before tighten screws.)

- Please do not exceed the weight limitations of this item.
- Do not stand on or use any part of this item as a step ladder
- Firmly secure all bolts, screws and nuts before use.
- Reconfirm that all bolts, screws, and nuts are secure every 90 days.
- Do not use or store this item in the proximity of open flame or flammable/combustible chemicals.
- Be aware that some parts are heavy and have sharp edges.

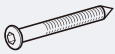

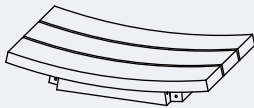

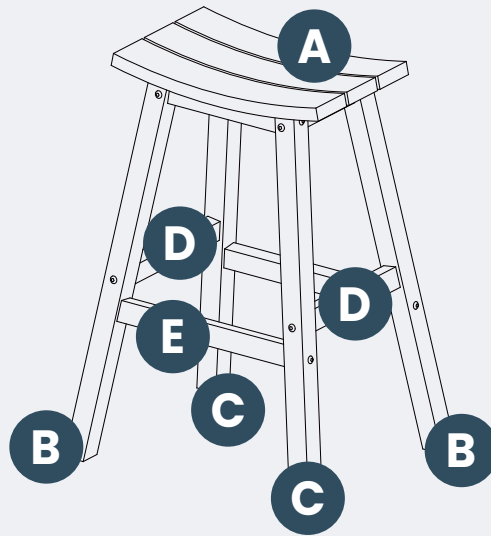

PRODUCT ASSEMBLY – OVERALL VIEW

Look at following overall view of this stool and exact position of each parts to be assembled.

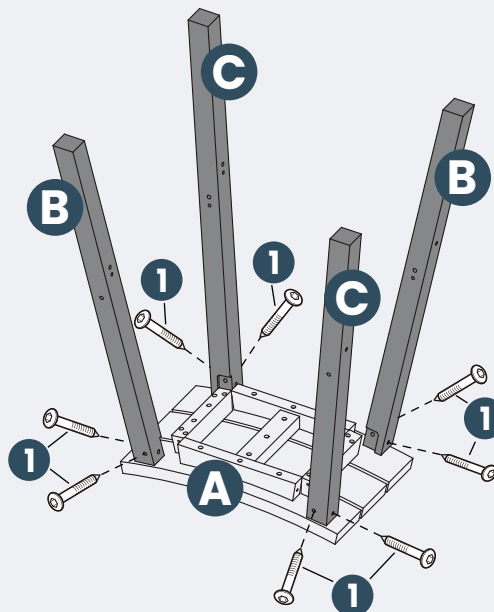


PRODUCT ASSEMBLY

1

Attach **Part B & C Stool Legs** to **Part A Saddle** with 8 pcs of **Hardware #1 Bolt**.

Do not tighten screws too much at this step.

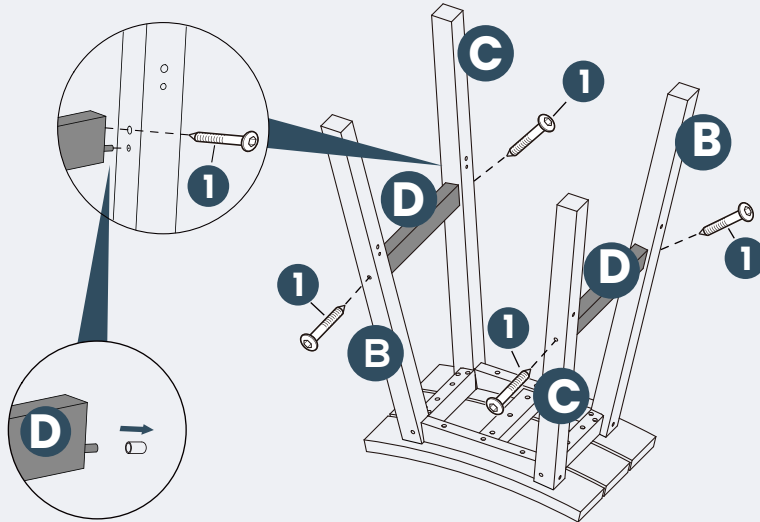


PRODUCT ASSEMBLY

2

Remove the cap from the safety pin before you fix the **Part D Short Rail** to **Part B & C Stool Legs**.

Attach **Part D Short Rail** to **Part C and Part B Stool Legs** with 4 pcs of **Hardware #1 Bolt**. Do not tighten screws too much at this step.

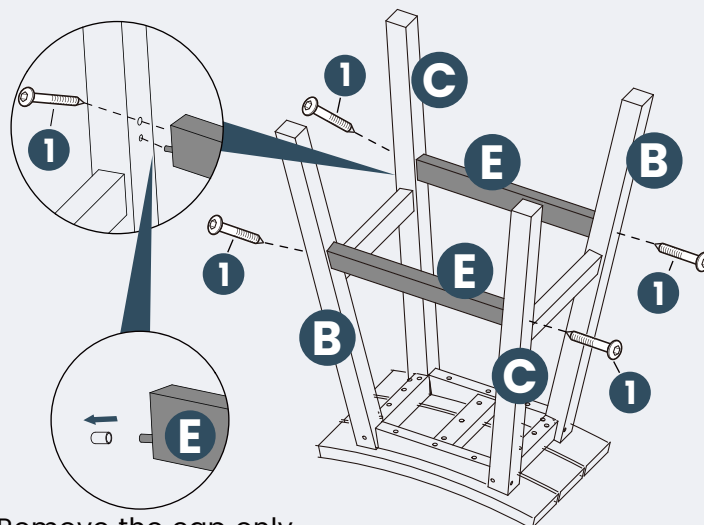


Remove the cap only.

Attach **Part E Long Rail** to the combined **Legs (Part B+C)** as below with 4 pcs of **Hardware #1 Bolts**.

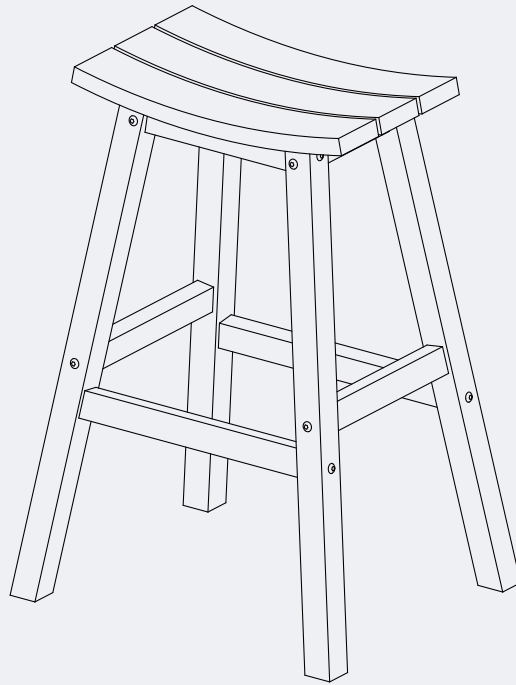
Remove the cap from the safety pin before you fix the Long **Part E Long Rail** to stool legs.



Remove the cap only.

Tighten all the bolts and finish the assembly.



CLEANING TIPS

REGULAR CLEAN: Use a mixture of warm water and mild soap. Gently scrub the surface with a soft bristle brush to remove any dirt or stains.

QUICK CLEAN: You can simply wipe down the furniture with a damp cloth.
