

INTRODUCTION


Read the manual carefully to ensure you fully understand all use, care, assembly, and safety information.



Read this manual carefully and follow the assembly instructions in the order listed. Pay close attention to assembly drawings.



Regularly clean with a clean microfiber cloth to prevent dust accumulation.



Assemble on a soft, flat, clean, and drv surface.

Use a soft, protective barrier when assembling the furniture.

TIP: Use the box carton as a protective layer to separate and protect the parts from scratches and other damage during assembly.



Do not paint the unit.

Do not use abrasive materials or cleaners to clean the furniture: only use a slightly moistened cloth.



Indoor use only.

Do not expose the furniture to heat or humidity.



Do not push or drag furniture as doing so may damage the unit.

Only move furniture when it is empty.



Always ask for help when moving furniture.



When cleaning nearby furniture, do not allow contact with water or cleaners as they can deteriorate the furniture.



Do not allow metal components to come in contact with water or cleaners as it may cause rust and staining.



Avoid Accidents - Do not climb, sit or stand on the furniture.

Do not allow children to play on or inside the furniture.




Keep sharp objects away as they may scratch or damage the unit.

Do not use the furniture as a writing surface without a padded barrier.

↑ IMPORTANT INSTALLATION INFORMATION


For the stability of the unit, it is important that furniture connectors are installed correctly. See drawings and tips below for proper installation.

Wood Dowel




Install wood dowels by gently tapping them into the designated hole using a rubber mallet.

Spreading Bolt



Install Spreading Bolts by firmly pressing them into the hole or gently tapping with a rubber mallet until the shoulder is flush with the panel.

Cam Lock





Align the cam lock opening (arrow) with the pre-drilled hole on the side of the panel. Use a screwdriver to adjust alignment as needed.




ASSEMBLY

Review all steps carefully and understand assembly before beginning.








Install four Wood Dowels (1), five Spreading Bolts (2), and two Cam Locks (3) into Middle Panel (D) as shown.

Turn the panel over.

Install three Spreading Bolts (2) into Middle Panel (D) as shown.
Then, turn the panel over.


Install four Wood Dowels (1) and four Cam Locks (3) into Left End Panel (H) as shown.

Repeat this step on the remaining Left End Panel (H).




As indicated in the drawing, align the dowel in Left End Panels (H) with Middle Panel (D).

Then, use a screwdriver to turn the cam lock until it locks onto the head of the spreading bolt.




Install four Wood Dowels (1) and three Cam Locks (3) into Right End Panel (I) as shown.




As indicated in the drawing, align the dowel in Right End Panel (I) with Middle Panel (D).


Use a screwdriver to turn the cam lock until it locks onto the head of the spreading bolt.

STEP 7





Install four Wood Dowels (1), one Spreading Bolt (2), and two Cam Locks (3) into Right Side Middle Panel (J) as shown.

Turn the panel over.


Install one Spreading Bolt (2) into Right Side Middle Panel (J) as shown.

Turn the panel over.


Install four Wood Dowels (1) and two Cam Locks (3) into Right Side Small Shelf (K) as shown.


Repeat this step on the remaining Right Side Small Shelf (K).






Ensuring the unfinished edges are on the bottom, align two Small Shelves (K) with Right Side Middle Panel (J) and secure the cam locks.








Install four Wood Dowels (1), one Spreading Bolt (2), and two Cam Locks (3) into Right Shelf (G) as shown.



Ensuring all unfinished edges are facing down, align Right Shelf (G) with Right Side Middle Panel (J) and secure the cam lock.


STEP 15

Ensuring the unfinished edges are on the bottom, align Right Shelf (G) and Right Side Small Shelf (K) with Middle Panel (D) and secure the cam locks.

Install four Wood Dowels (1) and two Cam Locks (3) into Left Shelf (F) as shown.

Repeat this step on the two remaining Left Shelves (F).

Ensuring the unfinished edges are on the bottom, align three Left Shelves (F) with Middle Panel (D) and secure the cam locks.

STEP 18 Tools Required C: 1 **⇒ (3**) **1**: 4 **2**: 3 **3**: 2


Install four Wood Dowels (1), three Spreading Bolts (2), and two Cam Locks (3) into Right Panel (C) as shown.

Install four Wood Dowels (1), five Spreading Bolts (2), and two Cam Locks (3) into Left Panel (B) as shown.

Loosely secure two Hinges (7). Do not fully tighten the hinge screws. Save the remaining screws for Step 27.

Ensuring the hinges are installed on the front of the unit, fasten Left Panel (B) to Left Shelves (F) and Left End Panels (H) by aligning the dowels and securing the cam locks.






As shown, align Right Panel (C) with the right side of the unit and secure the cam locks.



Install six Spreading Bolts (2) and one Door Stop (6) into Top Panel (E) as shown.

Next, align Stemware Rack (9) and firmly secure using three M6 x 9/16" Flat Screws (11).


STEP 21 TOOLS REQUIRED



Ensuring the glass rack is on the right, align Top Panel (E) with the top of the unit and secure the cam locks.

STEP 22 TOOLS REQUIRED




Secure one Foot (10) to the bottom of Bottom Panel (A) using four M6 x 1/2" Screws (13).

Repeat to connect the remaining three Feet (10).


Turn the panel over.

Install six Spreading Bolts (2) and one Door Stop (6) into Bottom Panel (A) as shown.

STEP 24 TOOLS REQUIRED




Assistance is required for turning unit.

Align Bottom Panel (A) with the dowels and cam locks on the bottom of the unit. Secure the cam locks.

With assistance, carefully and gently flip the unit over.

STEP 26

Assistance recommended to hold panels steady while the back panels are fastened.

Place Left Backing Board (N) and Right Backing Board (O) on the back of the cabinet, ensuring they are evenly aligned. Fasten the outer edges using eighteen Nails (8), and the middle using five Rear Panel Clamps (12) and five Nails (8).

Please note, care must be taken during hinge adjustment to avoid damage.

Only a slight adjustment is required. Rotate the Door Adjustment screw 1/8 to


1/4 turns at a time, then check the door position. Rotate adjustment screws as

Firmly fasten Handle (5) to Door (M) using the 3/4" Screws that are packaged with the handle.



IMPORTANT: The included wall anchor is suitable for drywall. Use a drill bit suited for your wall material; if the drill bit is too large, the tipover restraint system will be faulty.

If in doubt about installing the tipover restraint system, consult a certified professional.

Carefully measure and mark the location of screw installation and pilot holes before drilling. Measure twice, drill once!

Tipover Restraint Installation

- Use a 1/8" drill bit to drill two small pilot holes on the back of the furniture top.
- Securely fasten one end of the tipover restraint strap using the M8 x 1/2" Screw. Repeat to connect the second strap.
- Place the unit against the wall and mark the position for drilling the wall anchor pilot hole.
- Use a power drill with a 1/4" drill bit to drill pilot holes to the depth of the wall anchor, approximately 30mm deep. For walls made from softer materials, we recommend using a smaller drill bit to ensure the wall anchor remains snug inside the pilot hole.
- Insert the wall anchor until the wall anchor opening is flush with the wall.
- Align the unit with the wall anchor and secure the unit to the wall using the included M8 x 1" Screw.
