# WALKER INSTRUCTIONS

Easy "pull up" trigger release for opening and closing.

# LOCK COLLAR LEG PIN



### GLIDE SKIS

Be sure glide ski is centered on leg and facing forward with lip turned up at the front as shown.

### **IMPORTANT SAFETY NOTICE:**

Your walker features flip up legs that can be attached to the frame of the walker for easy storage. Be sure that when the legs are turned down for use as a walker, the leg pin is inserted into the lock collar as shown above. Be sure to check the leg height adjustment hole position when setting up or folding for storage in the carry bag to be sure all hole adjustments are the same.

# **CUSTOM WALKER ADJUSTMENTS**

With your arm extended down, handle should be at wrist height. With your hand placed on the hand-grip, your elbow should be flexed 20°- 30°.

### CAUTION:

Be aware of the following:

- · Electrical cords in way
- · Liquids on floor
- Throw rugs
- Toys or debris
- Furniture
- · Doors and door steps
- · Gaps in floor



### WARNING:

- 1. Use wheels on front legs only or on all four legs with appropriate rear wheel brakes.

# Wheelchair to Walker Transfer

Making certain wheels on the wheelchair are locked, lift your body by pushing down on the armrests and carefully transfer one hand at time to the walker.



# Wheelchair to Walker Transfer

### (with lower extremity injury)

Make sure the wheels on the wheelchair are locked.

- · For injuries to the right leg or foot: Lift your body by pushing down on the armrests and carefully transfer first the left hand, then the right hand to the walker.
- · For injuries to the left leg or foot: Lift your body by pushing down on the armrests and carefully transfer first the right hand, then the left hand to the walker.





Step 1

Align the middle of your foot with the back legs of the walker.

### Step 2

Slide the walker forward and place it comfortably in front of you.



### Step 3

Carefully, walk forward one step at a time.

# FOLDING

3. Fold the front frame legs, on both sides.

1. Pull up on release lever.





 To make the walker more compact for storage and transport, identify push pin above leg collar, depress pin and pull leg out of tube.

2. Fold the back frame legs, on both sides.





5. Fold legs up and insert into receptacle on frame. Repeat for each leg.
