CHAIN GLIDER ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Parts List:

Glider:

- (1) Glider Seat
- (2) Glider Arms with Chain
- (2) 6" Machine Bolts
- (4) 5/16" Standard Washers
- (2) 5/16" Loc Nuts

Brackets:

- (2) Glider Brackets
- (2) 10" Machine Bolts
- (4) 3/8" Fender Washers
- (2) 3/8" Loc Nuts
- (4) Standard Swing Hangers
- (4) Spring Clips

Glider Assembly:

Attach the glider arms to the seat section with 6" machine bolts, 5/16" standard washers and 5/16" loc nuts. Tighten enough to engage nylon insert but do not over tighten. Glider arms

must be able to move back and forth freely.

Glider Bracket Assembly:

Install 4" swing hangers into the two holes in the wooden glider brackets from the bottom. Make sure the eye of the bolt is pulled slightly into the wood and the nylon bushing moves freely back and forth. Attach the headbeam brackets to the headbeam with 10" machine bolts, 3/8" fender washers and 3/8" loc nuts by placing the brackets on top of the headbeam and inserting the 10" machine bolt through the fender washer and the top of the bracket to the bottom of the head beam. Secure with a fender washer and the lock nut and tighten until the brackets are securely in place.


Attach Glider to Brackets

Connect the glider chains to the swing hanger with spring clips.

Usage Note

After installing the glider, please make your children aware of the "safe use zone" in the front and back of the glider path. The weight of 2 children and the broader arc of the glider can make the swinging force stronger than a traditional belt swing.
