
INSTALLATION AND CARE & MAINTENANCE GUIDE Installation Guide



- Preliminary information
- 1. The A4911BO and A4912 trim kit are separate units. You must order both to complete the package.
- 2. The A4911BO has the adaptor C7594 in the box
- 3. The A4911BO is port specific. Make sure the arrow points in the direction of the flow.
- 4. 1 1/2" extension kit C4912 is available. Must order separately.
- a Preparation
- 1. Flush the system before and after installation.
- b Assembly of inside body
- 1. Estimate the finished wall and install the rough at the required depth.
- 2. Make sure the arrow on the body point in the direction of the flow.
- 3. DO NOT SOLDER THE CONNECTIONS: Heating the valve will damage the cartridge. There is no warranty on cartridges damaged by heat.
- 4. Leave the plastic mudguard in place if further work is done in the area.



Please note: The trim kit is assembled out of the box. There are no parts assembled. Parts 2 through 11 are preassembled. 1. Remove the mudguard. 2. Confirm the installation of adaptor C7594. 3. Position the lever at 12 o'clock and screw the body #3 on to the rough valve #1 with the adaptor C7594 in place. Please note: Part #2 is a part of the assembly and not an extension. The extension kit is number C4912 and is not part of the trim assembly. It must be ordered separately.



d - Before use

C7594

Turn on the water supply to the faucet.

Maximum temperature water supply to the faucet is 145° F.

Assembly of external part

Maximum recommended pressure is 75 psi.

CHECK THE INSTALLATION CAREFULLY FOR LEAKS AFTER INSTALLATION.

If further building work is to be carried out in the vici of the faucet, it should be covered to prevent paint, adhesive, etc. from damaging the surface.





Care and use for finishes

Country Bath Products are all authentic finishes that have not been coated with any product.

After each use, pat the fixture down to remove any excess water. This will prevent any water spotting or mineral build—up. Use only soft liquid soap and water to clean the surface. Use a soft brush to clean any gaps. Avoid any products that have ammonia or alcohol like Windex, 409 or Fantastik. These products can damage the finish leaving black or white spots. Never use an abrasive product like Softscrub, Comet, Ajax or Bon Ami.

For deep polishing we recommend Bruno's Wax for all finishings.

Tuscan Brass is a living finish and has no warranty. It will lighten with use. To extend the life of the finish, apply Bruno's Wax by patting it on, letting it dry and patting it off. Never rub or buff this finish.

WARNING: the use of cleaning products not recommended might irreparably harm the surfaces of the faucets which in such case are not covered by our warranty.

Limescale

The faucet is fitted with an aeration device in the Hot/Cold water outlet.

This may need occasional cleaning especially in hard water areas.

This is accomplished by unscrewing the outlet in a counter clockwise direction, dismantling and leaving the inner screen mesh immersed over night in vinegar or lemon juice.

Do not use chemical descaling liquids for this purpose.

INSTALLATION and WARRANTY INSTRUCTIONS TECHNICAL INFORMATION

All flexible hoses are designed and manufactured for use with water in exposed locations only. **Do not expose** to household cleaners, chlorine, cloride, hydrochloric acid or other corrosive chemicals.

- All connections with threads M10x1 male must be hand tighten. **Do not over tighten. Over tightening may cause damage to the hose.**

All faucets washers and o-rings are designed and manufactured for use with water. **Do not expose** to household cleaners, chlorine, cloride, hydrochloric acid or other corrosive chemicals.

Faucets are designed for use with the tempratures and pressures listed below:

- minimum cold water supply 50 °F
- maximum hot water supply 145 °F
- minimum pressure 15 psi
- maximum pressure 75 psi
- maximum fixing torque value = 10 lbf.ft.

Please note: The recommended best pressure for best performance is between 40 psi and 60 psi. More pressure than 60 psi or less pressure than 40 psi may affect the diverting action in side spray faucets.
