For over three decades, Kendall-Jackson has remained relentlessly committed to producing only the finest quality wines from grapes grown in California's cool, coastal vineyards. We carefully match climates and soil types for each grape varietal and then guide each vineyard lot throughout the entire winemaking process.

KEY POINTS

- Coming primarily from Monterey and Sonoma County's cool coastal vineyards, the Pinot Noir is bright, juicy, and vibrant with delicate floral and pink citrus fruit nuances.
- The Syrah in this wine contribute a beautiful pink/coral color and strawberry fruit notes.
- Stainless steel fermentation retains the bright fruit character, freshness, and purity of the wine and makes it perfect for sipping on its own or paired with bright spring and summertime meals.
