Assemble components on a soft, clean surface to avoid damaging the finish.

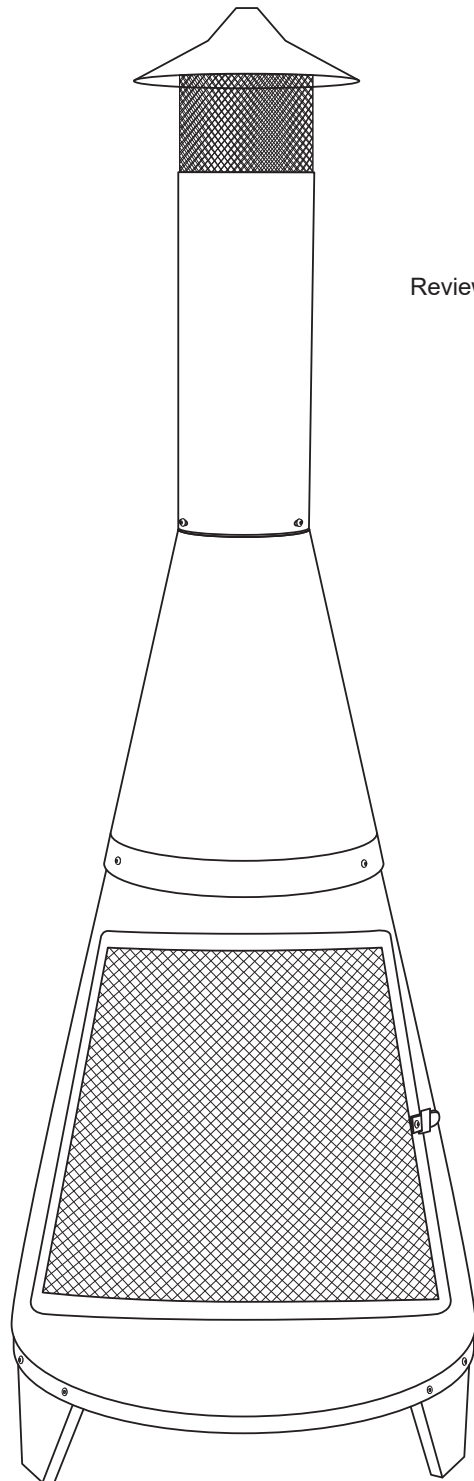







Inspect packaging to ensure all parts are accounted for before disposing of packing materials.

CHOKING HAZARD — This item contains small parts that can be swallowed. Keep children and pets away during assembly.

NOTE: The iron oxide finish is a result of the alloy steel being exposed to water and oxygen. Continuous color change is normal.

Rust will flake away from the unit when touched, use a drop cloth during assembly. Rust can cause staining, avoid contact with water and clothing.

Help limit color change, continued oxidization, and metal degradation by covering or storing the fire pit when not in use.

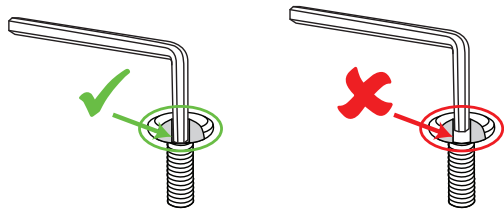

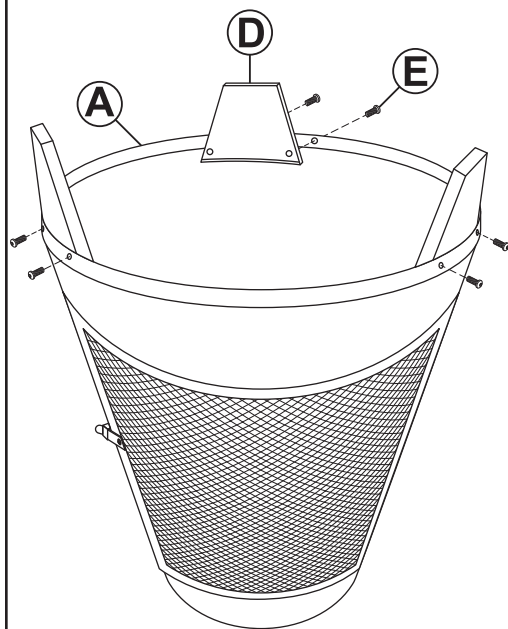
ASSEMBLY



TIP: Always fully insert the hex key inside designated notch of the bolt. If the hex key is not fully inside the notch, the hex key could slip out, causing damage to the bolt head. Repeated hex key slipping will cause the notch to become rounded, making it difficult or impossible to tighten the bolt with the hex key.

STEP 1

A: 1
D: 3
E: 6

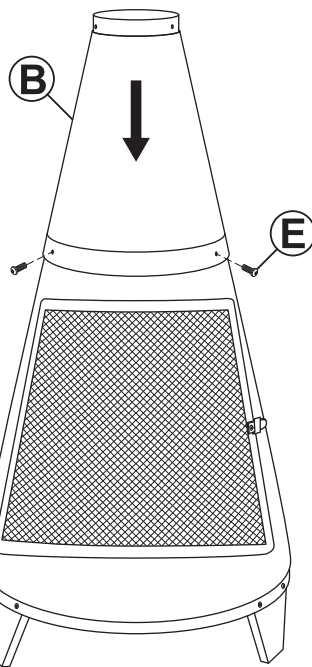


Place Main Body (A) upside down.

Secure Leg (D) to the inside of the main body using two Bolts (E). Repeat to secure the remaining two legs.

STEP 2

B: 1
E: 3

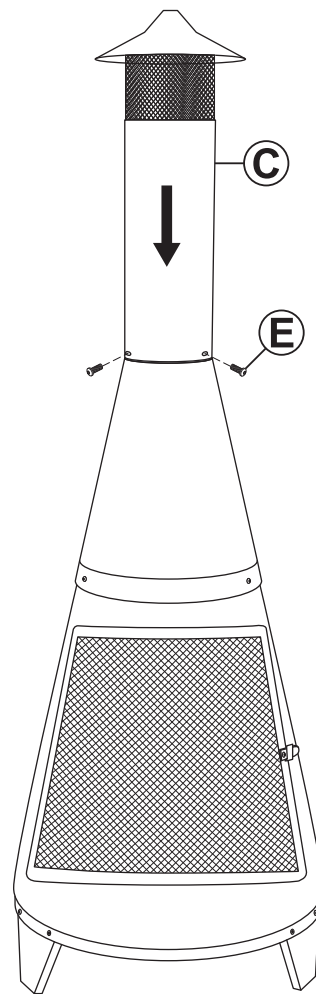


Flip unit upright and place Flue Base (B) onto the main body.

Align the mounting holes and secure using three Bolts (E).

STEP 3

C: 1
E: 3



Place Flue (C) onto the flue base and firmly secure using three Bolts (E).

CARE & MAINTENANCE

SAFE USE: Only use a chiminea on a flat, non-combustible surface such as concrete, rock, or stone. Do not use this fire pit on a wood deck or any other combustible surfaces like dry grass, leaves, mulch, etc. Never use in an area with an overhead structure or near any unprotected combustible constructions like vinyl or wood siding. Avoid using near or under overhanging trees and shrubs.

The unit will become extremely hot while in use. Always use heat-resistant gloves and tools when maintaining a fire.

NO ACCELERANTS, NO PLASTICS: Never use an accelerant, i.e. gasoline or kerosene, to start a fire; doing so is dangerous and can damage the chiminea. Never use any plastic materials in or near a fire. The emissions from burning plastic are toxic. Additionally, plastic residue is very difficult to remove.

EXTINGUISH: Let fires die down gradually and go out on their own. DO NOT use water to put out a fire as the sudden drop in temperature may cause serious injury and/or damage the metal.

EXPOSURE & MAINTENANCE: Although the fire pit is constructed from durable metal, exposure to high-intensity heat and humidity in the air will gradually affect the appearance and integrity of the unit.

Do not allow ash to accumulate in the bottom of the pit. Never drop the unit as doing so could cause permanent damage.

CLEANING: Remove ashes and debris before every use. Ensure the chiminea and ashes are completely cool before cleaning. Ashes can remain hot long after a fire dies down. If you feel heat when your hand is close to the metal or the ashes, the unit is too hot to clean.

COVER AND STORE: Ensure the entire unit is completely cool before covering. Always clean the unit before covering it. Do not allow the fire pit to be exposed to water. Water and moisture trapped beneath a cover and/or splashing from beneath the unit during rain will accelerate rust and degradation. Store in a dry location to protect it from the effects of environmental elements. Manufacturer is not liable for damage resulting from general use and/or environmental conditions.

- Always supervise children and pets when they are in proximity of this product, whether it is in use or not in use.
- Never use any fire pit or chiminea during dry or windy conditions.
- Keep unit a safe distance away from buildings, balconies, or overhangs when in use.
- Do not use on or near combustible surfaces or structures such as wood decks, dry leaves or grass, mulch, vinyl or wood siding, etc.
- Only use this unit on a level, non-combustible surface.
- Keep away from all combustible materials including gasoline and other flammable liquids and vapors.
- Never use accelerants such as, but not limited to, gasoline, alcohol, kerosene, as this may cause serious injury or product damage.
- Do not overfill or use this unit or use it to burn leaves or trash.
- This unit becomes very hot when in use and can remain hot for a long time after fire is extinguished. Ensure the unit is completely cool before cleaning or moving it.
- Never leave unit unattended while hot or in use.
- Extinguish the fire properly before leaving the unit unattended. If necessary, use a fire extinguisher or sand to smother the fire. NEVER use water to extinguish hot fires or embers as doing so may cause serious injury and/or permanently damage the product.
- Ashes can remain hot for a long time after fire is extinguished. Dispose of cold ashes properly.
- Ensure the unit is completely cool before covering, failure to do so will damage the cover and the unit.
- DO NOT USE CHEMICAL-BASED CLEANERS as this may damage the product and/or ignite a flame during the next use.
