Design Techniques

Here are easy, no sew techniques to try:

Tuck Fabric:

- 1. Locate the channel on the back of the mannequin. Use the tool to push and tuck the fabric in.
- 2. Drape the fabric around the mannequin creating elegant folds.
- 3. Wrap the remaining fabric around the back. Tuck into the channel to secure.
- 4. Use mini clothespins to hold fabric in place, as needed.

- 2. Slide a bow belt over the mannequin to hold fabric in place.
- 3. Adjust the fabric under the bow belt.

Use the trims to add volume to any look. Secure in channel or with clothespin.
