




Carefully remove all the parts from the carton and place them individually on a soft cloth to prevent scratches or other damage.

## Assembly Instructions 2/7


#### **IMPORTANT**

- Use a soft cloth between these parts and the floor.
- Do not use power tools above 8 volts to assemble.
- Do not tighten all the screws until each part is properly assembled.
- The unit must be level to work properly. Use the included adjustable levelers to level.
- Keep Hex Wrench as the bolts may need to be tightened in the future.

#### STEP 1

Attach Shelf Supports (E) to Shelves (C) with Head Cap Bolts (long).

Attach Shelf Support (E) to Adjustable Shelf (D) with Head Cap Bolts (long).







### STEP 2

Attach Rails (G) to unit with Head Cap Bolts (short).

Tighten Head Cap Bolts with Hex Wrench. (See Figure 4)

#### STEP 5

Attach Stretchers (H) to unit with Head Cap Bolts (short).







Turn unit to its upright position.


Insert Pins into side frames at desired level. (See Figure 6)







## Assembly Instructions 7/7

#### **IMPORTANT**

• To help reduce the risk of the unit tipping over, the Tipover Restraint must be installed following these instructions exactly.

STEP 9

Place unit at desired location.

Drill a 3/8" hole in wall in-line with pre-drilled hole in shelf of unit.

Move unit.

Insert Anchor into the wall hole and attach Bracket with Wall Screw.

Attach Bracket at pre-drilled hole in shelf of unit with Wood Screw.

Move unit back into place.

Slide Tipover Restraint through Bracket on wall and Bracket on unit. (See Figure 9)

Lock end




