II. Application and Directions

- 1. Always read entire label before using product.
- 2. Shake well and hold can 25-30cm from surface.
- 3. Spray a light even film on surface to be welded. Do not over apply.
- 4. After welding, wipe or clean away the thin film before applying any post-welding applications, e.g. painting or hot dip or cold galvanising.

Water-based formula – Allows easy clean up without solvent cleaners, allows part to be welded while wet.
