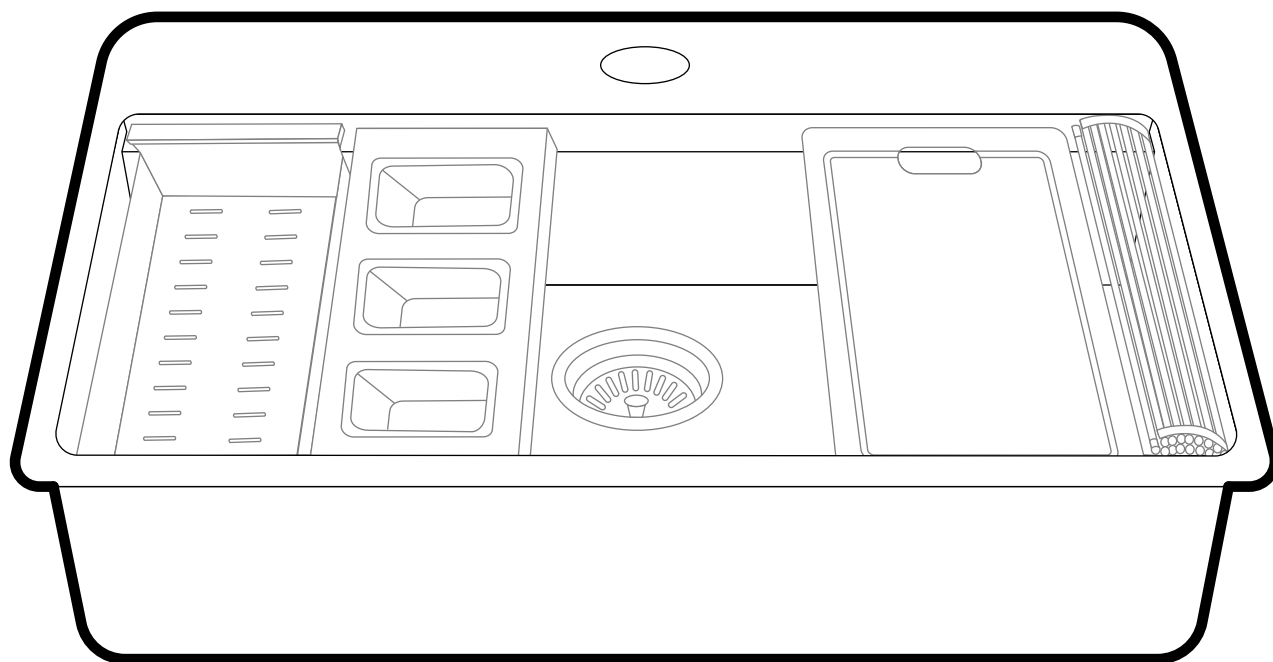


Top-Mount Kitchen Workstation Sink

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS





PRIOR TO INSTALLATION:

- Inspect product to ensure no damages have occurred while in shipping.
- Observe all plumbing and building codes in accordance with your state and local requirements.
- Make sure to purchase the correct cabinet size for your sink.
- All dimensions are nominal! Be sure to measure your vanity and sink prior to installation.
- Installation with laminate countertop not recommended.
- The step-by-step guidelines in the installation instructions are a general reference. Should there be any discrepancies, Swiss Madison cannot be held liable. It is recommended to install all Swiss Madison products by hiring a licensed professional.
- Read installation and maintenance instructions thoroughly before installing. Be sure to use proper tools and always wear proper personal safety accessories for your protection.

Lifelong Care: Swiss Madison Stainless Steel Sinks are easy to maintain with minimal care. For best results, always rinse with mild soap and wipe after each use. Rub lightly with soft cloth in the direction of the drain on a regular basis. To avoid damage and discoloration to the sink surface never use steel wool, scouring pad or abrasive cleaners.

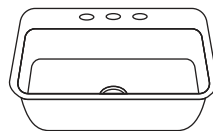

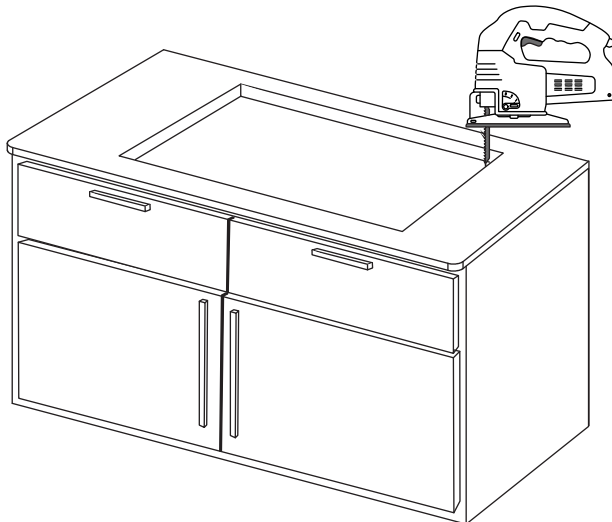
1 Position and Trace Template

- Check the cutout template against the actual sink to ensure a proper sized cutout.
- Place the cutout template in the desired location on the countertop.
- Trace the template onto the countertop.
- Make sure clearance is suitable for back splash, faucet, and plumbing for the sink.



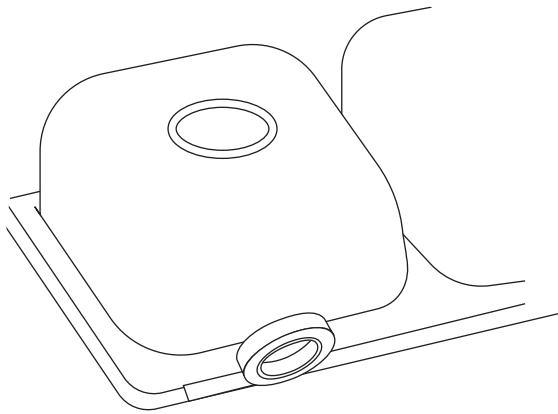
2 Cut Countertop

- Cut an opening in the countertop by carefully following the traced line from the template.
- Please use the appropriate saw that best fits your countertop material. Professional should be consulted for cutting countertop.



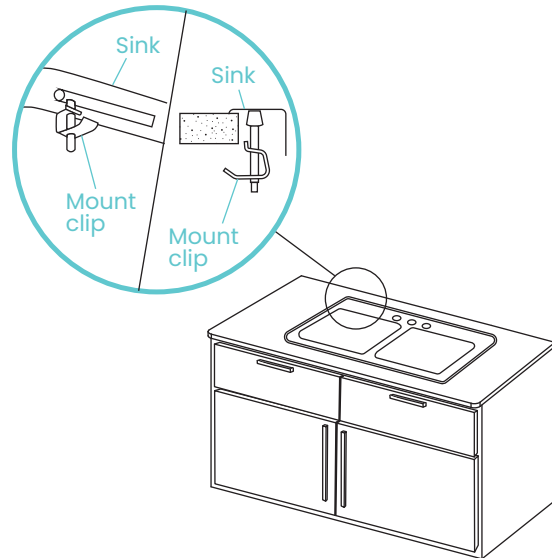
3 Prepare the Sink

- Place the sink into the installation hold to verify the fit. Adjust the cutout if necessary.
- Place the sink upside down and align the bottom edge with waterproof strip.



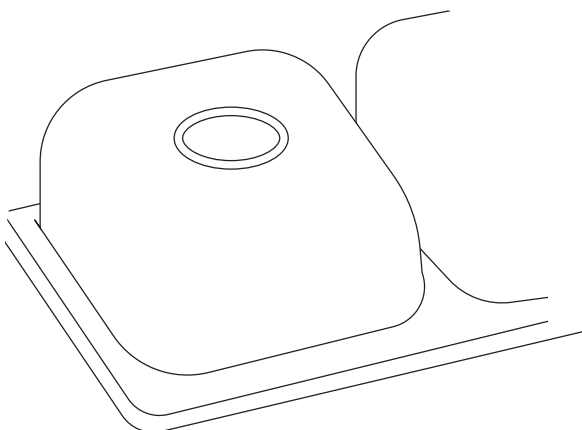
4 Attach Mounting Clips

- Attach the top-mount clips to the edge of the sink.



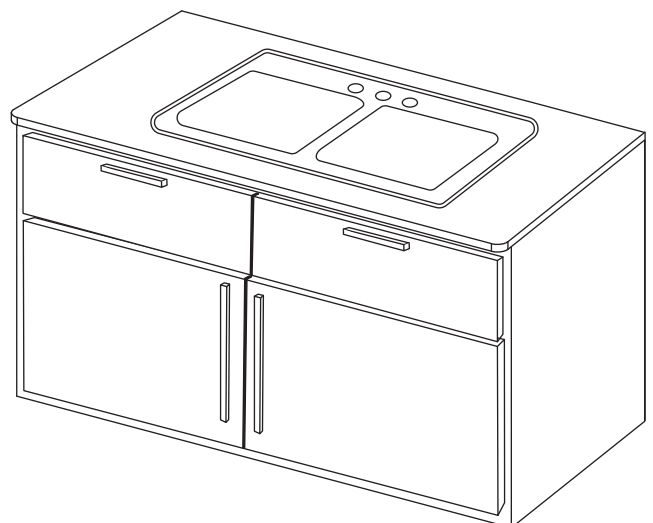
5 Install the Sink

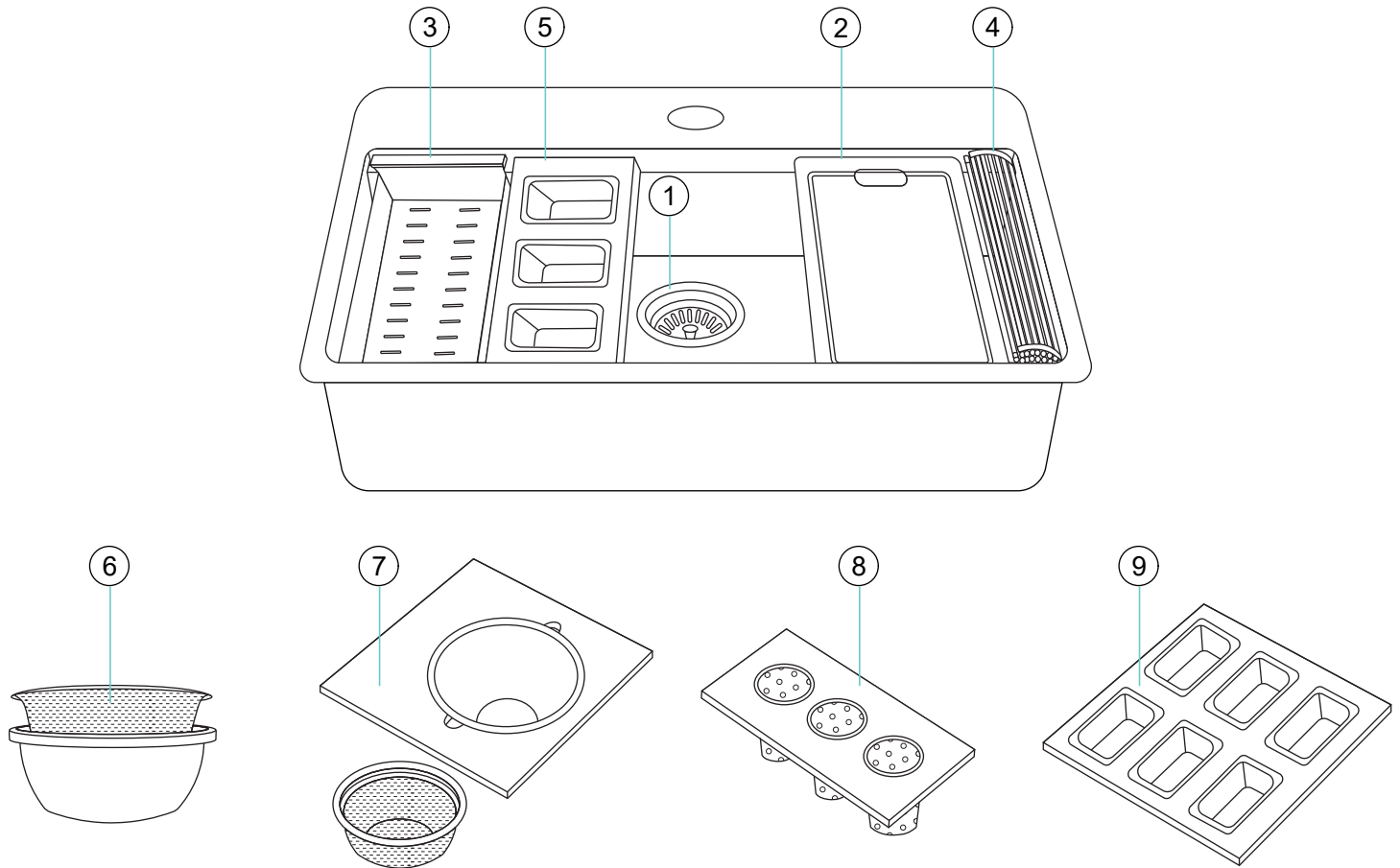
- Apply silicone sealant (not included) around the underside and lip of the tank.
- Test run water into sink and check for leaks. Carefully lower the sink into the counter.
- Tighten the screws on the top-mount clips evenly until the sink is flush with the counter. Do not over-tighten.
- Wipe excess sealant with a rag.



6 Install Plumbing Fixtures

- Connect drain trap to drain, and water supply connections to faucet according to manufacturer's instruction.
- Test run water into sink and check for leaks.

USE & CARE INSTRUCTIONS

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- It is recommended to wash the basin frequently.
- Please clean only use warm soapy water and then dry with a soft cloth.
- Do not use wire brushes, detergents, abrasives and other supplies to clean, to prevent abrasion on the surface of the basin.
- Do not use hard or sharp objects to scratch the surface of the basin.
- Pay attention to avoid collision.
- It is recommended to use wax to maintain the wash basin every six months.
