

Tip

If you want to permanently attach accessories, add a drop of glue to the back to hold them in place on the headband.

• Slide these onto undecorated headbands with the elastic loop.

Rhinestones

Use the self adhesive, felt backer elastic loops to attach large Heart & Mermaid Rhinestones.



Peel

Press

Felt Backer

Make sure the knot is facing you when you add the felt backer.

Glue the small rhinestones directly onto the headbands.

Assembling your headbands!

1 Add Accessories **before** adding rhinestones or peel & press decorations.

2 Glue small rhinestones onto headband. Set in the workstation, allow to fully dry.

1 Glue ribbon onto headband.

2 Glue ribbon ends under, set in the workstation. Allow to fully dry.

3 Slide accessory onto headband.

1 Peel & press tulle flowers.

Why not host a headband party and invite your favorite friends over for some creative crafting?

Before you begin

- It is helpful to have a pair of scissors & a roll of tape or a few paper clips handy.
- Use your scissors to cut the ribbons.
- The tape or paper clips can be used to hold the ribbons in place while you wait for the glue to dry.

Your headbands come attached to a backer card. Save this insert to use as a work station. It's the perfect place to rest your headbands while you wait for the glue to dry.

Remember, work with clean hands on a clean work surface.

Although the glue is washable, it's a good idea to keep a damp paper towel handy for clean up.

Tip


Since the headbands are satin, any extra glue will leave a dark spot on the fabric. Wipe off any extra glue with a damp cloth.

Design Time Plan out how each of your headbands will be decorated. You can refer to the pictures on the box or create your own styles.

Ribbon wrap



TIP

While the glue dries, secure the ends of your ribbon with tape or a paperclip.

- 1 Glue the end of the ribbon to the inside bottom edge of the headband.
- 2 Wind the ribbon around the headband until you reach the other end. Glue the end under, trimming as needed.
- 3 Set it in your workstation to dry.
- 4 Allow it to dry completely before wearing.

Gold Leaf and Butterfly Trims



- Working a few inches at a time, draw a thin line of glue down the center of the headband.
- Apply the trim adding more glue as you go.
- Cut ends as needed.
- Set it in your workstation to dry.


BOWS! Create big or little bows using your ribbon. Ask an adult or older friend for help as needed.

Simple Bow

Tie a bow around your headband using the tulle ribbon, just like tying a shoe!



Double Bow



- Cut 2 pieces of ribbon as shown. Use the guide to measure.
- Flip ribbon over to the non-pattern side.
- Apply glue to the edge as shown.
- Form each piece into a loop.



- With seam side down, stack the small loop on top of the larger loop.
- Pinch together in the center.
- Measure a **C** length of gel cord or thin ribbon.
- Wrap around the center a few times and tightly knot.
- Use a dot of craft glue to secure your knot.

leave extra cord on both sides so you can tie it to your headband.

Triple Bow

- For this bow, cut the ribbon into 3 pieces: **A B C**
- Follow the directions above to create your loops, glue, stack and tie.
