## 2021 PINOT NOIR

Each year this small production wine, sourced from distinguished vineyards across multiple AVAs, aims to represent the unique quality of a specific vintage here in the Willamette Valley. ### 2021 VINTAGE

The 2021 growing season began with a winter ice storm, followed by rain at bloom and a heat dome in June. Overall yields were decreased due to the rain at bloom, but flavor intensity remained strong. A warm growing season kept berries small and concentrated. Much needed rains in early September extended the growing season, allowing the grapes a little extra hang time to build up flavor and balance acidity.

### TASTING NOTES

This wine opens with spiced red fruits, cherry cola, tea leaves, and perfumed berries. There is a delicate sweetness to the attack with peppered spice and a freshness that culminates in a lengthy and savory finish. The mouthfeel has great density and provides power and elegance.
