2018 VINTAGE

The 2018 growing season started off cool and wet followed by slightly warmer than average summer temperatures. Early September rain helped give the vines a sip of water to recharge just before harvest.

TASTING NOTES

Plum, dried cherry, and warm summer berries mix with exotic spices and cassis to create warm and inviting aromas. Dark fruit and dried raspberry mix with fine grain tannin to give this wine mid-palate depth and an extended finish.
