# 12806 INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Please read carefully and save these instructions as you may need them a later date.

## **CAUTION**

WARNING: Risk of Fire. Consult a qualified electrician to ensure correct branch circuit conductor.

Turn off the main power at the circuit breaker before installing the fixture in order to prevent possible shock.

#### **GENERAL**

All electrical connections must be in accordance with local and National Electrical Code (N.E.C.) standards. If you are unfamiliar with proper electrical wiring connections obtain the services of a qualified electrician.

Remove the fixture and the mounting package from the box and make sure that no parts are missing by referencing the illustration.

# **ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION**

- 1. Spread the socket arms on fixture body (17) to create the chandelier design.
- 2. Connect the stems (15) (14)(13) (depending on desired height). Attach them to the nipple on the top of the coupling (16), then thread the stem into the swivel (11).
- 3. Thread two mounting screws (5) through the mounting bar (7) and secure with the hex nut (9).
- 4. Attach the mounting bar (7) with box screw (10) to the outlet box (1).
- 5. Pull out the outlet wire and ground wire from the outlet box, make wire connections with wire nut (6) as follow:
  - --Connect the smooth-coated wire (w marked) or Black wire from fixture to the Black wire (3) from power source.
  - -- Connect the ribbed-coated wire (w/o marked) or White wire from fixture to the White wire (2) from power source.
  - --Attach the fixture ground wire to mounting bar (7) with the ground screw (8). Connect it to the house ground wire (4) with the wire nut (6).
- 6. Attach the fixture canopy to the outlet box (1), secure it with the ball nut (12).

7. Install bulbs: (bulbs not included)
(Don't exceed the maximum capacity recommended on the sockets).
