

- Floor must be level prior to installation of vanity.


1. Left side panel


1. Install Side Panel Slides

- Screw 9 cam bolts (A) into the left side panel (1). Repeat for the right side panel (2).
- Install 3 undermount slides (K) to the right side panel (2) using 2 screws (G) per slide. For additional reinforcement, drill an additional 4 screws (G) per slide as shown.
- Insert 6 cam bolts (A) and 4 wooden dowels into the bottom panel (3).
- Insert 1 cam bolt (A) and 2 wooden dowels (C) into the middle panel (8).




2. Assemble Frame

- Insert 1 cam bolt (A) into the rear top bar (4). Repeat for the rear bottom bar (5).
- Insert 4 cam bolts (A) into the front bottom bar (13).
- Insert 2 wooden dowels (C) into the front top bar (12).
- Connect the front bottom bar (13) and bottom panel (3), secure with 4 cam locks (B).
- Connect the rear bottom bar (5), rear top bar (4), and front top bar (12) with the middle panel (8).
Secure with 3 cam locks (B).




3. Assemble Base

- Connect the bottom panel (3) to the middle panel (8) and rear bottom bar (5) as shown. Secure with 6 cam locks (B).
- Connect the side panels (1 & 2) to the main body. Secure with 18 cam locks (B).




4. Install Middle Panel Slides

- Attach 3 undermount slides (K) to the middle panel (8) using 2 screws (G) each as shown.
- Reinforce this connection with an additional 4 screws (G) per each slide shown.




5. Assemble Drawer Base

- Screw 6 cam bolts (A) into pre-threaded holes on the drawer left side panel (14). Repeat for the drawer right side panel (15).
- Screw 2 cam bolts (A) into the drawer back panel (16). Repeat for the drawer front panel (17).
- Use 16 cam locks (B) to connect and secure all panels in place as shown.




6. Assemble Drawers

- Attach the drawer front panel (17) to the drawer surface (9, 10, 11) with 4 screws (J) as shown.
- Use 2 screws (M) for the handles to attach the drawer handles (L) to the drawer surface (9, 10, 11).




7. Install Drawers

- Attach the 2 undermount slides (K) to the drawer bottom panel (18) with 2 screws (I). Do not tighten screws all the way.
- Insert the hooks of the slides (K) to the back panel of the drawer (16). Tighten the 2 screws (I) on the bottom of the drawer (18) to secure the slides (K). Repeat entire process for all 3 drawers.




8. Install Doors & Handles

- Install 2 hinges (E) to both the left door (6) and the right door (7) using 2 screws (G) per hinge.
- Use an additional 2 screws per hinge to attach the left door (6) and right door (7) to the cabinet. If the door does not align properly, adjust the hinges according to the diagrams below. Once adjustments have been completed, secure the hinges using 2 screws (G) each.
- Install the handles (L) to the doors using the handle screws (H).




Hinge/Door Adjustment and Realignment

• If adjustment or realignment is needed, follow the instructions provided in the following chart.



9. Secure Vanity to Wall

- Attach 2 metal brackets (D) to the rear top bar (4) using 16 screws (G).
- Mark desired mounting location on wall and ensure placement is level.
- Select installation option 1 or 2.



Option 1: Securing to Drywall


- Position cabinet against wall in desired location.
- Using a pencil, make a mark on the wall through the holes in each bracket (D).
- Move cabinet away from the wall. Create a pilot hole in each mark on the wall, then insert the plastic anchor (F).
- Place cabinet against the wall, insert a screw (F) through the metal bracket (D) into each hole in the wall, then tighten to plastic anchors (F) to secure the vanity.

Option 2: Securing to Drywall & Wood Stud

- Position cabinet against wall in desired location, be sure desired mounting location aligns with existing wood studs.
- Insert screw (F) through the holes in the metal bracket (D), then tighten through the drywall into the wood stud. Repeat this step for the other metal bracket (D) to secure the vanity.

10. Vanity Top Installation

- Install faucet and drain according to manufacturer's installation instructions. Do not overtighten, this may cause the sink to crack.
- Set the vanity top on top of the vanity base, checking the location of the p-trap and drain.
- Remove vanity top from vanity base. Apply a thin bead of silicone around the vanity base and set the vanity top carefully in place.
- Remove excess silicone with a wet cloth.



Wait 24 hours before use.
