CRC Paint Marker Pen uses solvent based paint formula for durable marking on multiple surfaces in all weather conditions. It shows excellent coverage and is an ideal product for every toolbox.

II. Application and Directions

- Shake the pen well with the cap on, until the agitator ball moves freely.
- Take off the cap and press tip several times or until the paint starts to flow.
- Always use in a well ventilated area.
- Replace the cap carefully after use and store in a horizontal position.

VI. Special Precautions

The solvents in CRC Paint Marker Pen are flammable. Keep away from heat and sources of ignition. Use only in well ventilated area.

The volume of solvent vapour liberated from marking a 1 metre line is 0.005 litres. This volume is insufficient to generate a flammable atmosphere in normal conditions.
