Applies to UltraMax® Ligttech® purchased directly from Current between April 2017 and the date on which this Limited Warranty document is later superseded.

Current Lighting Solutions, LLC d/b/a GE Current, a Daintree company ("Current"), is pleased to provide the following limited warranty covering Ligttech & UltraMax LED constant current and constant voltage drivers purchased directly from Current from April, 2017, until this Limited Warranty document is later super ceded. Current warrants that these LED drivers comply with Current's specifications and are free from defects in materials and workmanship for the period set forth below.

Remedy: If a Ligttech or UltraMax LED constant current or constant voltage driver fails due to defects in materials or workmanship within either five (5) years after the date of manufacture in applications where the maximum case temperature is >70°C, or 3 years after the date of manufacture in applications where the maximum case temperature is between 70°C and 90°C then Current will, at its option, either (1) provide credit to the direct purchaser ("Purchaser") equal to the current price Current charges Purchaser for the driver, or 2 provide a free replacement driver to purchaser. This warranty applies only to Ligttech LED or UltraMax constant current and constant voltage drivers that have been properly wired and installed and operated within the electrical values shown on the driver label.

Compatibility: Compatibility of any dimmers or LED module/array, is the responsibility of Purchaser to determine, unless Current approved controls are used. Current does not warrant the suitability of a Ligttech or UltraMax for any application or use in any equipment.

Terms & Conditions: This warranty is VOID in applications where the case temperature is >90° C. The foregoing Ligttech or UltraMax LED driver warranty applies only to direct purchases from Current and to drivers operated in lighting equipment designed and approved for the application and in environmental conditions (temperature, humidity and air movement) within the normal specified operating range of the system, but does not apply to failures caused by acts of God or as a result of any improper storage or installation, abuse, misuse, abnormal use, or use in violation of any applicable recommendations of Current or any standard, code or instructions for use in installations, including, but not limited to, those contained in the National Electrical Code, the Standards for Safety of Underwriters Laboratory, Inc., Standards for the International Electrotechnical Commission, Standards for the American National Standards Institute or, in Canada, the Canadian Standards Association. **Current reserves and has the right to examine failed drivers to determine the cause of failure and patterns of usage.** Any replacement Product will be comparable in function, but may not be identical to the original. The replacement Product is warranted for the remainder of the original warranty period. Current is not responsible for any labor or other costs associated with removal or reinstallation.

THE FOREGOING WARRANTIES CONSTITUTES THE SOLE AND EXCLUSIVE REMEDIES OF PURCHASER AND THE SOLE LIABILITY OF CURRENT FOR CLAIMS BASED ON DEFECT IN OR FAILURE OF PRODUCTS, WHETHER THE CLAIM IS IN CONTRACT, INDEMNITY, WARRANTY, TORT (INCLUDING NEGLIGENCE), STRICT LIABILITY OR OTHERWISE. THESE WARRANTIES ARE EXCLUSIVE AND IN LIEU OF ALL OTHER WARRANTIES, WHETHER WRITTEN, ORAL, IMPLIED OR STATUTORY. NO WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PURPOSE IS MADE OR IS TO BE IMPLIED. IN NO EVENT, SHALL CURRENT BE LIABLE FOR ANY OTHER COSTS OR DAMAGES INCLUDING LOST PROFITS, INDIRECT, INCIDENTAL, SPECIAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES.

To Make a Warranty Claim: To make a warranty claim, retain the failed products and notify your Current sales representative in writing within thirty (30) days of the failure. This warranty extends only to Purchaser. However, Current will honor, under the terms of this Limited Warranty, valid warranty claims made by Purchaser for the remedy set forth above because of warranty claims made to Purchaser by its customers and indirect customers.
