TOUS ENSEMBLE PINOT NOIR

Tous Ensemble, "all together" in French, is a series of approachable wines that are perfect for every occasion, every palate, and every day of the week.

APPELLATION NOTES

True Sonoma Coast, a more specific area that focuses on the ridges along the Pacific Coast from the Sonoma/Mendocino County border down to Bodega Bay. Our estate vineyards Sealift and Tidal Break are planted here and they each benefit from the soil, elevation, and proximity to the Pacific Ocean. These characteristics define the terroir for growing world class Pinot Noir and Chardonnay.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Aromas: Currant, cranberry, raspberry, blackberry

Palate: Intense layers of cherries, pomegranate and spice amplify this wine. As the wine further opens, we get chanterelle mushrooms, fresh cut redwood and wet sandstone.

VINTAGE NOTES

2018 was a very cool growing season that allowed us to leisurely pick grapes over a long period of time. This cool weather allowed us to have many different blocks picked at various levels of ripeness and flavor development, while maintaining ideal sugar levels. This gave us a diverse group of wines to blend from at our blending session.
