



SONOMA COUNTY ROSÉ

THIS 100% CABERNET FRANC WAS PICKED FROM OUR JACKSON PARK VINEYARD IN THE BENNETT VALLEY AVA. THE FRUIT WAS PICKED EARLY IN HARVEST IN THE FIRST FEW DAYS OF SEPTEMBER TO PRESERVE THE BRIGHT ACIDITY OF AN ELEGANT ROSÉ. MIRRORING TRADITIONAL ROSÉ PRODUCTION IN FRANCE, THE GRAPES WERE FERMENTED AT LOW TEMPERATURES IN STAINLESS STEEL TANKS. THE WINE WAS KEPT FRESH WITH NO MALOLACTIC FERMENTATION OR BARREL AGING, SHOWCASING THE FLORAL NOTES OF CABERNET FRANC AND THE BEAUTY OF SONOMA COUNTY.

A lustrous rosé wine with a bouquet of ruby-red grapefruit, strawberries and jasmine flowers. Emerging on the palate are flavors of golden apples and raspberry, alongside flowers and honeycomb. The 2019 vintage is one of harmony, creating a balance of fruits and florals with bright acidity. The finish has a lingering freshness that concludes this vibrant, exuberant expression of Cabernet Franc.
