HARVEST NOTES

The 2017 vintage began with a cool and wet Spring compared with previous years, which resulted in bud break beginning in mid-April. The cool Spring temperatures didn't last long before a record heat spike hit in late May that caused flowering to begin across the valley. Continued heat in July and August moved the grapes quickly into veraison and brought steady ripening which allowed for great maturity and flavor development, along with perfectly balanced sugar and acid levels.

WINEMAKING

Our 2017 Jory Hills Vineyard Pinot Noir perches high in the ridges of Willamette Valley's Dundee Hills. Our vineyard, named for the famous red volcanic soil type that predominates here, provides our Pinot Noir with unique ripening and spice notes that can only be found in the Dundee Hills. We select a combination of the best blocks and clones from our vineyard and ferment them separately, so that when blended together, they deliver a wine with power and elegance that truly illustrates this unique cool-climate terroir.

TASTING NOTES

Seamless power and finesse, the Jory Hills Pinot Noir shows classic red fruit and spice on the nose and palate as a reminder of the vineyard's famous Jory soils. These blocks and clones, when blended together, deliver an elegant balance between ripe fruit and delicate acidity that continues through the finish.
