THE VINTAGE

The 2024 vintage in Paso Robles was defined by a long, hot summer that led to an early harvest and lower-than-average yields, down about 20%. Harvest began in late August and wrapped up by mid-October. Despite the heat, grapes achieved excellent maturity and retained vibrant acidity, thanks in part to a cool spring and rainy winter that preceded the growing season. The warm conditions and lower yields produced fruit with intense flavor concentration and freshness. Despite the season's challenges, responsiveness in both the vineyard and winery allowed us to overcome obstacles and make the most of opportunities, resulting in a high-quality vintage with balance, structure, and expressive character.

THE VINIFICATION

For the inaugural vintage of 2024 Gotham Series Red Blend, we leaned into the silky texture of Jada Vineyard Merlot, using select barrels from two of our favorite Merlot focused lots of 2024; one composed of 100% Merlot while the second was co-ferment of Merlot and Malbec. The Syrah was selected from four different blocks at Jada Vineyard and provides structure, complexity, and spice. A single lot of a co-ferment of two Cabernet clones (4 and 47.1) was blended in to contribute to structure and add a savory balance to the blend. We used a co-ferment of two clones of Petit Verdot (Alban and clone 2.1) for color and aromatic uplift. All lots were fermented in small 1-4 ton tanks and the wine spent between 5 and 14 days on skins prior to pressing off to tank.
