LES GLORIES HERITAGE

Since the 1920s, Les Glories has honored French winemaking tradition, paying homage to the monks who safeguarded and advanced viticulture by protecting the vines and experimenting with different grape varieties. Through collaboration with multi-generational families across prime wine regions in France, we meticulously select varietals from the best appellations that showcase the unique soils found throughout the country's diverse terroir. Les Glories intertwines the past and present by creating wines that are timeless yet contemporary.

THE CHABLIS APPELLATION

Located in the northern part of Burgundy, halfway between Paris and Beaune, the village of Chablis has an exceptional reputation for producing white wines from Chardonnay. The wine's distinctive character is rooted in its Kimmeridgian clay-limestone soils, an exceptional formation found in only a few regions worldwide, imparting profound minerality, precision, and a refined, crystalline purity.

WINEMAKING

Cold settled prior to fermentation, the wine was fermented in stainless steel tanks and barrels with both primary and malolactic fermentation, then aged for approximately 12 months on fine lees to build texture while preserving freshness and mineral clarity.

TASTING NOTES

The 2023 vintage shows a pale gold hue, bright and clear with golden highlights. The nose is initially subtle, with light smoky and toasted notes, opening to aromas of lime, white flowers, and flint. Precise and well-balanced, the palate is structured with a subtle oak influence, while fine grain and gentle bitterness on the finish add tension, length, and a fresh, mineral-driven character.
