ABOUT THE BRAND

In 1960, Germaine Renard and her husband, André Nominé started Nominé-Renard. Claude, the eldest, joined the family business after studying oenology. Today, his son, Simon Nominé, is at the head of the family house as the fifth generation of winegrowers and third generation of Champagne winemakers.

WINEMAKING TEAM

Nominé-Renard is classified as a GROWER CHAMPAGNE, or Recoltant Manipulant. In the region there are 19,000 producers, of which approximately 5,000 produce Champagne. They own their own vineyards, harvest and press their own grapes, and fully produce their own namesake Champagne. They have full control, ground to glass. You'll see each bottle is marked with the RM designation.

SUSTAINABILITY

The Nominé family owns their 20-hectare estate, spread across six villages, with 36 plots. All their vineyards are certified sustainable, as the family is passionate about taking care of the environment and using the least amount of intervention possible. They are proud to have their farms be HEV and VDC certified, demonstrating their commitment to conservation, water management, biodiversity and responsible waste management.
