

2021 SAN SIMEON PASO ROBLES CABERNET SAUVIGNON



Region/Vintage Notes

Our 2021 Cabernet Sauvignon was farmed from three of our estate vineyards in El Pomar AVA of Paso Robles. El Pomar is a coastal appellation that experiences warm days and cool evenings due to breezes flowing inland through the Templeton Gap. Each of our sites features steep hillsides with rocky or marine-derived soils. The 2021 season saw early winter and spring rainfall with seasonal totals that were just below average, producing typical vine growth. Vines reach deep into the soil for water and nutrients resulting in grapes with highly concentrated flavors. Heatwaves throughout the summer season slowed berry development, keeping them small and the skin to juice ratio something to desire. Warm weather in early October before harvest aided in the fruit's maturity, ideal color, acid, flavor, and tannin.

Winemaker/Tasting Notes

Our 2021 Cabernet Sauvignon was aged in a selection of 60% new French and American Oak barrels and 40% neutral barrels following the fermentation and pressing process. This Cabernet is highlighted by its dark deep hues and robust flavors of plum, black cherry and blackberries. The nose is greeted with aromas of baking spice, nutmeg, and tobacco. With soft, long-lasting leathery tannins, the mid palate is rich and spicy, balancing the wine with a long, round smooth finish.

Sustainability

Sustainability is a top priority at San Simeon. Our Paso Robles Vineyards are certified sustainable by the rigorous California Sustainable Wine Alliance (CSWA). At our Paso Robles winery, solar panels provide 100% of the needed electricity, and wastewater is effectively reclaimed and recycled for additional use.

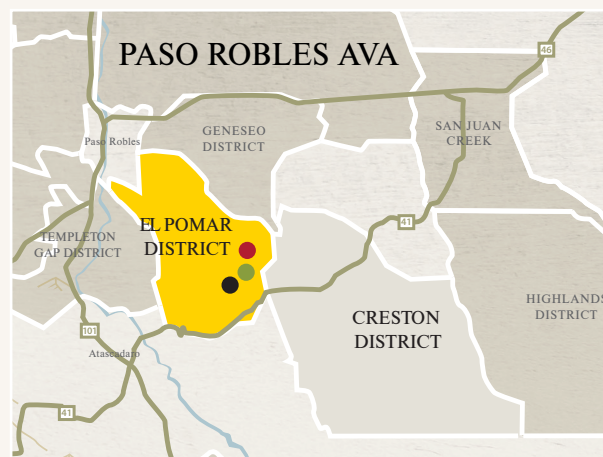
