ABOUT THE BRAND

The name ‘Les Glories’ pays tribute to men who wrote the history of wine in the period of the Middle Ages and the Renaissance. Monks pursued the culture of the vine, brought by the Roman Empire, which would probably have disappeared after its collapse. Les Glories is a small, third-generation producer and was founded in 1921 by Paulin Lebrun, a cooper by trade. The mission is to convey as accurately as possible, the expression of the appellations in the Loire Valley by careful selection, vinification and aging.

WINEMAKING TEAM

Les Glories’ focus is always to increase biodiversity, maintain and improve watersheds and the water cycle, to enhance all biological processes for carbon sequestration, to continuously increase the resilience of the ecosystems to climate change. This involves maximizing nutrients, minimum plowing, rowcropping and grassy strips.
