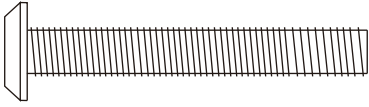

ASSEMBLY TIPS

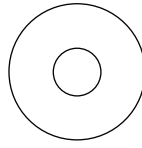
Make sure you understand the following tips before you begin to assemble your game table.

1. Start all bolts by hand before tightening.
2. An electric screwdriver is helpful in assembly. However, please set at low torque and use extreme caution with an electric screwdriver because you could overtighten the hardware and strip the screws.
3. Some drawings or images in this manual may not look exactly like your product. Please read and understand the text before starting each assembly step.
4. Assembly can be made both simpler and less timely by first unpacking all parts, and matching and organizing them to the Parts Identifier. This will greatly help you become familiar with the parts before and during assembly.
5. Some of this assembly can be made easier – by placing the parts and building the assembly on a pair of saw horses. A table can be used also as long as the top is well protected from any scratches that could occur. The table or saw horses would need to be structurally strong enough to support this weight.

STEP 1

Attach the **P4** Under Cabinet Support Braces onto the **P1** Main Cabinet using the Pre-drilled holes with **H4** Phillips Round Head Screws as shown in **FIGURE 1**.

Do not strip out the screws.



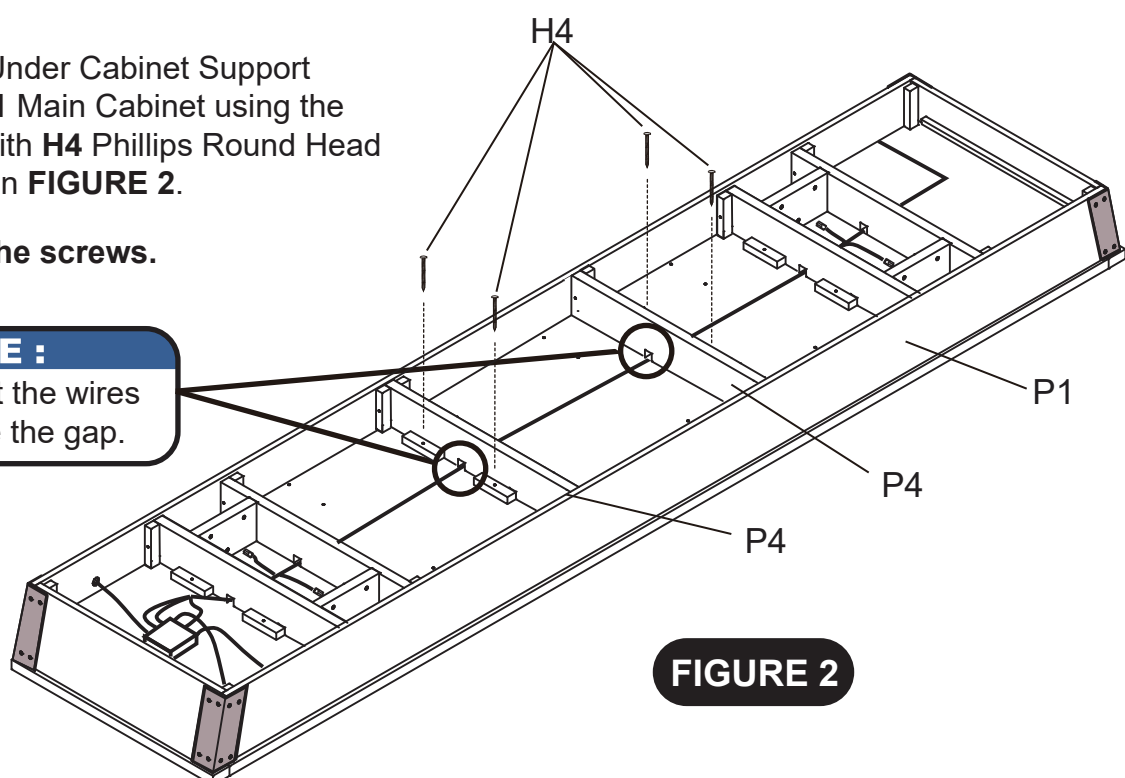
STEP 2

Reinforce the **P4** Under Cabinet Support Braces onto the **P1** Main Cabinet using the Pre-drilled holes with **H4** Phillips Round Head Screws as shown in **FIGURE 2**.

Do not strip out the screws.

NOTICE :

Please note that the wires must be inside the gap.

2 pcs - **P2** Left Leg
2 pcs - **P3** Right Leg

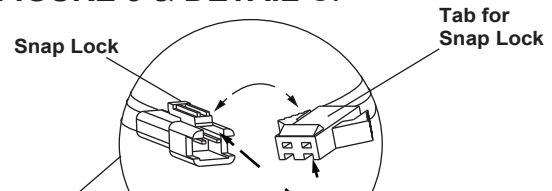

STEP 3

Firstly, pull the leg wire through the wooden board and connect the Snap Lock & Tab for Snap Lock at this step as shown in **FIGURE 3 & DETAIL B**.

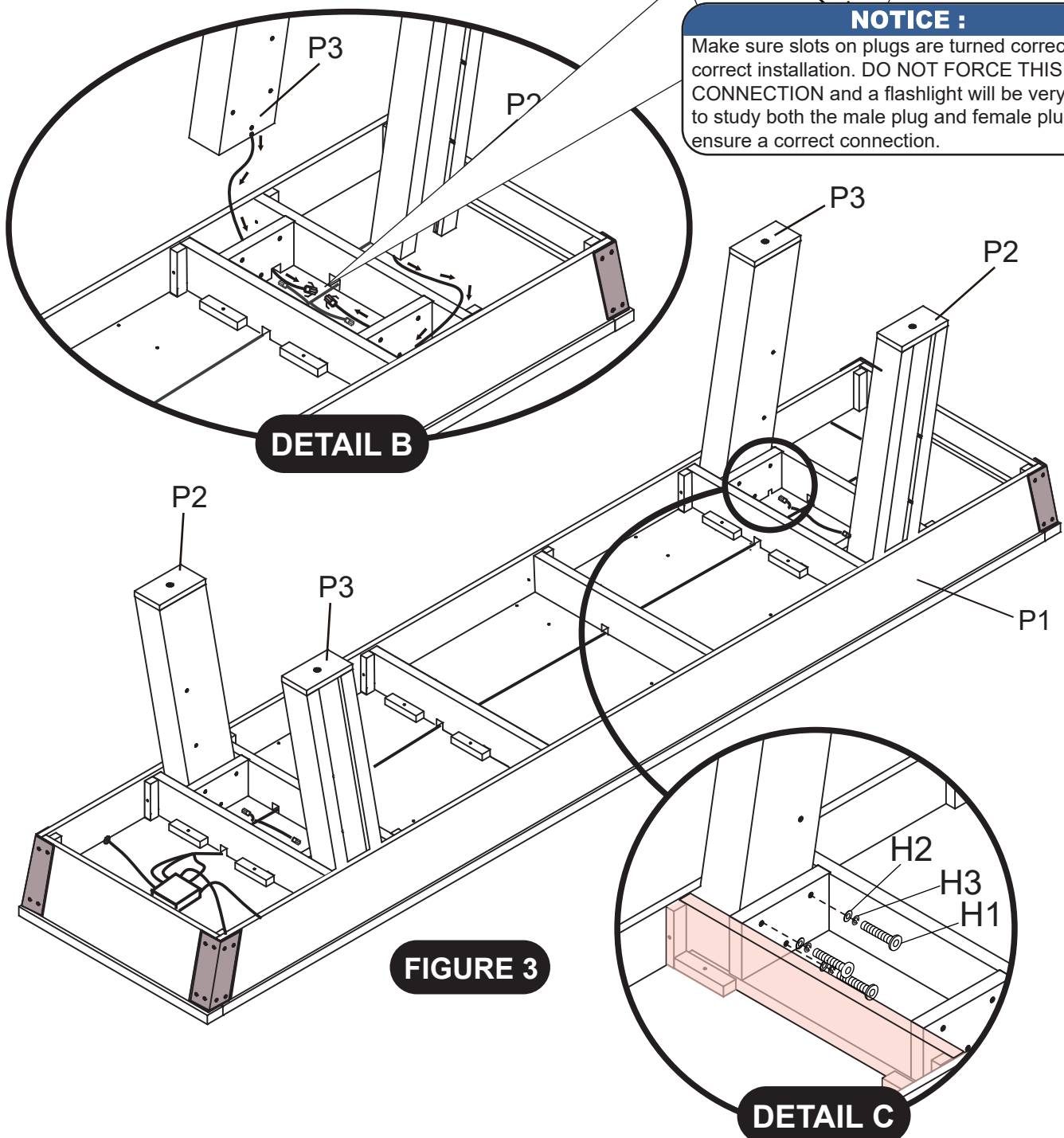
Attach the **P2** Left Leg & **P3** Right Leg onto the **P1** Main Cabinet using the **H1** Allen Head Bolt & **H2** Flat Washer & **H3** Lock Washer as shown in **FIGURE 3 & DETAIL C**.

Do not tighten H1 Bolts on this time.



NOTICE :

Make sure slots on plugs are turned correctly for correct installation. **DO NOT FORCE THIS CONNECTION** and a flashlight will be very helpful to study both the male plug and female plug to ensure a correct connection.



PARTS REQUIRED

2 pcs - **P5** End Leg Panel
4 pcs - **P6** Leg Leveler

8 pcs - **H2** Flat Washer
8 pcs - **H3** Lock Washer
8 pcs - **H5** Allen Head Bolt
1 pc - **T1** M6 Allen Wrench

STEP 4

Attach the **P5** End Leg Panels onto the **Legs** using the **H5** Allen Head Bolt & **H2** Flat Washer & **H3** Lock Washer as shown in **FIGURE 4 & DETAIL D**.

Tighten all H1 Bolts using the T1 Allen Wrench.

Lastly thread the **P6** Leg Levelers as shown in **FIGURE 4**.

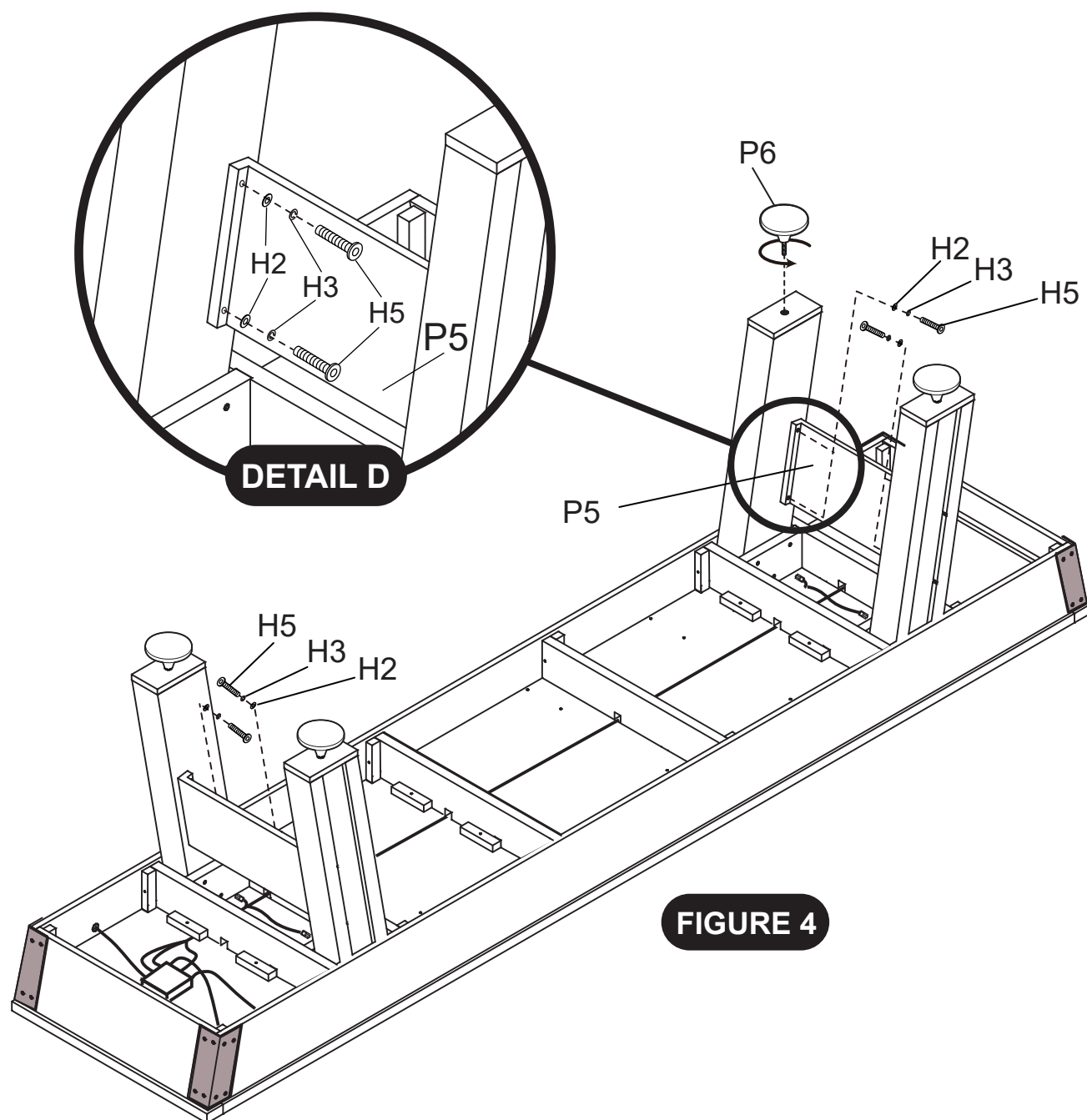

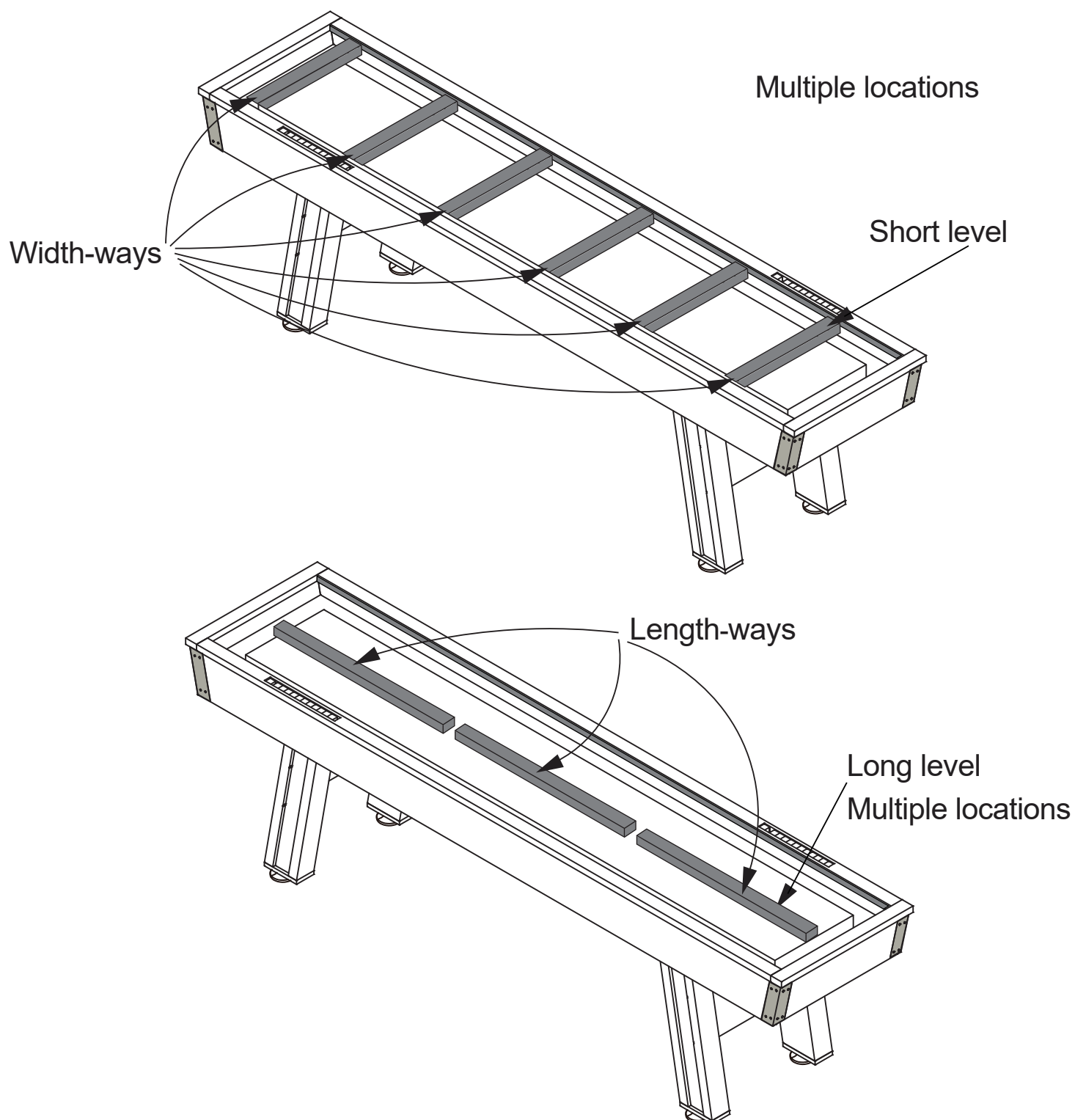
PLAYFIELD LEVELING

Tools Required: A short carpenter's level (approximately 12")
A long carpenter's level (approximately 42" to 48")

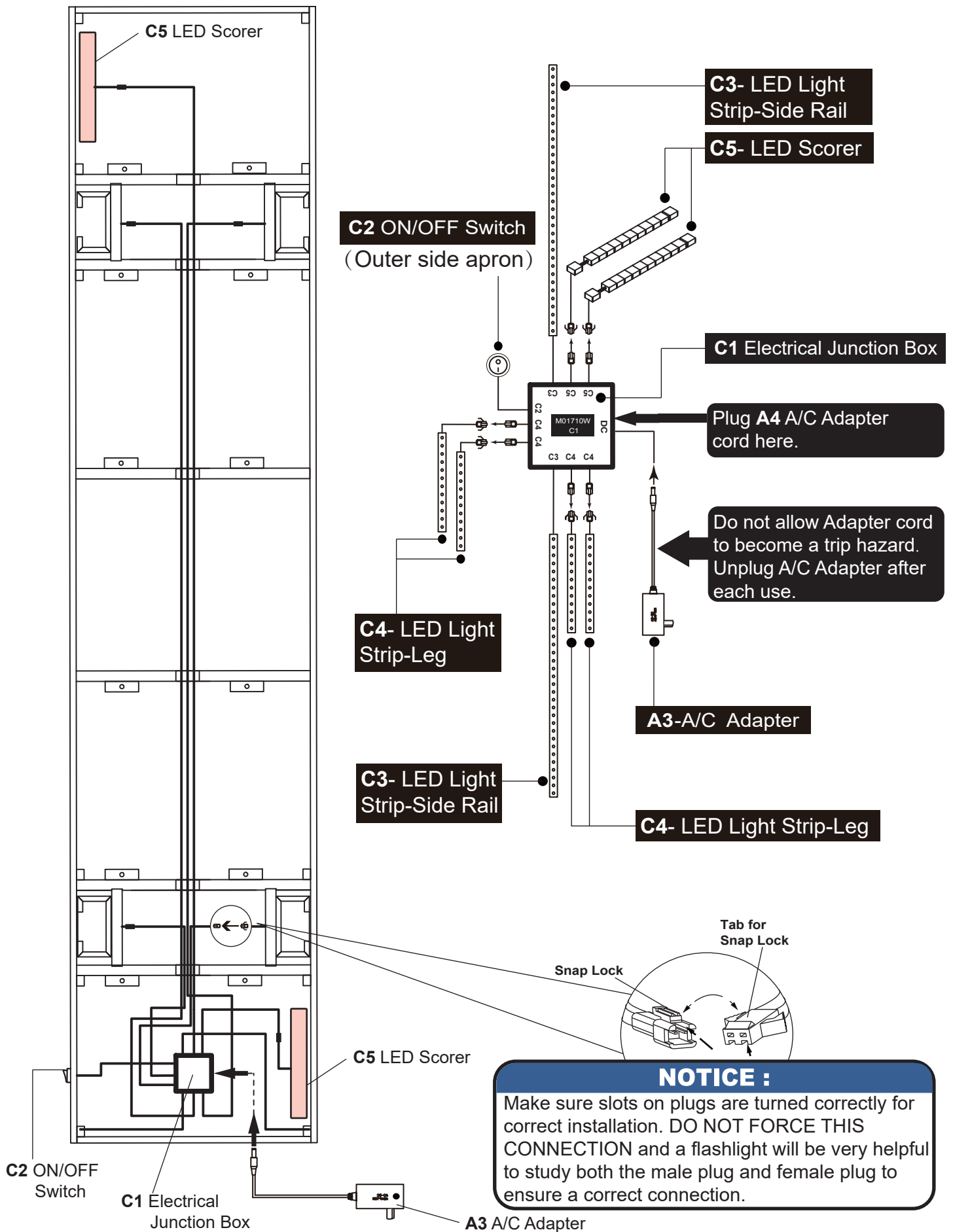
Place the table where it will be kept.

Use the levels to determine the lowest area(s) of the playfield.

Slowly screw the leg leveler(s) outward to raise the low part of the playfield until it is level.

CARE AND USE FOR YOUR TABLE

1. Before first use and frequently there after, **apply furniture polish to shuffleboard playfield** to insure long life of playfield and the most competitive level of play.
2. Always shake shuffleboard wax before applying to table.
3. Apply an adequate amount of shuffleboard wax over the entire length of shuffleboard playfield so puck will always "float" consistently over the entire length of the playfield.
4. Use spray furniture polish to clean all exterior surfaces of your game table.
5. This product is intended for **INDOOR** use only.
6. **DO NOT** sit, climb or lean on the table.
7. **DO NOT** drag the table when moving it. This will damage the legs.
8. **DO NOT** set drinks on the table.
9. **DO NOT** allow A/C Adapter cord to become a trip hazard. Unplug A/C Adapter after each use.

SHUFFLEBOARD GAME RULES

Shuffleboards Game Rules - Information on how to play shuffleboard including rules and instructions on how to keep score in the most common shuffleboard games.

Common Shuffleboard Game Rules

Have you ever wondered how to play shuffleboard? Here are the most common shuffleboard rules that generally apply to most games. The rules usually require that you alternately take turns sliding, by hand, all 4 of your weights against the ones from your opponent. Try to make it to the highest scoring area on the shuffleboard without falling off the end of the board into the alley. In order to earn points your weights need to be the farthest down the board. Some of the strategy and fun really comes into play when you knock off your opponents' weights, outdistance them or use your weights to protect your other highest scoring weights.

Usually the most common games are played either to 15 or 21 points. The sections below cover the shuffleboard game rules for the most famous (and fun) shuffleboard games.

Shuffleboard Game Rules Scoring:

EXAMPLE: If a Red Weight is the most distant Weight from the playing end at the completion of a round, Red becomes the winner of the round, and only Red can score. To determine Red's score, total the value of each Red Weight that lies ahead of the leading Blue Weight. Red Weights which are either blocked or which lie behind the leading Blue Weight are not scored. If there are no Blue Weights remaining on the board, all remaining Red Weights are scored.

Knock Off Shuffleboard Rules:

Knock Off shuffleboard is one of the simplest and most common ways to play the game. However, just because the rules are simple to remember does not mean the game is easy to play. Any game of shuffleboard can be improved with patience and strategy, and this one is no different. Learn more about the Knock Off Game Rules.

Horse Collar Shuffleboard Rules:

Need a high scoring affair? Horse Collar shuffleboard is played one-on-one or with teams, and the winner must score 51 points. With a fun betting element for those who can't score and huge shots worth 26 points, Horse Collar is a game that everyone will be wanting to play. Learn more about the Horse Collar Game Rules.

Tap & Draw Shuffleboard Rules:

Unlike Knock Off participants, Tap & Draw players who get to shuffle the first puck have the best advantage. Tap & Draw is played and scored similarly to other versions of the game, but there is one major difference. In Tap & Draw, you can attempt to send your own puck farther up the board by tapping it with another one of your pucks. Learn more about the Tap & Draw Game Rules.

Crazy Eight Shuffleboard Rules:

As far as physically throwing the pucks and keeping score, Crazy Eight presents a version of shuffleboard that is pretty similar to many of the classic games people play. However, Crazy Eight is a fun and challenging version of shuffleboard due to the way that points are actually scored. Learn more about the Crazy Eight Game Rules.

Target Shuffleboard Rules:

Just like darts, archery and rifle, this shuffleboard game gives you the chance to aim and shoot at a target. With hopes of scoring one, two, three or four-points, use your skills to shoot for a target and bring home the winning game. Only the winner scores in each round, so choose your play wisely. Learn more about Target Game Rules.

Replacement of LED Light Strip(s)-Side Rail

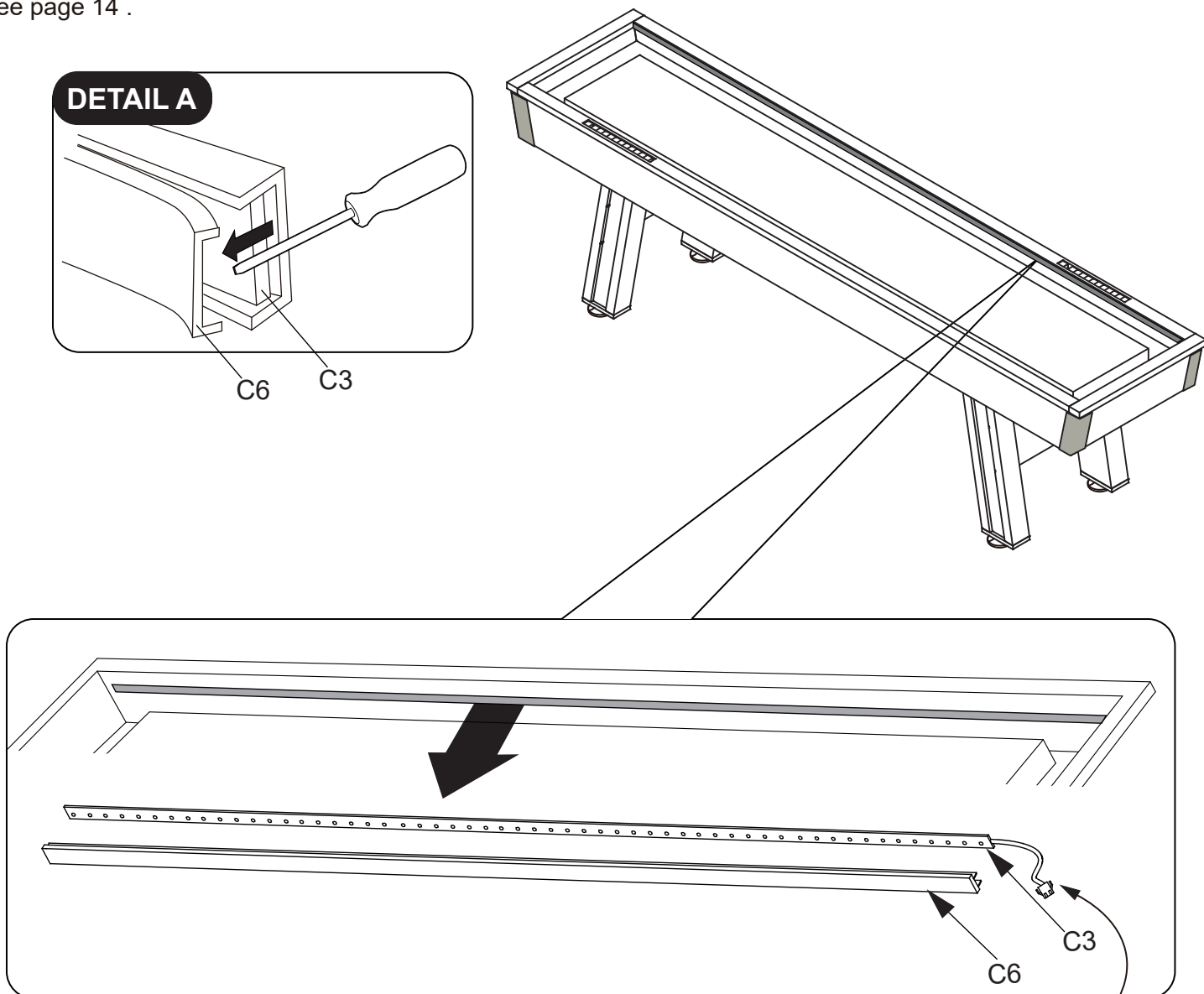
STEP ONE :

Should the LED lights not be working in the side rail - Firstly , make sure the A/C Adapter is plugged in to a live A/C outlet properly. Secondly , make sure the A/C Adapter cord (**A3**) is tightly plugged in to its electronic control box under the table . Lastly, make sure all LED Strip light connections are snugly plugged into the Main Electronic Unit (**C1**) . At this point , should the LED Strip Lights still not be working , please disconnect the A/C power to the table before proceeding . **A call will be required to our Customer Service Department to acquire the necessary replacement part(s)** .

STEP TWO :

If the LED Light Strip needs to be replaced on the **P1** Cabinet inner side, **carefully pry the C6 LED Light Strip -Side Rail Cover out of the apron with the help of a flat blade screwdriver as shown in DETAIL A**, then remove the C3 LED Light Strip from the table.

The LED Light Wire Connection will need to be disconnected first, the connection is under the table, please see page 14 .



STEP THREE :

See page 14 for disconnect / connect instructions for this electrical connection.

Replacement of LED Light Strip(s)-Leg

STEP ONE :

Should the LED lights not be working in a Leg (s) - Firstly , make sure the wall outlet cord is plugged in to a live A/C outlet properly. Secondly , make sure the ON/Off Switch **(C2)** is in the "ON" position . Thirdly , make sure the A/C Adapter **(A3)** is tightly plugged in to its outlet under the table . Lastly, make sure all **(P2)** & **(P3)** connections are snugly plugged into the Junction Box **(C1)** . At this point , should the LED leg(s) lights still not be working, please disconnect the A/C power to the table before proceeding .

A call will be required to our Customer Service Department to acquire the necessary replacement part(s) .

STEP TWO :

Unplug the connecting wires of LED Light Strip-Side Leg **(C4)** from the Junction Box **(C1)**.

STEP THREE :

Need six strong ADULTS to turn the table over and place the table onto soft carpet or a non- abrasive surface. Gently remove the leg from the table cabinet using a **(T1)** M6 Allen Wrench.

STEP FOUR :

Unscrew the screw of the LED Light Strip-Leg Cover **(C7)** and slide out the Cover **(C7)** from the Leg slot.

STEP FIVE :

Unscrew the screws of the LED Light Strip-Leg **(C4)** and gently pull apart the LED Light Strip-Leg from the connection plug.

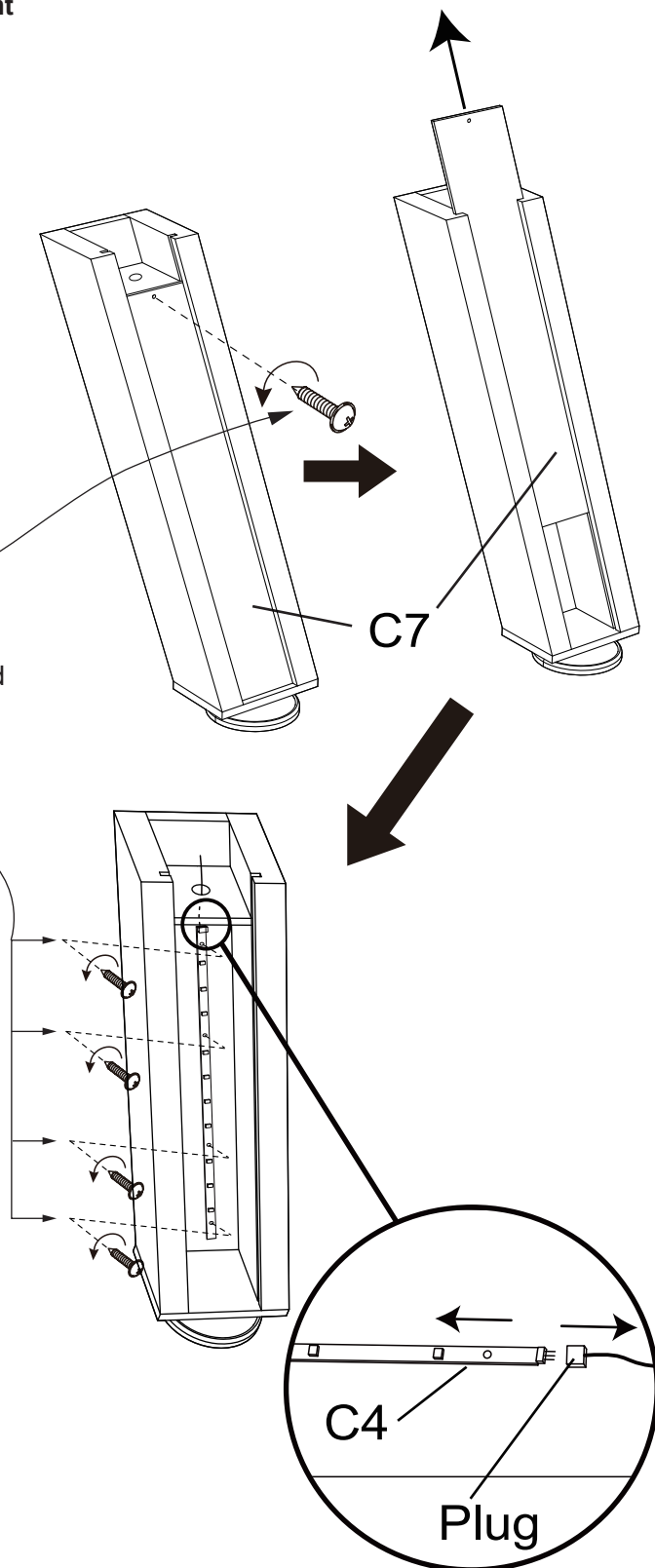
STEP SIX :

Install the replacement LED Light Strip-Leg **(C4)** and carefully reattach the LED Light Strip-Leg Cover **(C7)**.

STEP SEVEN :

Reinstall the leg into the table cabinet using a **(T1)** M6 Allen Wrench.

Need six strong ADULTS to turn the table back.



Replacement of LED Scorer(S)

STEP ONE :

Should the LED scorer(s) not be working - Firstly , make sure the wall outlet cord is plugged in to a live A/C outlet properly. Secondly , make sure the ON/Off Switch **(C2)** is in the "ON" position . Thirdly , make sure the A/C Adapter **(A3)** is tightly plugged in to its outlet under the table . Lastly, make sure two (C5) LED scorers connections are snugly plugged into the Junction Box **(C1)**. At this point , should the LED scorer(s) still not be working, please disconnect the A/C power to the table before proceeding.

A call will be required to our Customer Service Department to acquire the necessary replacement part(s).

STEP TWO :

Unscrew the screws from three positions. Sliding the **(C8)** LED Beads will expose the each screw as shown in **FIGURE 1**.

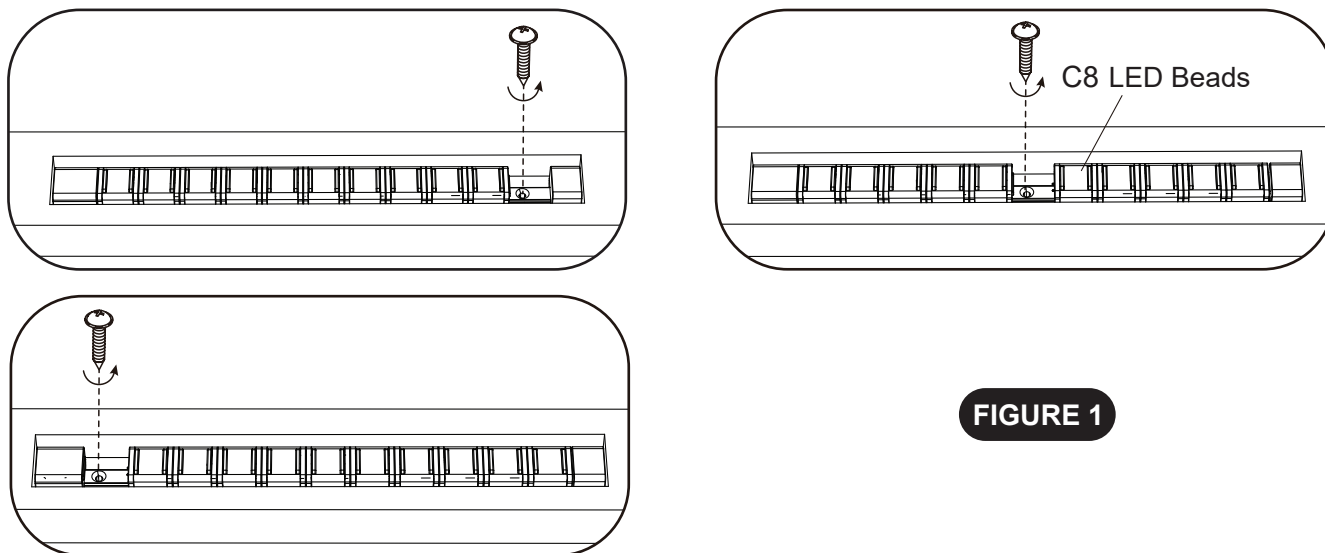

STEP THREE :

Make sure whether the **(C9)** LED scorer rail host is damaged or the **(C8)** LED Beads is damaged. Select the corresponding replacement steps below based on the damaged components.

Damage phenomenon

- If some **(C8)** LED Beads are on and some are not, it can be determined that some **(C8)** LED Beads are damaged and need to be replaced.
Please refer to the replacement instructions of **LED Slider damaged** in page 17.
- If all the **(C8)** LED Beans don't light up, it is necessary to consider whether the **(C9)** LED Scorer Rail Host is damaged, and also whether it is the first bead near the+electrode that is damaged as shown in **FIGURE 2**.
The detection method can be found on page 16.

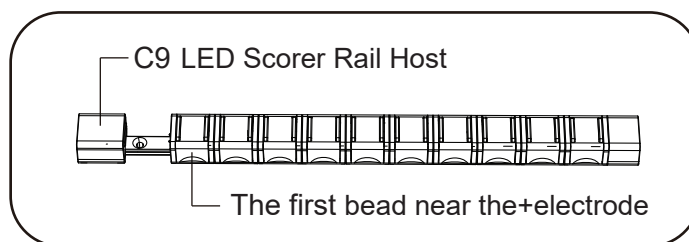

Unscrew the two screws that in the end of LED scorer and remove the Fixed Block.

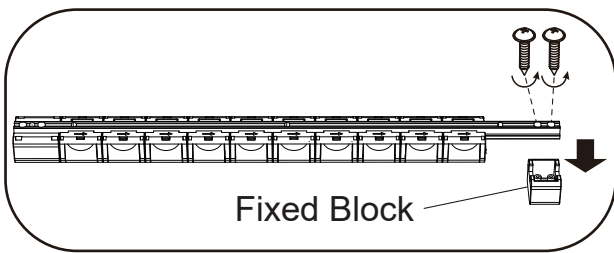

Take out all the (C8) LED Beads from the track.

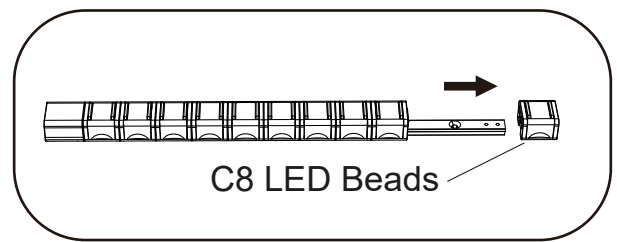

STEP Three:

Insert the other (C8) LED Bead (except the first bead near the+electrode) one by one from the gap to reach the LED Rail Host as shown in **FIGURE 5 & DETAIL A**.

If the LED Bead lights up during the testing process, it indicates that the LED is not damaged, it is only LED bead damaged. Please refer to the replacement instructions of **LED Slider damaged** in page 17.

If all LED beads do not light up when they come into contact with the LED rail host alone, it indicates that LED rail host is damaged. Please refer to the replacement instructions of **LED Scorer Rail Host damaged** in page 16.

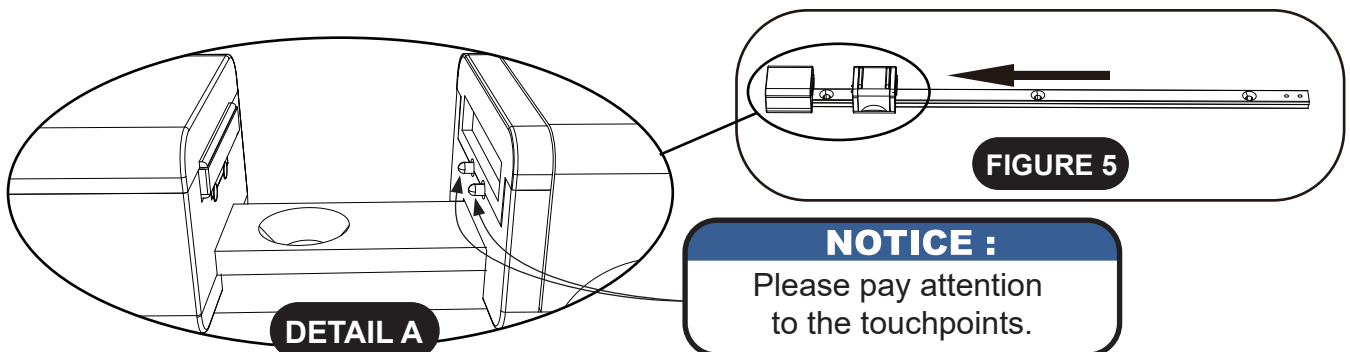

Pull out (C9) LED scorer rail host and wire as shown in **FIGURE 5**. Make sure the connections are unplugged from the Junction Box (C1)

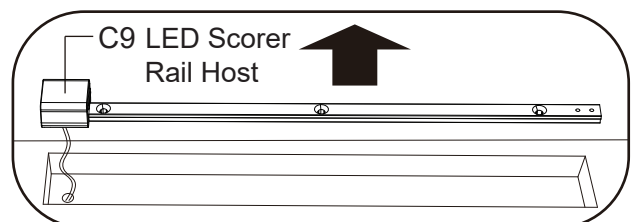

Take out all the (C8) LED Beads from the gap.

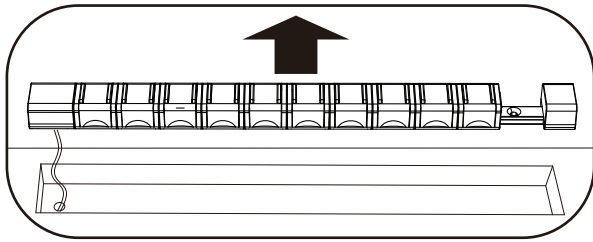
