ASSEMBLY TIPS

Make sure you understand the following tips before you begin to assemble your game table.

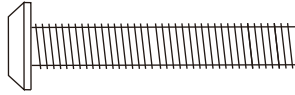
1. Start all bolts by hand before tightening.
2. An electric screwdriver is helpful in assembly. However, please set at low torque and use extreme caution with an electric screwdriver because you could overtighten the hardware and strip the screws.
3. Some drawings or images in this manual may not look exactly like your product. Please read and understand the text before starting each assembly step.
4. Assembly can be made both simpler and less timely by first unpacking all parts, and matching and organizing them to the Parts Identifier. This will greatly help you become familiar with the parts before and during assembly.
5. Some of this assembly can be made easier – by placing the parts and building the assembly on a pair of saw horses. A table can be used also as long as the top is well protected from any scratches that could occur. The table or saw horses would need to be structurally strong enough to support this weight.

Step 1

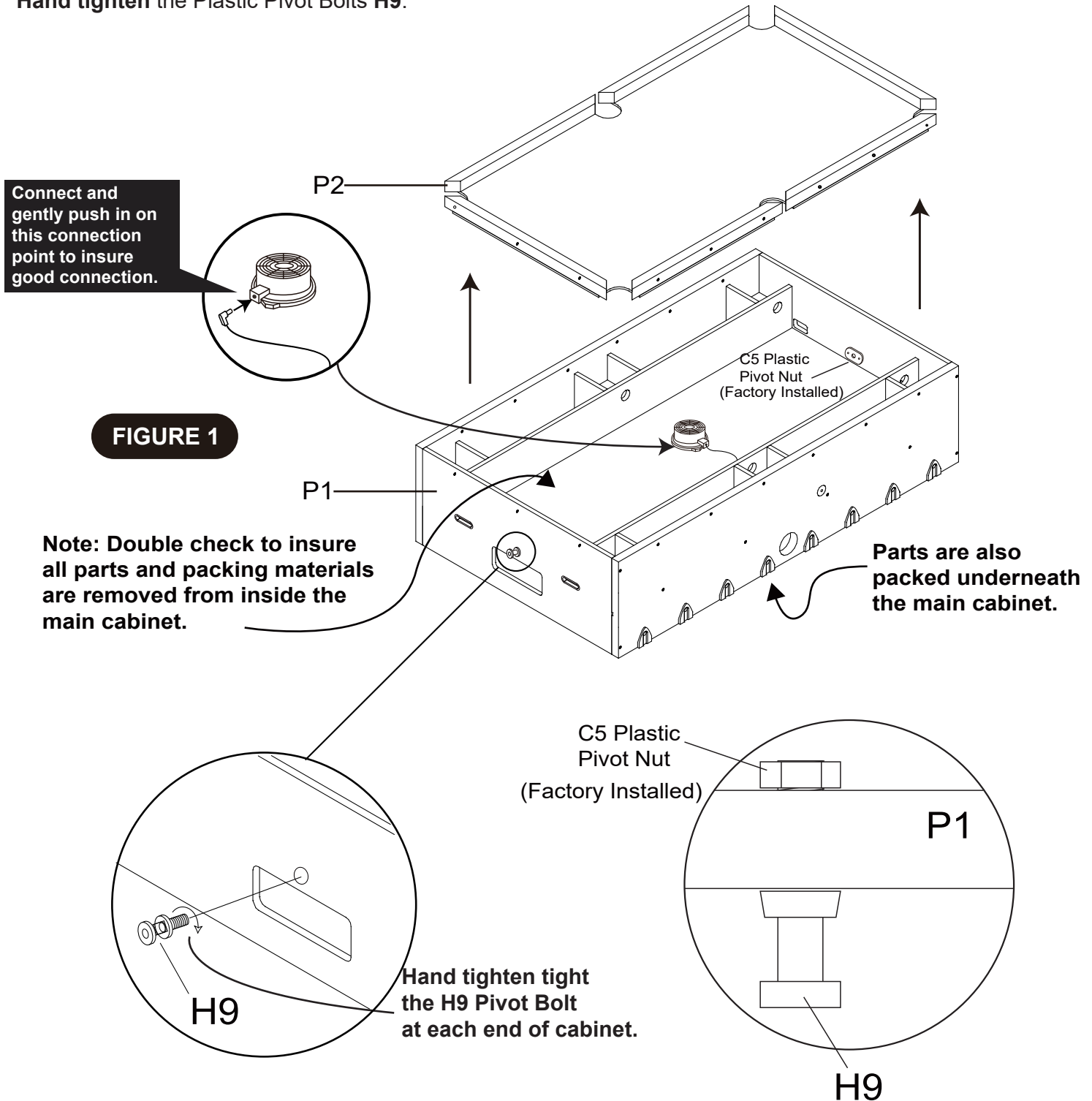
Please inspect the main cabinet and playing surfaces before putting the game together.

Remove all the contents from inside the carton and verify that you have all listed parts as shown on the part list.

NOTE: Parts are packed inside and under the table cabinet. Remove the billiards playfield **P2** from Main Cabinet. Inside the table cabinet you will find parts needed to assemble your table.

Attach the Plastic Pivot Bolts **H9** to the Plastic Pivot Nuts **C5** to each end of Main Cabinet.

Hand tighten the Plastic Pivot Bolts **H9**.

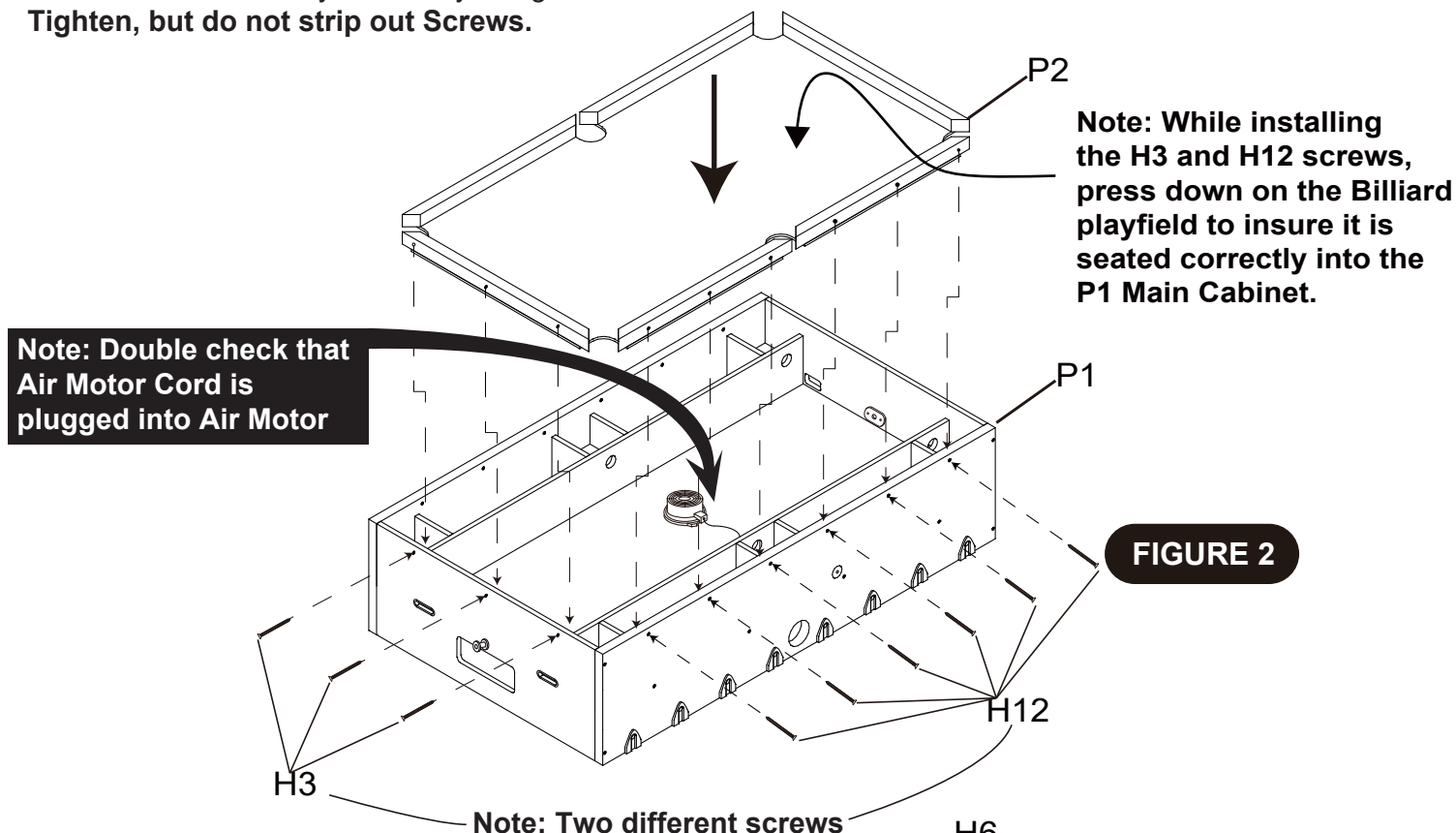

Step 2 Before Starting Step 2, Double Check That All Loose Table Components and Packing Material Are Removed From The Main Table Cabinet.

When all the parts are out of the Main Table Cabinet **P1**, replace the Billiards Playfield .
Attach the Billiards Playfield **P2** by using screws **H3** and **H12**
Tighten, but do not strip out Screws.



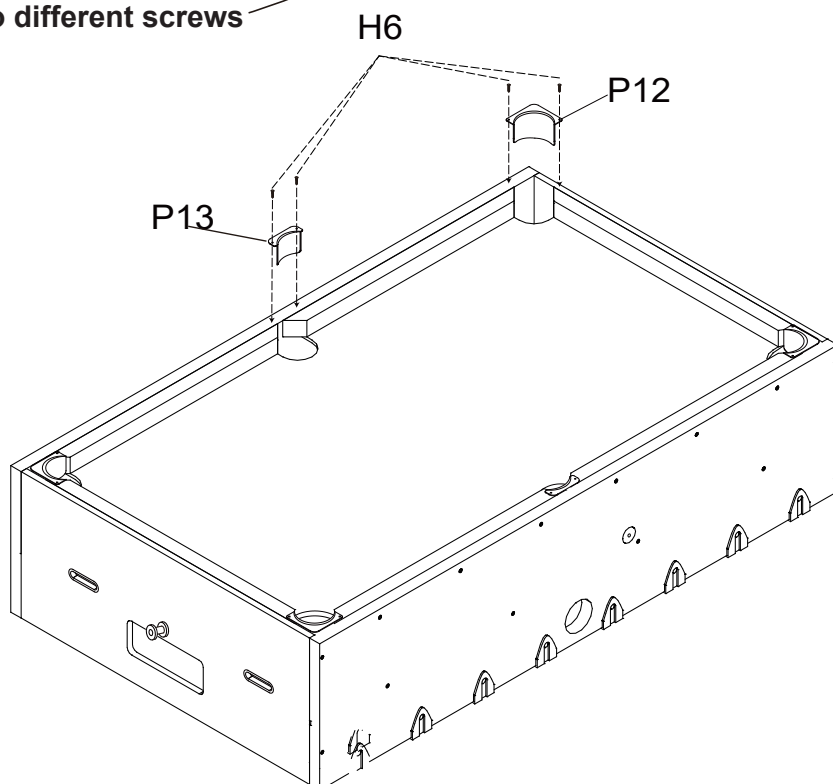

Install Corner Pockets Shields **P12**
and Side Pocket Shields **P13** into

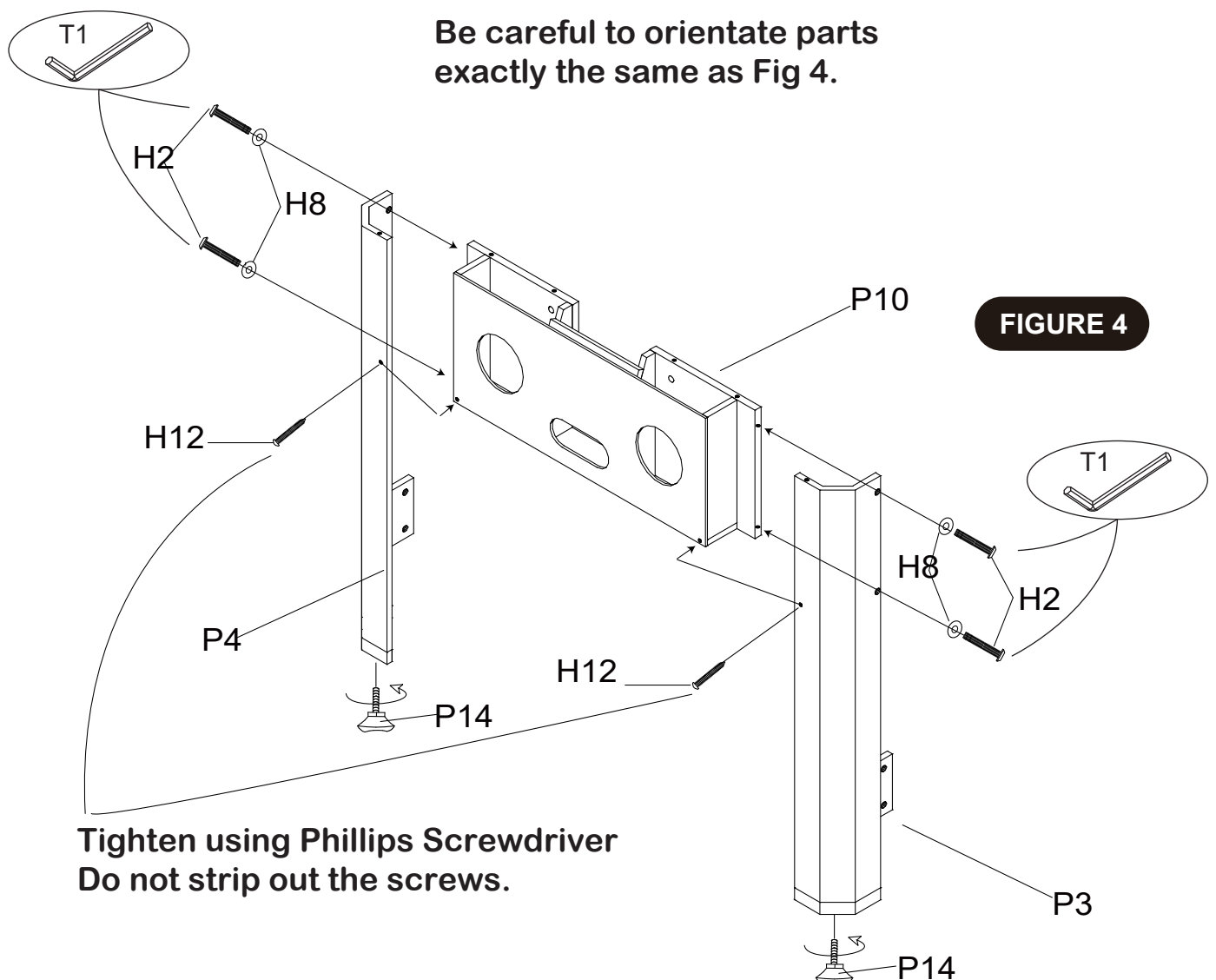

Step 4 (Build 2 Identical Assemblies, One For Each End)

Attach the Right leg **P3** and Left Leg **P4** to the Leg Top End Apron **P10** by inserting Bolts **H2** with washers **H8** into the predrilled holes of the legs and into the Barrel Nuts. Tighten using the **T1** Allen Wrench. Screw the Legs **P3 & P4** to the Leg End Apron **P10** using the Screws **H12**.

Tighten, but do not strip out screws H12.

Install leg levelers **P14** to the bottom of each Leg **P3 & P4**.

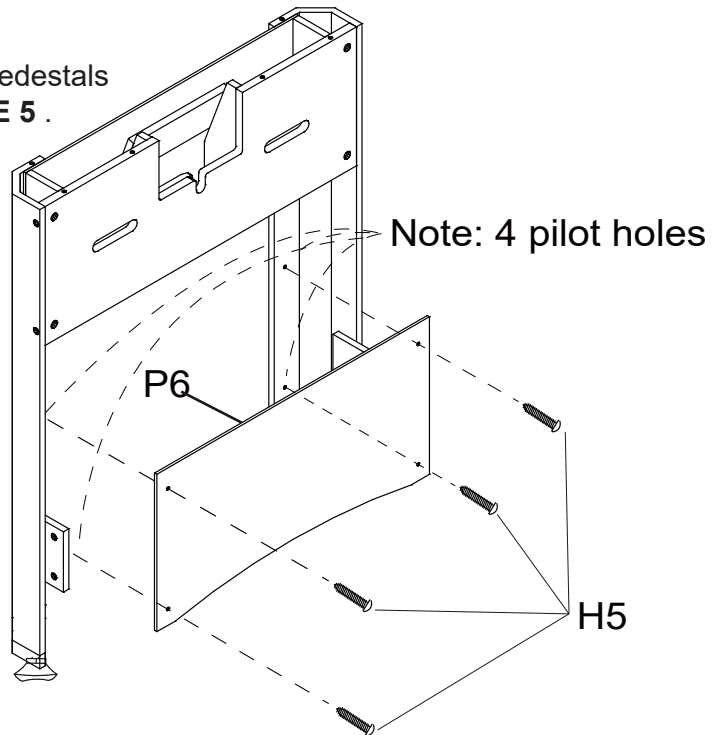

Step 5 (Build 2 Identical Assemblies)

Attach the End Leg Panel **P6** to the assembled leg pedestals using screws **H5** into pilot holes as shown in **FIGURE 5**.

Tighten, but do not strip out screws H5.

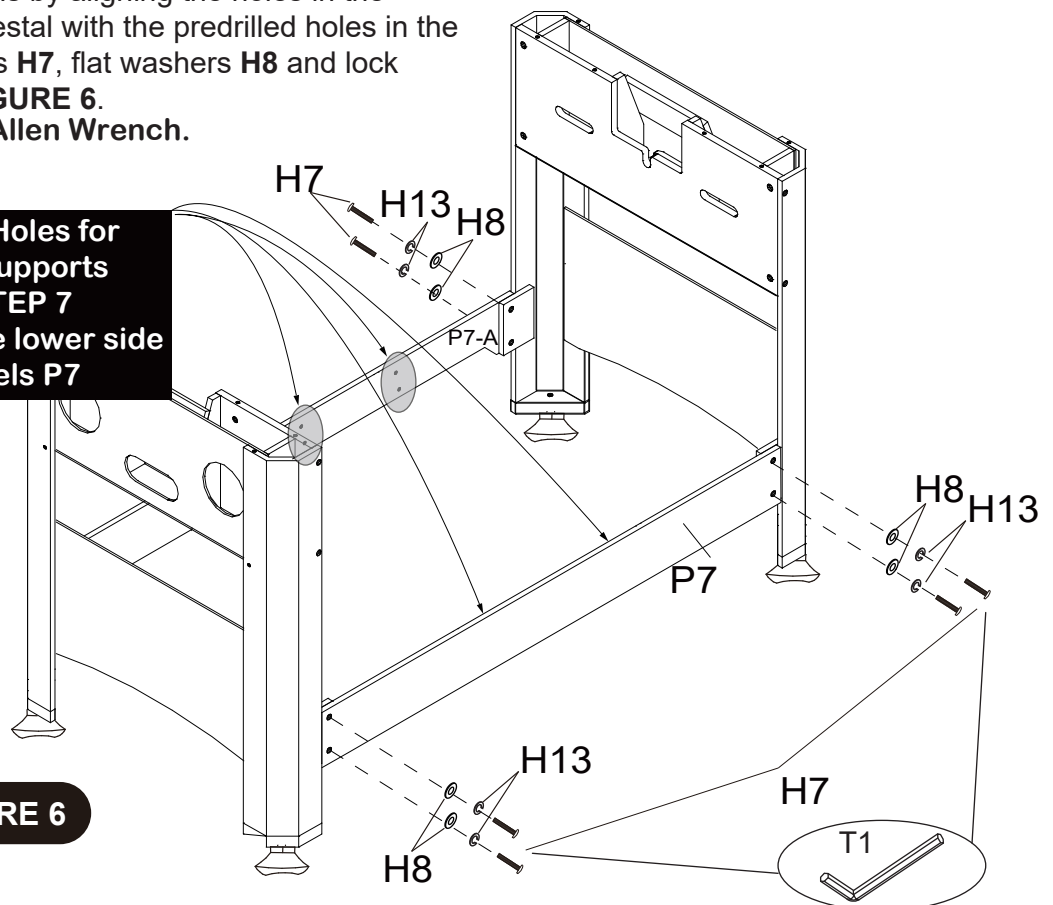
Step 6

With the help of another adult, attach the Side Leg Panels **P7** to the assembled leg pedestals by aligning the holes in the corner braces on the leg pedestal with the predrilled holes in the Side Leg Panel **P7** using bolts **H7**, flat washers **H8** and lock washers **H13** as shown in **FIGURE 6**.

Tighten H7 Bolts using T1 Allen Wrench.

Note: The Pilot Holes for Center Frame Supports installation in STEP 7 should be on the lower side of Side Leg Panels P7

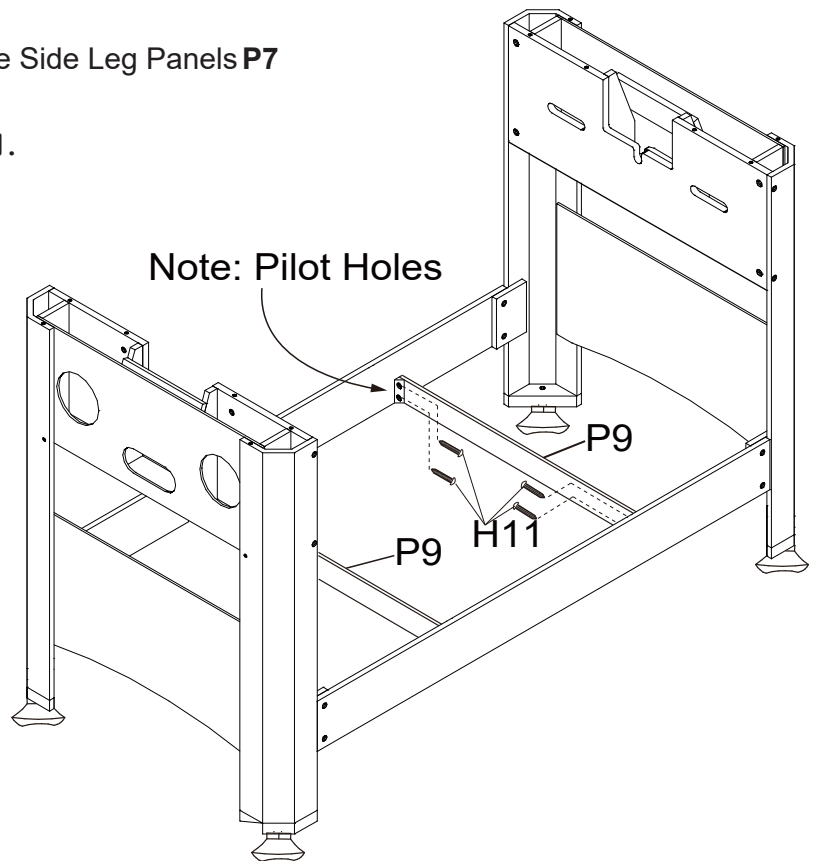

Attach the Center Frame Supports **P9** to the Side Leg Panels **P7** using Screws **H11** as shown in **FIGURE 7**.

Tighten, but do not strip out screws H11.

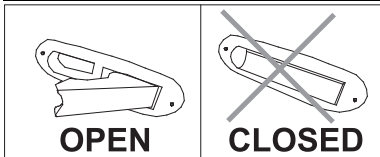

Step 8

Install the Main Cabinet **P1** by sliding the Plastic Pivot Bolts **H9**, already attached to the end's of the cabinet, into the 2 slots on each Leg End Apron **P10**. Make sure the plastic pivot bolts **H9** rests in the slots on each end of the Leg Top End Apron **P10**.

IMPORTANT NOTE:
Make sure all 4 lock / latches are in "open" position before installing the main cabinet into the slots.

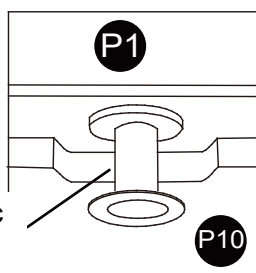

Step 9

Attach the Leg End Top Panels **P5** to the assembled leg pedestals by aligning the holes in the Leg Top Panels **P5** with the predrilled holes in the top of the Leg Top End Apron **P10**, and attach with screws **H1** as shown in **FIGURE 9**.

Tighten, but do not strip out screws **H1**.

 Close all 4 locks/latches before proceeding to Step 9.

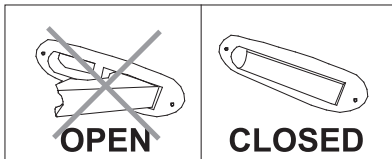
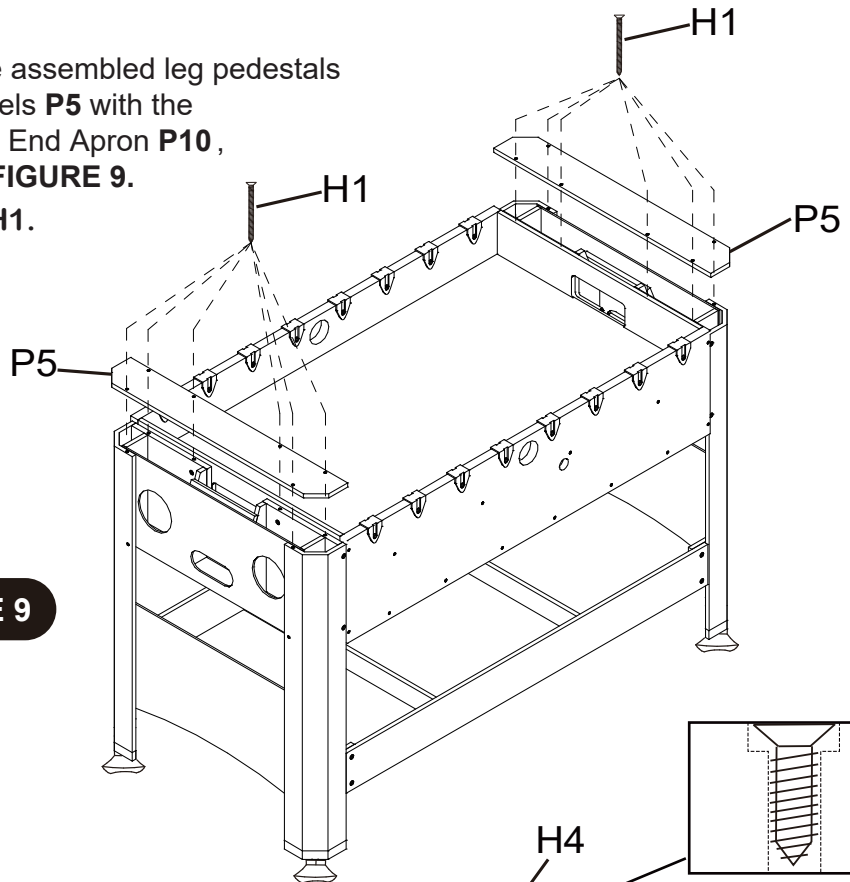

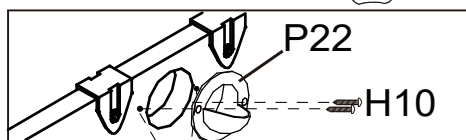
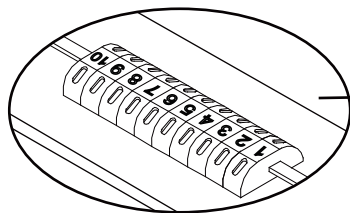
Step 10

Attach Manual Scorers **P11** to the Leg Top Panels **P5** using screws **H4**.

Attach Entry Cups **P22** to the Main Cabinet **P1** using screws **H10**, as shown in **FIGURE 10**.

Tighten, but do not strip out screws **H4** and **H10**.

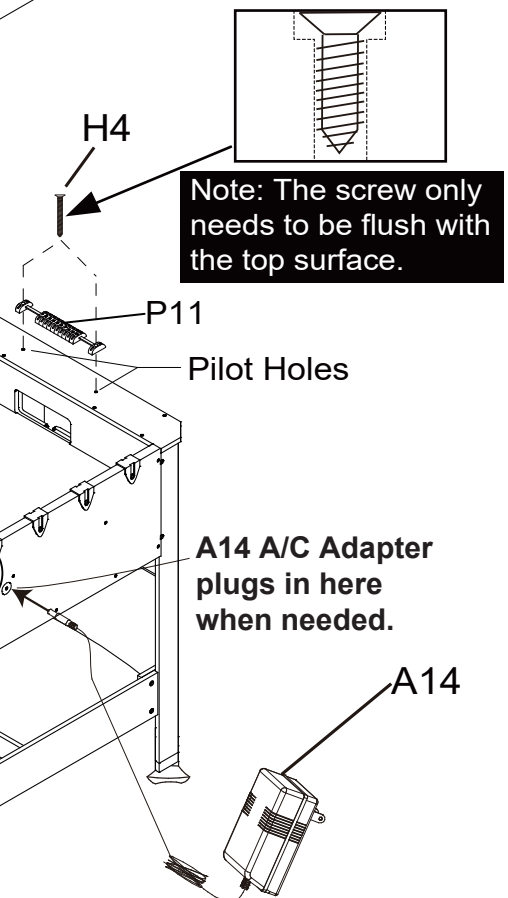
Note: Always disconnect the **A14** A/C Adapter from the wall outlet and main cabinet when play is completed or when not in use.

Step 11

FIRST: Insert the Rod Handles **P21** onto the rod ends with the hole as shown in **FIGURE 11A**.

Note: It may be necessary to vertically tap the Rod Handle, end down on the floor, to insure the Rod Handle is all the way on the player rod.

Second: Place the Player Rods into the cabinet bushings as per the player placement diagram below.

Third: Snap the Removable Bushing Cap **A16** into the female bushing as shown in **FIGURE 11B**.

When you finish playing the Soccer Game and want to play a different game, squeeze the Push Lock of the Removable Bushing Caps **A16** and remove the Bushings.

NOTE: There will be four rod handles on each side of the table. It is critical that you set the rods as shown below so the players will be correctly placed.

NOTE: Rod Handle should be placed on rod end WITH THE HOLE OR DIMPLE.

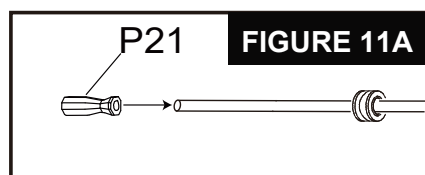

Step 12 (Rotate Table To Play Billiards)

To swivel table, first - remove all 16 pcs Removable Bushing Caps **A16**.

Second - remove and stow all Player Rods as per Diagram below.

Third - replace all 16 pcs Removable Bushing Caps **A16**.

Open or unlock all 4 Lock /Latches. And very carefully swivel the main cabinet.

Close or lock all 4 Lock /Latches to play the Billiards Game.

NOTE: All Soccer Rods must be removed before rotating the table. Also make sure A/C adapter cord is disconnected from the table.

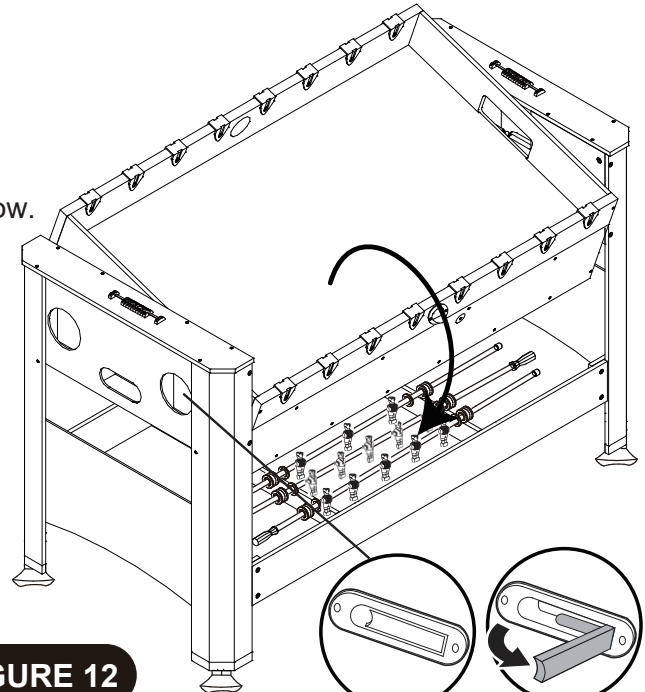
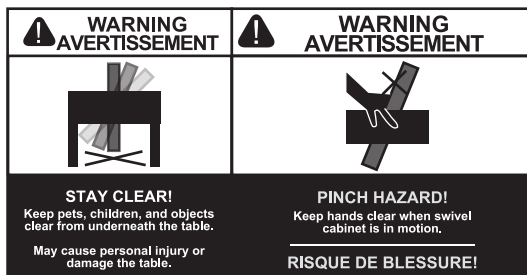

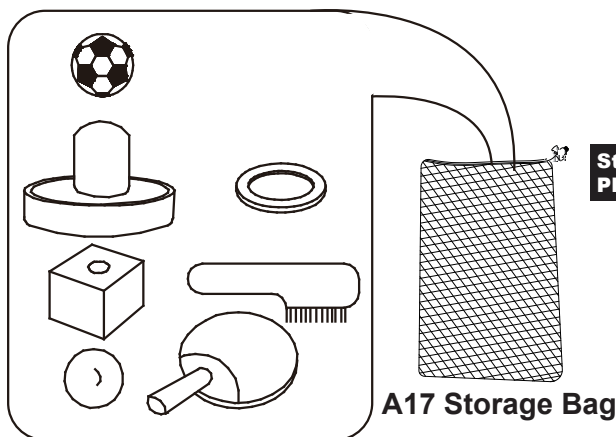
Step 13 (Remove Player Rods, But Do Not Rotate Table To Play Air Hockey or Table Tennis)

Store the soccer player rods on the Center Frame Supports **P9** under the table to play the Air Hockey Game.

Place the Table Tennis Board **P8** onto the Soccer Top Aprons and insert the net posts **A13** and net **A10** to play the Table Tennis Game.

Place the Table Tennis Board **P8** onto the Soccer Top Aprons and insert the net posts **A13** and net **A10** to play the Table Tennis Game.

Store the accessories into the **A17** Storage bag when not in use.

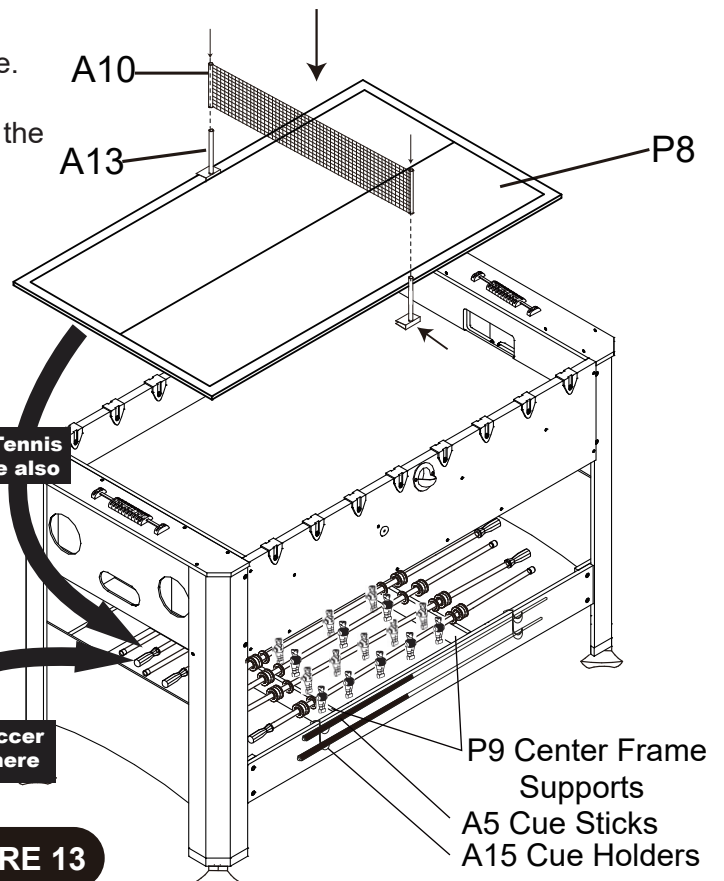

AIR POWERED HOCKEY:

1. This game is designed to be played with two (2) players, one at each end. Plug in A/C Adapter.
2. Play begins when the puck is placed on the playing surface. Players must hit the puck with the hand-held pushers and attempt to shoot into the opponent's goal.
3. One point is given when a puck is shot into the opponent's goal.
4. Winning: the winning goal is accomplished by being the first player to reach a predetermined score or by being the player to score the most points within a given period. Unplug A/C Adapter when not in use.

SOCCER:

1. This game is intended for 2-4 players. Competing teams will be on opposite sides of the table from one another.
2. Players must use the player rods to maneuver the ball into your opponent's goal to score one point.
3. Spinning the rods with uncontrollable force is not allowed.
4. If a ball comes to a complete stop, a timeout occurs and the ball is dropped into the middle to start play back up again.

Note: Use the ball entry cup for this if provided on your game table

BILLIARDS:

In the course of play, a player must call each shot in advance, by indicating the ball to be made and the pocket into which it will be made. It is not necessary to indicate details such as cushions, banks, caroms, etc. Failure to make the shot as called results in a loss of turn. If the shot is made as called, then any other balls pocketed remain pocketed. However, if the called shot is not made and any other balls are pocketed, then the shooter's ball(s) that were pocketed would be spotted and any of the opponent's balls would remain pocketed.

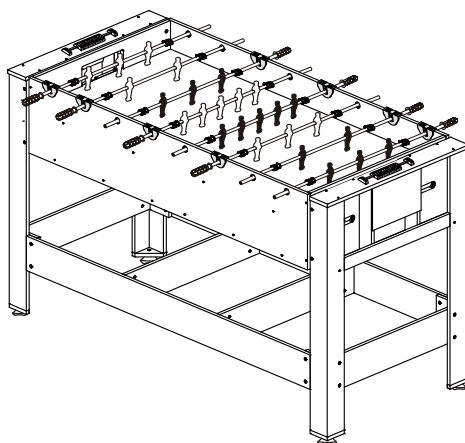
In order to execute a Legal Shot, the first ball hit must be one of the balls in the shooter's group (stripes or solids) and the object ball must be pocketed or the cue ball or any object ball must come into contact with a rail. (Note: It is legal for the shooter to bank the cue ball off a rail before hitting the object ball.) A player who legally pockets a ball continues play until missing or committing a Foul. Once a player's ball group (stripes or solids) is pocketed, the player may play the 8 ball. Again, the player must clearly indicate the intended pocket, even if it appears obvious. A player who legally pockets all of his ball group and the 8 ball is the winner.

FOULS

1. Failure to execute a legal shot as defined above.
2. A scratch shot (shooting the cue ball into a pocket or off the table)
3. Moving or touching any ball by means other than legal play.
4. Shooting an intentional jump shot over another ball by scooping the cue stick under the cue ball. (A jump shot executed by striking the cue ball above center is legal.)
5. Using the 8 ball first in a combination shot when the table is not open.

TABLE TENNIS:

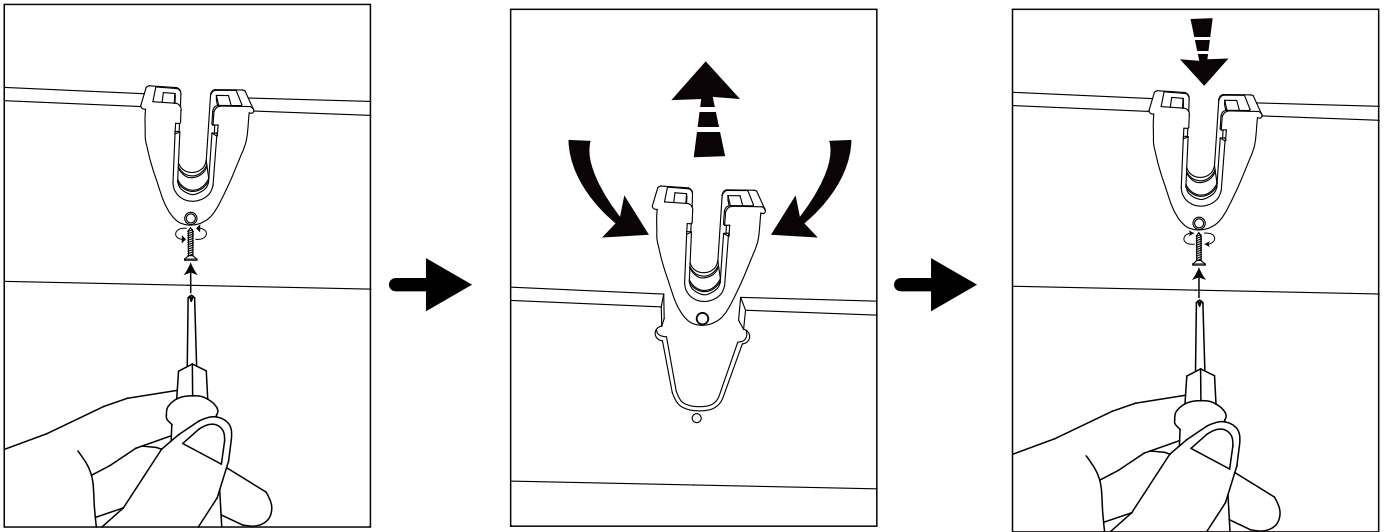
In singles, the server first makes a good service and then the receiver makes a good return. Thereafter, server and receiver alternately each make a good return. In doubles, the server first makes a good service and the receiver returns the ball. Then the partner of the server makes a good return, followed by the partner of the receiver returning the ball. Thereafter, each player alternately in that sequence makes a good return



Female Bushing Replacement

In the remote chance that the female rod bushing may need to be replaced , please follow these replacement directions.

1. Call our Customer Service Department at 1-888 on the front of your assembly manual and request the bushing replacement.
2. Locate and remove the Philips screw in the bushing , as per the diagram.
3. Pinch the bushing together and pull the bushing up and out of it's slot , per the diagram.
