LEG ASSEMBLY

STEP 1.

Attach Leg cabinet A (P4) to Leg cabinet B using Bolt (H2) and Washer (H3) as shown in FIG 1.1. Repeat this step to combine Leg cabinet (P6) and Leg cabinet (P7).

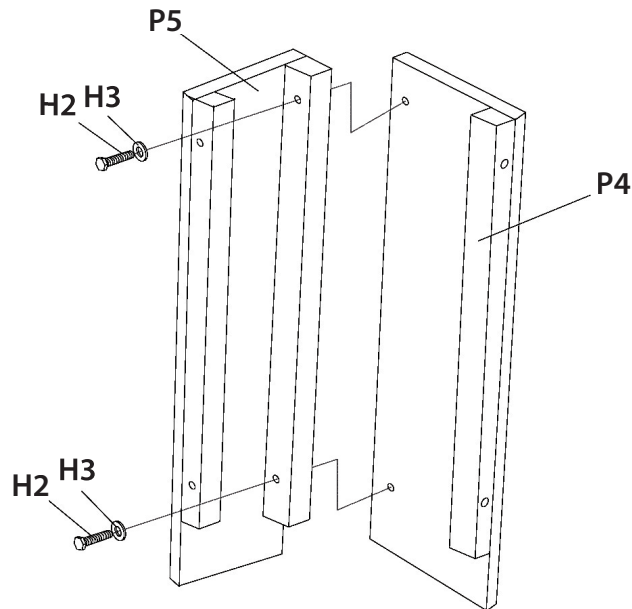

STEP 2.

Attach Leg cabinets (P6 and P7) to the Leg cabinets (P4 and P5) using Bolts (H2) and Washers (H3) as shown below in FIG 2.1. Once this step in the the leg assembly is complete, attach the Leg base (P8) using 4 (H4) screws.

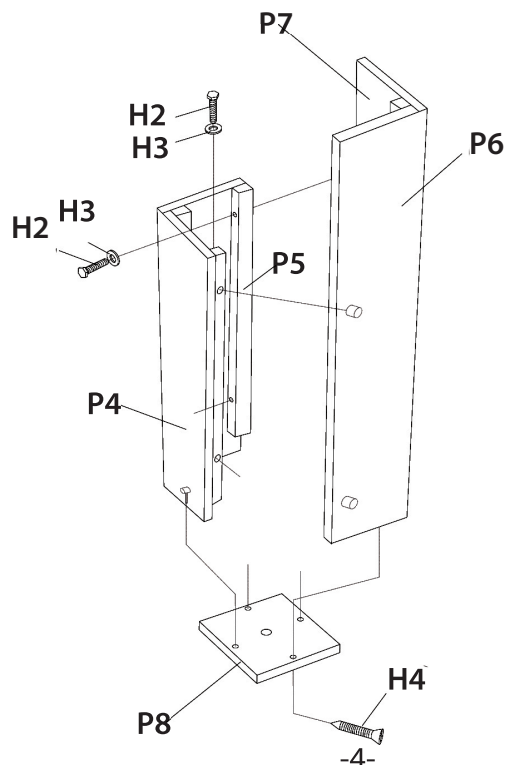

TABLE ASSEMBLY

STEP 3.

Attach each leg assembly to the Main cabinet (P1) using Bolts (H5) and Washers (H7) and Nuts (H6) while the table is in an up-side-down position as shown in Figure 3.1. Be sure to leave each leg loosely secured to allow easier installation of Aprons (P2 and P3) in Step 4. You should attach the Leg levelers (P9) at this time.

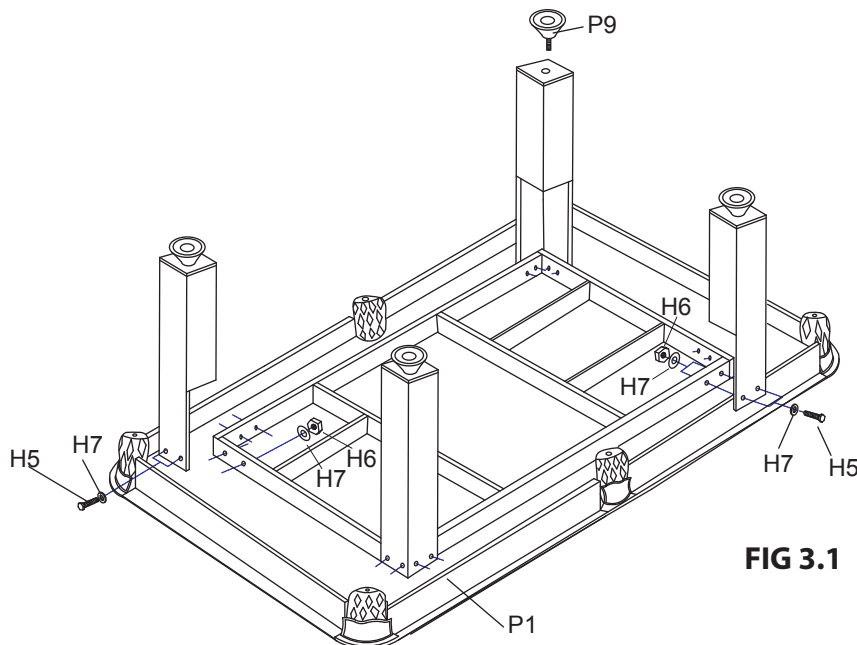

STEP 4.

Using Bolts (H1) and Washers (H3) you will now attach the Lower side aprons (P2) and the Lower end aprons (P3) to the Main cabinet as shown in Figure 4.1. Now go back and firmly secure all leg bolts to main cabinet. Once the aprons are attached and legs are secured, two or more adults should lift and turn the table over onto its leg levelers.

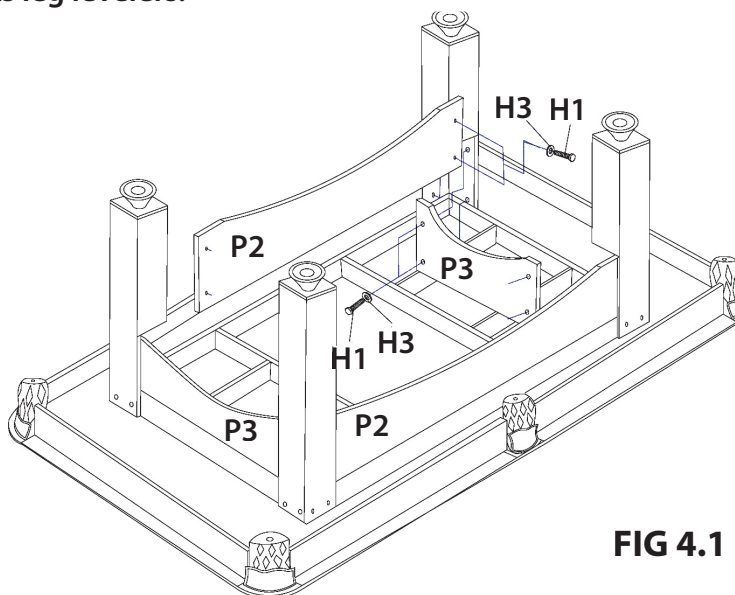

INSTRUCTIONS FOR LEVELING A POOL TABLE

When the table is complete and in its final location, we suggest that you make sure the table is level. Please refer to these instructions for leveling a pool table.

- Assemble pool table according to the instructions, making sure levelers are screwed in completely, then turning one full turn out.
- Any type of level would be sufficient to perform this procedure. However, a two-foot level is recommended.
- Before leveling, make sure level is placed on the playing surface, not the rails.
- Level the ends between the corner pockets. Place the level on the playing surface between the two corner pockets and adjust the levelers in or out to position the bubble in the middle of the level.
- Repeat the step above to the opposite corner pockets.
- Next, level the length of the table. Place the level next to the side pocket and adjust the levelers in or out to position the bubble in the middle of the level.
- Repeat the step above to the opposite length of the table.
- Recheck both short ends to ensure bubble is in the middle on the level.
- Depending on the surface the pool table sits, especially deep pile carpeting, the pool table needs to settle for 24 hours. Recheck the level on each side of the table after 24 hours.
- These same instructions may be followed to level hockey and soccer table play surfaces as well.
