Region/Vintage Notes

Our 2021 Highlands Black Granite is an outstanding example of the red blends produced and sourced from our estate vineyards in Paso Robles. Harvested from our Creston Highlands Vineyard in the northeastern section of the Creston District AVA, this red blend highlights the uniqueness of the area. Calcareous soils developed from marine deposits impact district minerality. The 2021 vintage is one of the best to come out of the central coast in the last few years.

Winemaker/Tasting Notes

This beautiful, approachable vintage, starting with the bright color and high fruit intensity. Our 2021 Highlands Black Granite greets the palate with notes of blackberry, raspberry, and plum with warm notes of spice, brown sugar, and vanilla. After a 10 months of barrel aging, this well-integrated wine has long, soft tannins and a smooth finish.

Sustainability

Sustainability is our top priority. Our Paso Robles and Monterey vineyards are certified sustainable by CSWA. At our Paso Robles winery, solar panels provide 100% of the needed electricity, and wastewater is effectively reclaimed and recycled for additional uses.

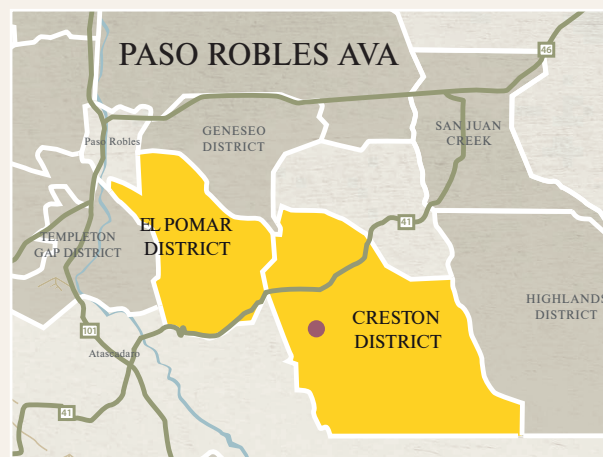
