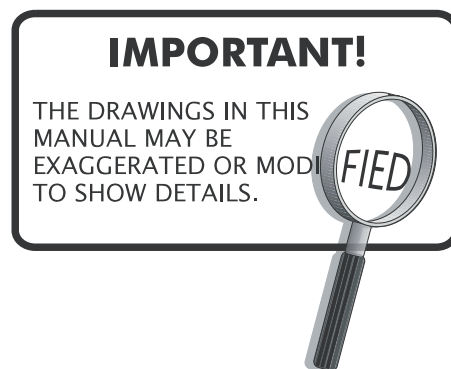

Tools Required (not provided):

Phillips Screwdriver
Furniture Polish and Cloth

An electric screwdriver is helpful in assembly. However, please set at low torque and use extreme caution with an electric screwdriver because you could overtighten the hardware and strip the screws.

Assembly Tips

Make sure you understand the following tips before you begin to assemble your hockey table.

1. Start all bolts by hand before tightening.
2. Some drawings or images in this manual may not look exactly like your product. Please read and understand the text before starting each assembly step.

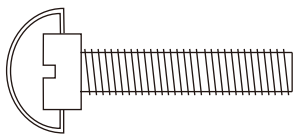

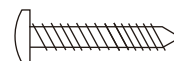

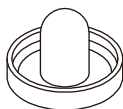

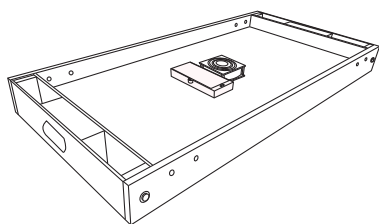

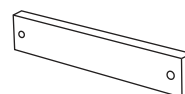

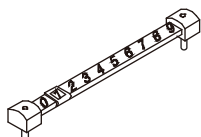

PARTS REQUIRED:

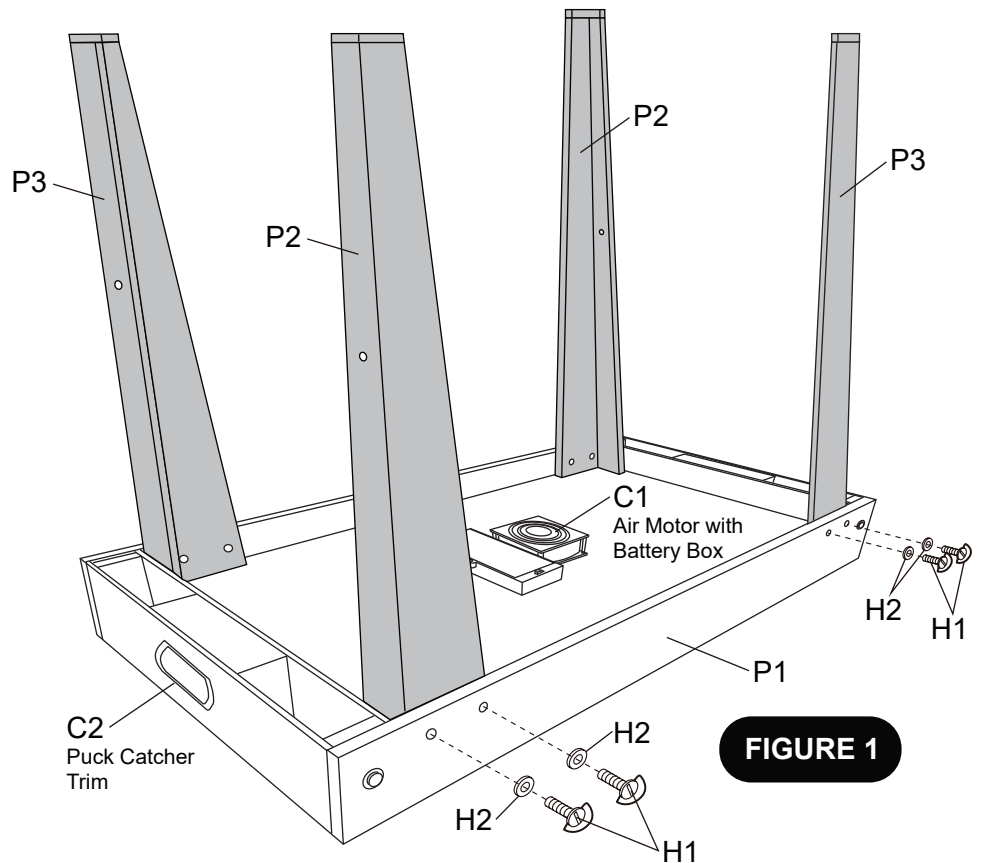
- 8 pcs - **H1** Wing Bolt
- 8 pcs - **H2** Flat Washer
- 1 pc - **P1** Air Hockey Cabinet
- 2 pcs - **P2** Left Leg
- 2 pcs - **P3** Right Leg

STEP 1:

Leave **P1** Air Hockey Table Cabinet face down in carton to assemble.

Install **P2** Left Legs and **P3** Right Legs onto **P1** Air Hockey Cabinet using **H1** Wing Bolts and **H2** Flat Washers as shown in **FIGURE 1**.

Do not tighten H1 Bolts during this step.



PARTS REQUIRED:

- 4 pcs - **H1** Wing Bolt
- 4 pcs - **H2** Flat Washer
- 2 pcs - **P4** End Leg Panel
- 6 pcs - **1.5V AA** Batteries (not provided)

STEP 2:

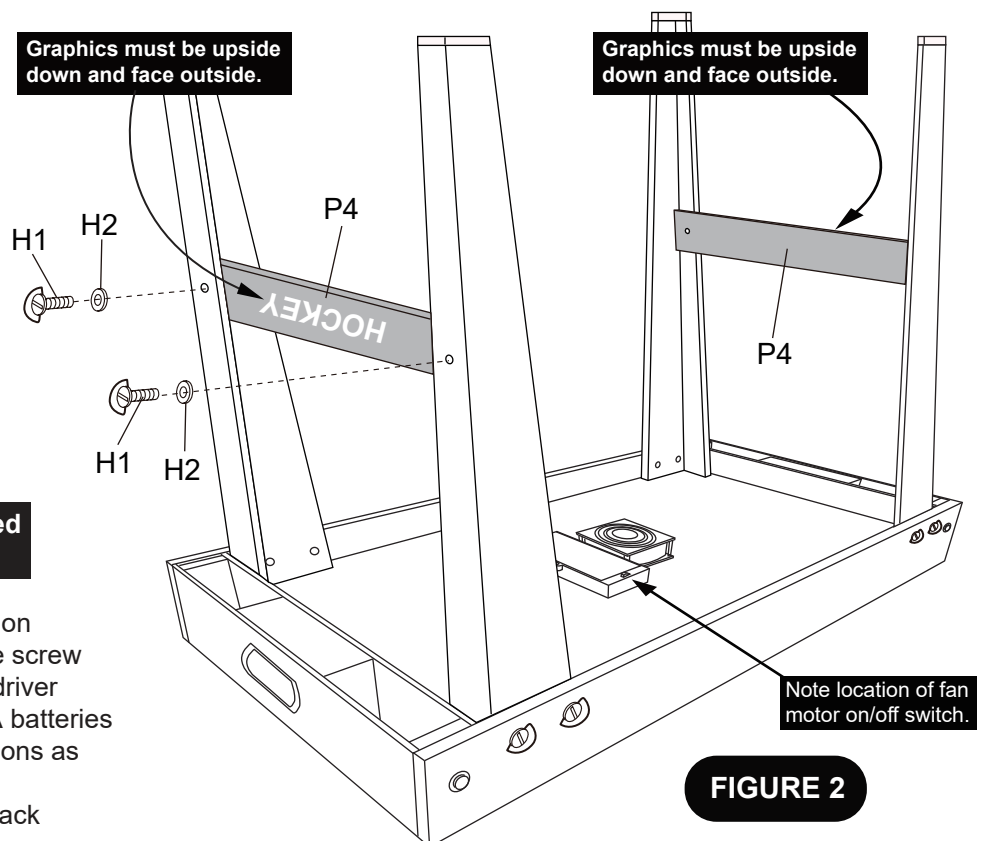
Install **P4** End Leg Panels using **H1** Wing Bolts and **H2** Flat Washers as shown in **FIGURE 2**.

Tighten all H1 Bolts at this time from STEP 1.

All H1 Wing Bolts should be tightened with a screwdriver (not provided).

Next, Open battery compartment cover on the underside of the table by turning the screw counter-clockwise using Phillips Screwdriver (not provided). Install 6 pieces 1.5V AA batteries (not provided) in the proper (-) (+) positions as indicated inside battery compartment. Replace the cover and turn the screw back clockwise to secure it into place.

See "FIRST TIME BATTERY INSTALLATION AND NOTICE", before installing batteries, located on page 7.



WARNING:

THIS STEP REQUIRES TWO ADULTS.
VERY CAREFULLY TURN THE TABLE OVER AND SET IT ON ITS LEGS. BE CAREFUL, THE TABLE IS HEAVY.

PARTS REQUIRED:

- 2 pcs - **P5** Manual Scorer
- 4 pcs - **H3** Phillips Round Head Screw

STEP 3:

Install **P5** Manual Scorer onto **P1** Air Hockey Cabinet using pre-drilled holes and using the **H3** Phillips Round Head Screw as shown in **FIGURE 3**.

Lastly, Turn the power switch ON from battery compartment (underneath table) to play your hockey table.

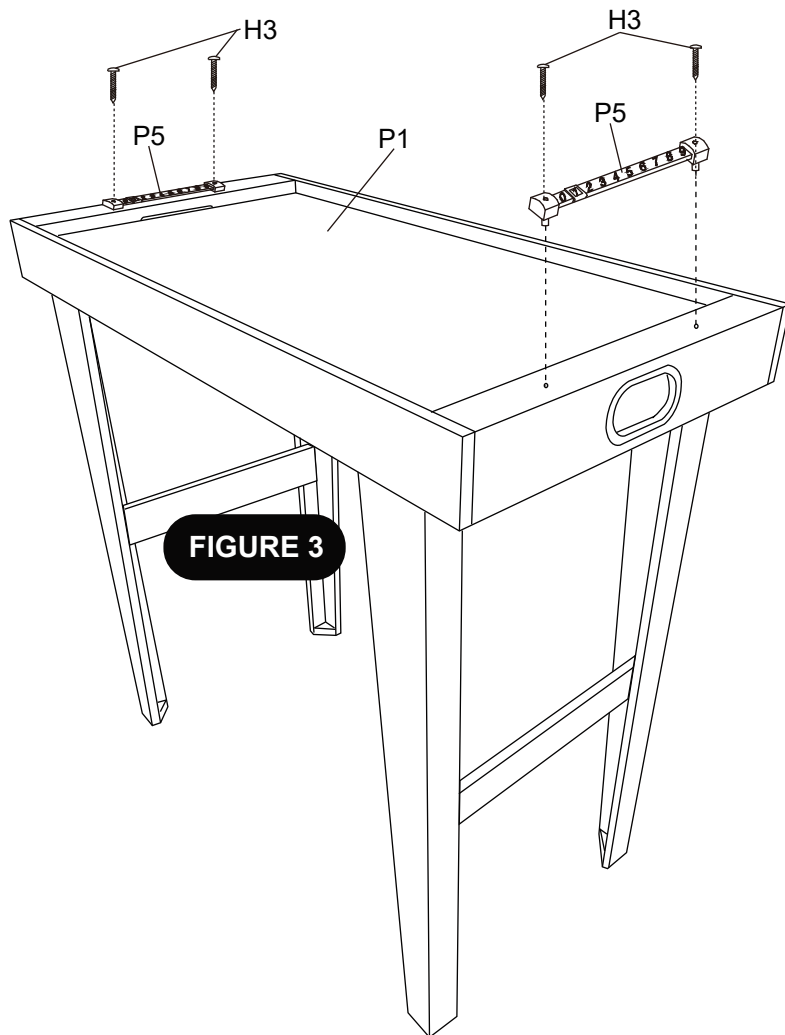

FOR TABLE TOP PLAY:

Carefully remove **H1** Wing Bolts and **H2** Flat Washers as shown in **FIGURE 4**.

NOTE: Do not remove this Allen Head Bolt.

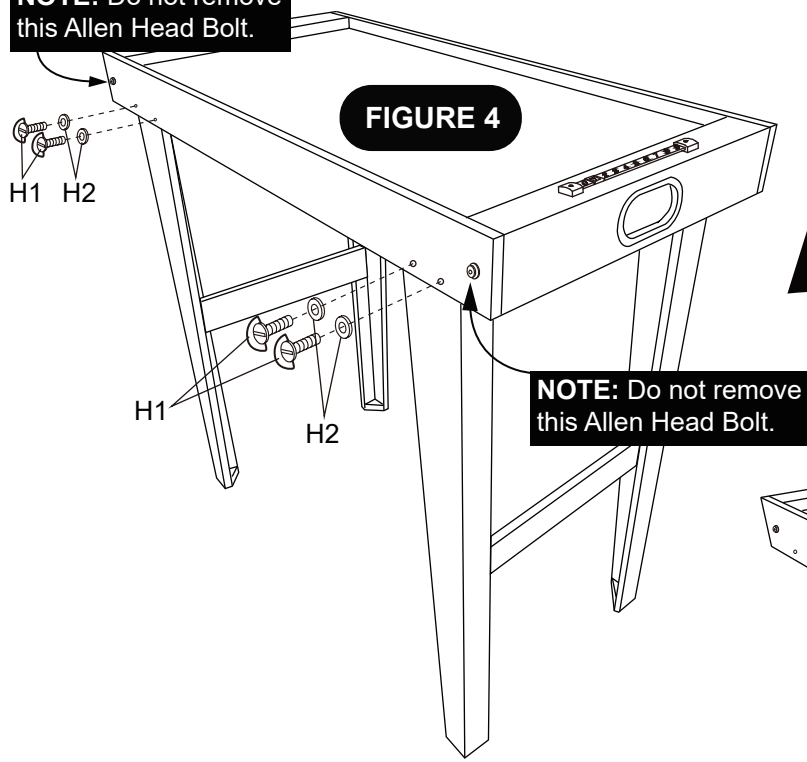
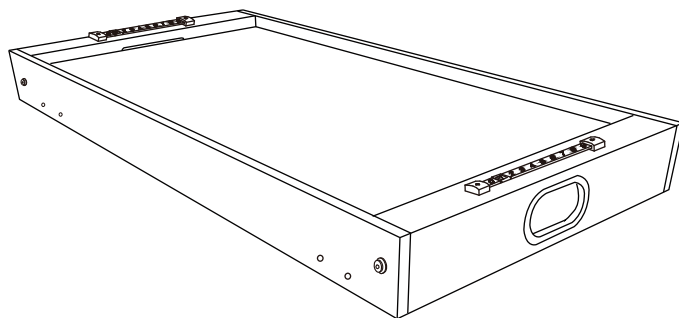

Congratulations! You have now assembled your hockey table. Please note the Care and Use instructions below to insure many years of trouble free use of your hockey table.

CARE AND USE OF YOUR HOCKEY TABLE

1. For long life and best play from your air hockey table, apply spray furniture polish to clean cloth and wipe down the playfield with air motor running to make the pucks slide faster before first play and frequently thereafter.
2. This product is intended for **INDOOR** use only.
3. **DO NOT** operate the motor if the battery compartment is damaged in any way.
4. **DO NOT** sit, climb or lean on the table.
5. **DO NOT** drag the table when moving it. This will damage the legs.
6. **DO NOT** set drinks on the table.

First Time Battery Installation:

Locate battery compartment for this product .

Use alkaline batteries for maximum performance .

Using a small Phillips head screwdriver – loosen and remove the battery compartment cover screw(s).

Remove battery compartment cover .

Install new batteries only after reading the “ Battery Information NOTICE“ !

Replace compartment cover and secure cover with the cover screw . Do not over tighten and strip out the screw .

IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

Please retain this information for future reference. Batteries must be installed / replaced by an adult .

Notice:

1. Remove and replace batteries when the electrical features of this product work slowly or are not functional .
2. Do not mix old and new batteries .
3. Do not mix different types of batteries : Alkaline , Standard (Carbon-Zinc) , or rechargeable (Nickel-Cadmium batteries) .
4. Use Alkaline Batteries for maximum performance .
5. Do not use damaged batteries .
6. Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended.
