WINEMAKER NOTES

The 2023 vintage for Paso Robles reds is proving to be a standout with rich dark notes, plenty of tannins, and excellent complexity. Harvest came about three weeks later because of a cool start, and late September had a few warm weekends that pushed things along, culminating in an outstanding vintage quality.

TASTING NOTES

Luscious concentrated notes of dark riparian fruits and plum are supported by hints of cedar cigar box, black olive, and baking spice. A rich velvety mouthfeel with supple tannins. Pairs well with baked feta and plum tomatoes drizzled with olive oil and served over pasta.
