TXAKOLI BLANCO 2025



Baskoli combines the best of classic and modern winemaking, produced at an exceptional winery equipped with state-of-the-art technology and showcasing Txakoli's terroir, culture, and history in a glass. Txakoli Blanco is a traditional wine made from the Hondarrabi Zuri grape, grown on estate vineyards in Hondarribia, Spain.

The winery's 17-hectare, approximately 42-acre vineyard is located in the area surrounding the winery itself, at the foothills of Jaizkibel Mountain. Nestled on a south-facing slope, it is protected from the wind and moisture of the nearby Cantabrian Sea, allowing the vineyard to enjoy excellent sunshine. The vineyard utilizes a double Guyot training system on trellised vines, and the plot features clay-like soil with fragments of calcareous marlstones and limestone.

The 2025 harvest was shaped by a dynamic growing season, beginning with frequent rainfall and wind in the spring. Continued humidity through the summer, followed by warmer temperatures in mid-August, encouraged steady ripening and helped bring the fruit to ideal maturity. The grapes were harvested at optimal ripeness, resulting in a vintage with balanced acidity, gentle structure, and expressive character.

Clean and bright, the wine presents a pale-yellow hue with emerald glints. When poured, delicate, tiny carbonation bubbles emerge, a signature characteristic of Txakoli. The nose is vibrant and expressive, offering intense aromas of white pear and crisp apple, elevated by natural effervescence. On the palate, the wine is fresh and lively, with well-integrated acidity and subtle citrus and mint notes. A long, aromatic finish completes this elegant expression of the region.
