

2021 HIGHLANDS 41 MONTEREY PINOT NOIR



Region/Vintage Notes

The 2021 Highlands 41 Pinot Noir is grown in the heart of Monterey County, from 100% estate-owned fruit. Our wine is crafted to bring out the purest expression of Pinot Noir. This Pinot Noir is one of the best vintages in recent years due to a smooth harvest following a cool, long growing season. The maritime layer from the coastline provided an extended coolness throughout the summer, resulting in high acids and low sugars, balancing out when the marine layer moved off the coast in September.

Winemaker/Tasting Notes

This Pinot Noir was aged in 10% new French oak barrels and 90% neutral oak barrels. The nose is greeted with scents of black pepper, raspberry, and spice, followed by a palate of black cherry, strawberry jam, and notes of anise. Similar characteristics fill the mouth with rich, silky texture that is framed by soft tannins.

Sustainability

Sustainability is our top priority. Our Paso Robles and Monterey vineyards are certified sustainable by CSWA. At our Paso Robles winery, solar panels provide 100% of the needed electricity, and wastewater is effectively reclaimed and recycled for additional uses.
