ETNA BIANCO 2024



For over 150 years, the Pennisi family has been cultivating the soils of Mount Etna. The vineyards, located in the region of Castiglione di Sicilia, an area where the cultivation of the vine has ancient origins. The vineyards are perfectly situated along the side of the Mount Etna volcano, where the mineral-rich soil allows the vines to slowly grow and are kissed by the hot Sicilian sun. These conditions lead to the growth of superb grapes which produce the finest wines.

Every bottle tells a rich story of the vineyards, the harvests, the fatigue, and the hands dirtied with soil and determination. The winery is family run, passed down through generations. The vines are cultivated following the traditional techniques, that respect the environment and the natural development of the plants and fruits.

The honey hued Etneide Etna Bianco is produced with Carricante and Catarratto grapes. This wine has a delicate, vibrant, and youthful taste. With its golden yellow color, Etna Bianco has hints of jasmine flowers, white-fleshed fruit like sbergia (a typical Sicilian variety of nectarine peach) and intense volcanic minerality due to the soils.

The 2024 harvest began slightly earlier than usual following a warm winter and relatively dry spring. Steady summer heat encouraged even, consistent ripening across the vineyard, while light seasonal rains in the Etna region helped the vines restore their water balance and maintain a healthy crop. The resulting wines are exceptional, showcasing vibrant aromatics and a beautifully balanced finish.
