The vineyards are divided into five farms located in diverse and desirable positions both in terms of soil type and exposure. Clay, iron rich, marled and white limestone rock soils provide an ample range of land for cultivation. Nebbiolo and Pinot Noir thrive on high altitude clay-limestone soils. Chardonnay prefers slightly looser soil which help in giving elegance and savory notes to the wine.

The vineyards are situated in a variety of desirable locations, each with distinct soil types and exposures, creating a rich tapestry of land for cultivation. The grapes thrive in slightly looser soil, which imparts elegance and savory notes to the wine. Cuvage represents a modern take on the ancient sparkling wine tradition that originated in Piedmont in 1895. This expression harmonizes history, innovation, and technology, producing Cuvage using the Traditional Method.
