For over 150 years the Pennisi family has been cultivating the soils of Mount Etna, a volcano on the island of Sicily. The vineyards are located in the area of Castiglione di Sicilia, where the cultivation of the vine has ancient origins. At the side of the Mount Etna volcano, the mineral-rich soil allows the vines to slowly grow, kissed by the hot Sicilian sun. These conditions enhance the growth of superb grapes where we obtain our finest wines.

SICILY, ITALY

Sicily enjoys a warm Mediterranean climate with plenty of sunshine and heat. The red and white wines produced here are fresh and have high acidity. The mineral-rich soil supports slow vine growth and winds play a crucial role, with the Scirocco and Maestrale winds contributing to the vitality of many vineyards. Carricante, Catarratto, and Nerello Mascalese varietals thrive at the island's higher altitudes, resulting in wines with elevated aromas, fresh fruit flavors, lower alcohol content, and higher acidity.

Beyond every bottle there is a long story that tells about the vineyards and harvests, fatigue and hands dirtied with soil and determination. The winery is family run, passed through generations.
