TXAKOLI ROSÉ 2025



Baskoli combines the best of classic and modern winemaking, produced at an exceptional winery equipped with state-of-the-art technology, showcasing Txakoli's terroir, culture, and history in every glass. Txakoli Blanco is a traditional wine made from the Hondarrabi Zuri grape, grown on estate vineyards in Hondarribia, Spain.

Situated near the winery, the vineyard spans 17 hectares, approximately 42 acres, at the base of Jaizkibel Mountain. Facing south, it is shielded from the wind and moisture of the nearby Cantabrian Sea, ensuring optimal sunlight exposure. The vineyard utilizes a double Guyot training system on trellised vines, thriving in clay-like soil derived from calcareous marlstone with limestone fragments.

The 2025 harvest was shaped by a dynamic growing season, beginning with frequent rainfall and wind in the spring. Continued humidity through the summer, followed by warmer temperatures in mid-August, encouraged steady ripening and helped bring the fruit to ideal maturity. The grapes were harvested at optimal ripeness, resulting in a vintage with balanced acidity, gentle structure, and expressive character.

Baskoli Txakoli Rosé showcases a stunning pink hue with enticing aromas of fresh strawberries, pomegranate, and green apples. Subtle citrus notes and delicate herbal nuances add layers of complexity. On the palate, the wine is crisp and refreshing, with lively acidity that enhances its minerality. A long, aromatic finish completes this elegant and expressive vintage.
