Our family-owned winery has been producing wines for over 1000 years, including 120 vintages of exceptional, Italian wine. Ponte Vecchio is a wine that tells a story of history, terroir and after dinner walks along the 'old bridge' in Florence, Italy. The heart of the winery is in Tuscany, but family relationships allow our winemaking team to craft beautiful, varietal-driven wines from all over Italy.

THE WINEMAKING

Our wines blend the beauty of tradition with modern innovation that allows us to deliver excellence in the bottle.

Our winery is located between Florence and Pisa, with over 250 hectares of vineyards, reflecting the heart of Tuscan. We have a strong commitment to sustainability in both the vineyard and winery.

Named for the iconic 'Ponte Vecchio' bridge, which majestically arches over the Arno River and connects two tales of Florence. Through history it has and currently does host vendors selling their tokens (especially gold and jewelry) since set was built in 1345. It was the only bridge not destroyed in World War II and was spared for its beauty!

Like the famous three segmental arches, Ponte Vecchio Wines offers three dynamic wines.
