Santo was inspired by the local village of in the heart of the region famous for Moscato d'Asti, Santo Stefano Belbo. It represents the best expression of grapes from Piedmont, Italy. Located in the Northwest corner of 'the boot', Piedmont is known for many special DOCG wines, including Moscato d'Asti, Barbaresco and Barolo. This region holds the highest amount DOCG classifications, the most prestigious and rigorous quality standards in Italian wine. These wines were chosen for the Santo brand because of the terroir, which cultivates beautiful, complex, refined and sophisticated flavors and styles.



All of the grapes that go into Santo are chosen both through the vineyard and winery sorting process and are held to high standards. Warm sunny days and a steep slope allow them to fully ripen, creating beautiful structure and acidity. The wines are all produced in cold stainless steel fermenters and bottled at peak freshness. The wines are youthful and meant to drink among family and friends, often shared as an aperitivo or with dessert—due to their bright and light style.
