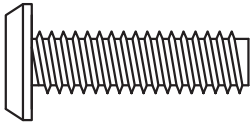
ASSEMBLY TIPS

Make sure you understand the following tips before you begin to assemble your game table.

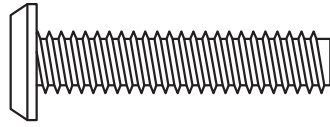
1. Start all bolts by hand before tightening.
2. An electric screwdriver is helpful in assembly. However, please set at low torque and use extreme caution with an electric screwdriver because you could overtighten the hardware and strip the screws.
3. Some drawings or images in this manual may not look exactly like your product. Please read and understand the text before starting each assembly step.
4. Assembly can be made both simpler and less timely by first unpacking all parts, and matching and organizing them to the Parts Identifier. This will greatly help you become familiar with the parts before and during assembly.
5. Some of this assembly can be made easier – by placing the parts and building the assembly on a pair of saw horses. A table can be used also as long as the top is well protected from any scratches that could occur. The table or saw horses would need to be structurally strong enough to support this weight.

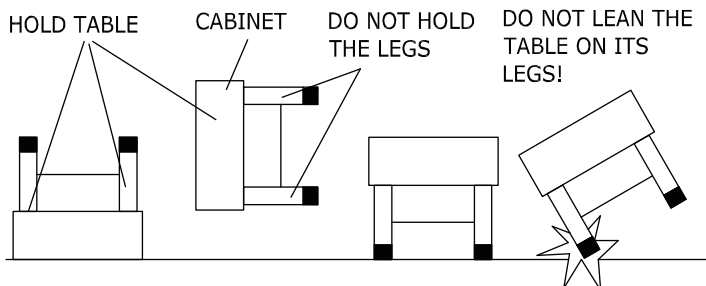
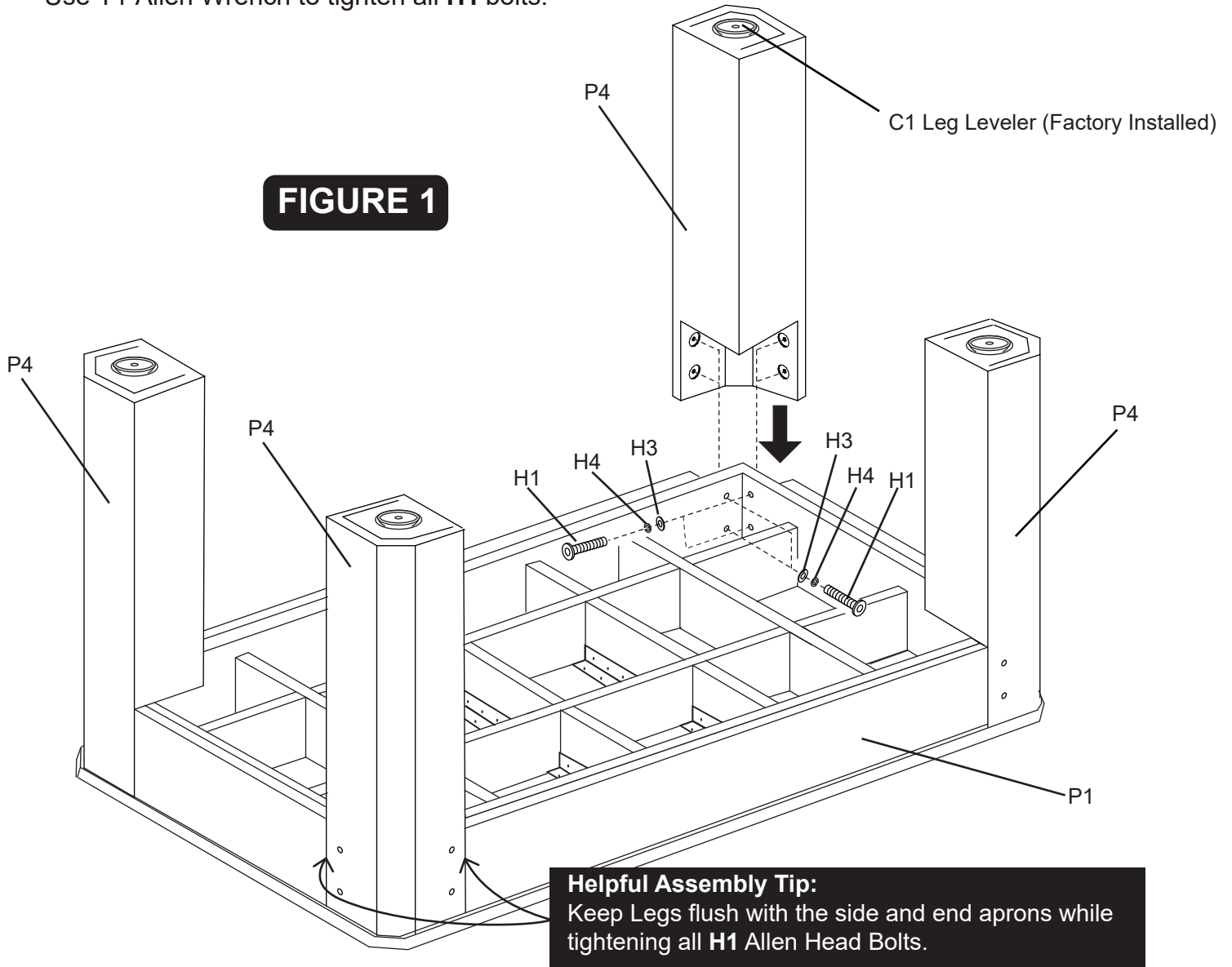
1pc - **P1** Main Table Cabinet

STEP 1:

Attach **P4** Legs onto the Side Aprons and the End Aprons using **H1** Bolts, **H4** Lock Washers and **H3** Flat Washers as shown in **FIGURE 1**.

Use T1 Allen Wrench to tighten all **H1** bolts.

CAUTION:

Six strong adults are recommended to flip the table as shown.

1. Grab the table on the ground.
2. Turn the table over.
3. Place it on all four legs at the same time onto the floor.

PARTS REQUIRED

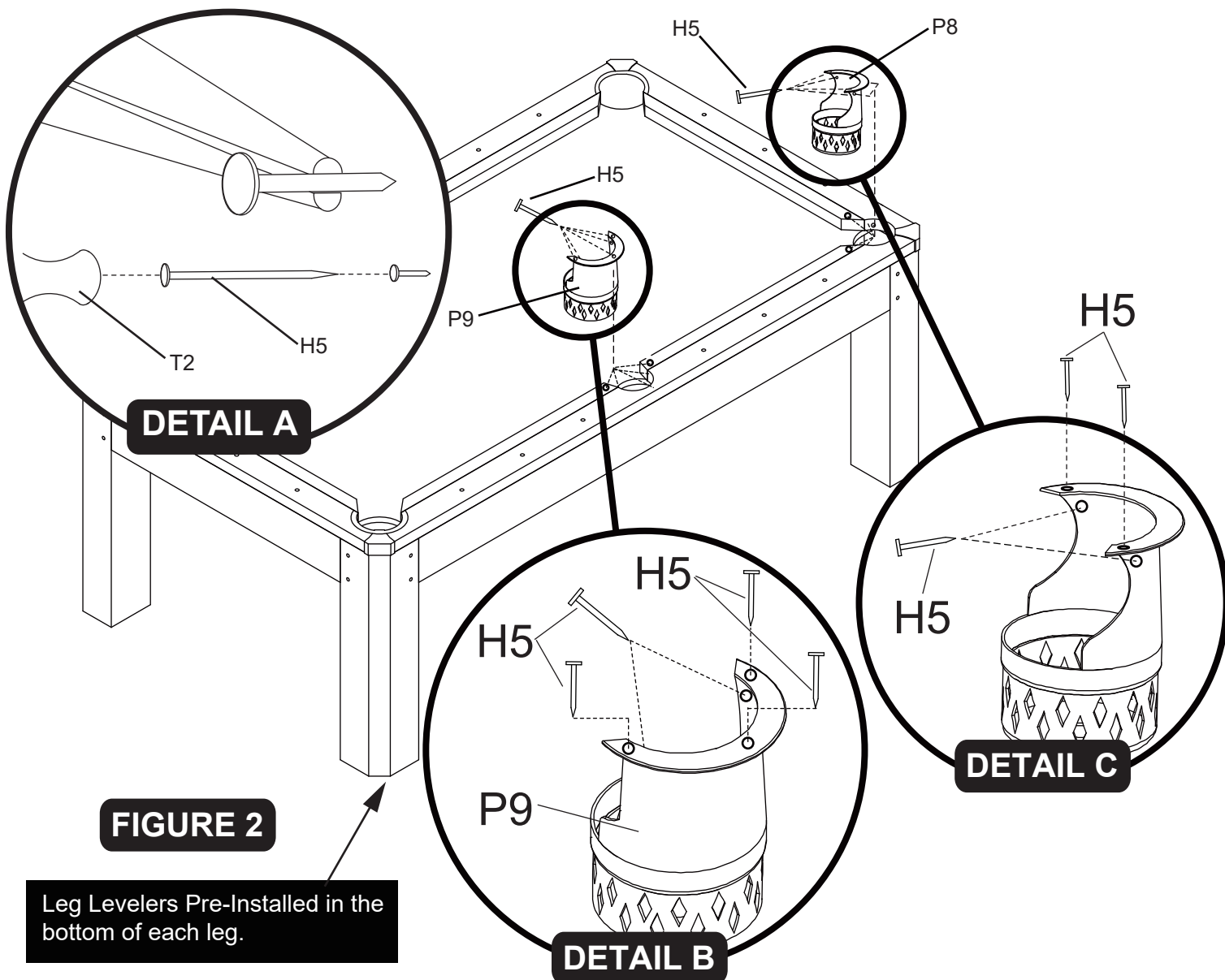
4pcs - **P8** Corner Pocket
2pcs - **P9** Middle Side Pocket

26pcs - **H5** Nails
1pc - **T2** Small Hammer

STEP 2:

Insert the **P8** Corner Pockets into each of the corner holes by using four **H5** Nails and **T2** Small Hammer. Insert the **P9** Middle Side Pockets into each of the middle holes by using five **H5** Nails. Hold nails with a pair of Needle Nose Pliers and tap them into the plastic pocket with the small hammer as shown in **DETAIL A & B & C, FIGURE 2**.

Place nails about 1/2 inch below the top of pocket so the balls will not hit the heads of the nails and get chipped. Once nails have been started into plastic pocket, hammer them in until the heads are flush with the plastic pocket. Use the small hammer to slightly countersink the nail heads.

1pc - **P2** A Table Tennis Top With Guide Pins

1pc - **P3** B Table Tennis Top With Guide Pin Holes

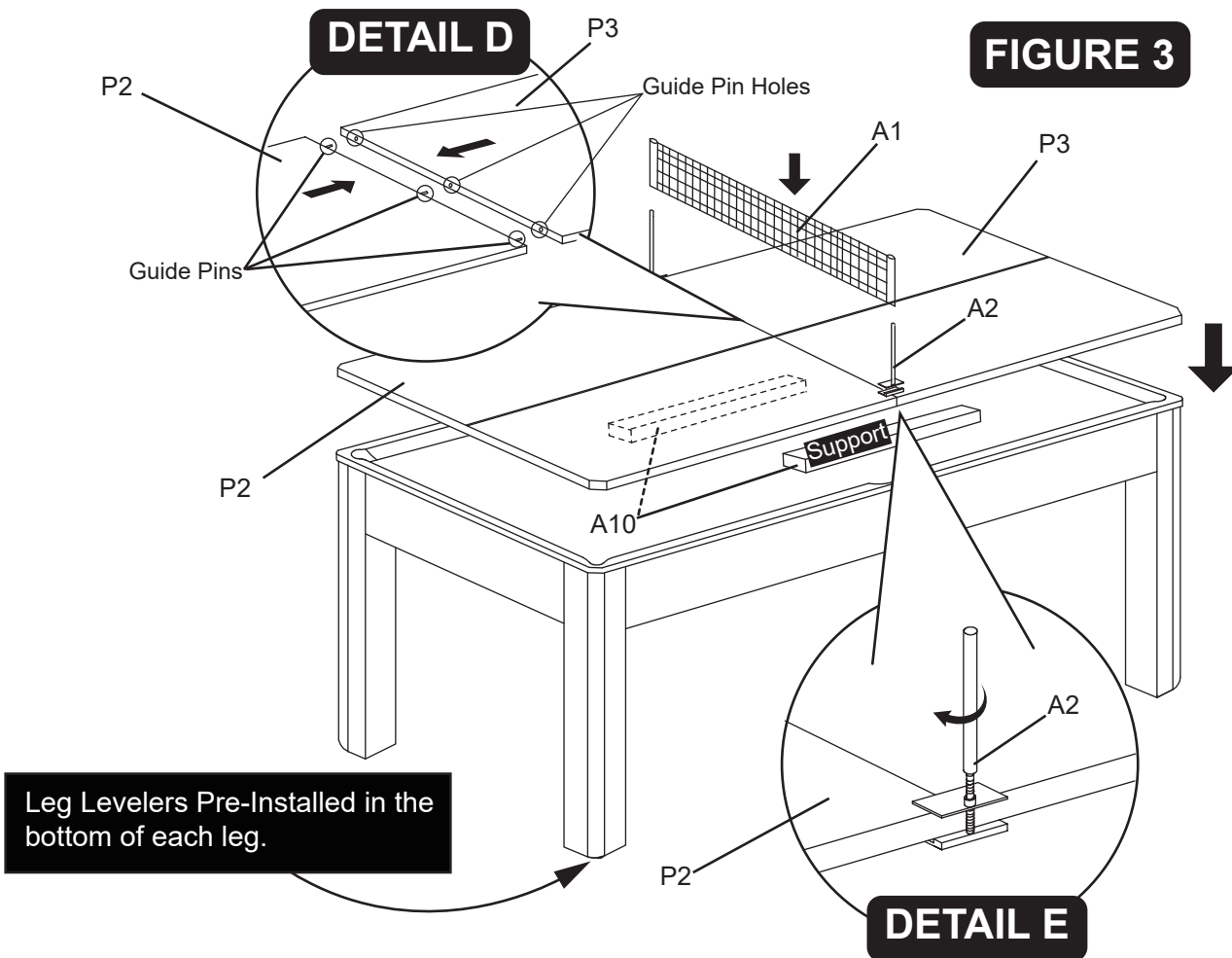

STEP 3:

Using the guide pins carefully connect the **P2** A Table Tennis Top With Guide Pins to **P3** B Table Tennis Top With Guide Pin Holes as shown in **DETAIL D**. Place **A10** Table Tennis Playfield Supports between Table Tennis top and Billiard table. Install **A1** Table Tennis Net by adjusting **A2** Net Post as shown in **DETAIL E** & **FIGURE 3**.

16pcs - **H2** Allen Head Bolt

8pcs - **H7** Round Head Screw

STEP 4:

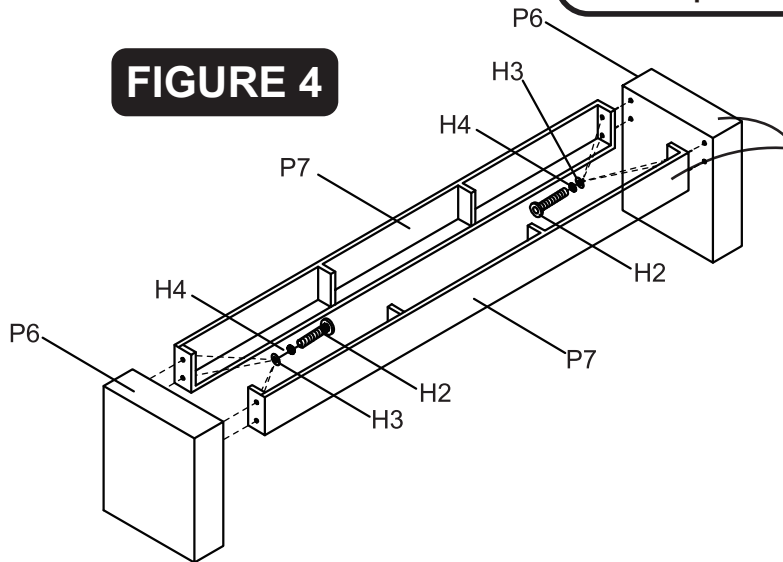
Attach **P6** Bench Legs to **P7** Bench Supports using **H2** Allen Head Bolt, **H3** Flat Washer and **H4** Lock Washers as shown in **FIGURE 4**.

Tighten all **H2** Allen Head Bolts.

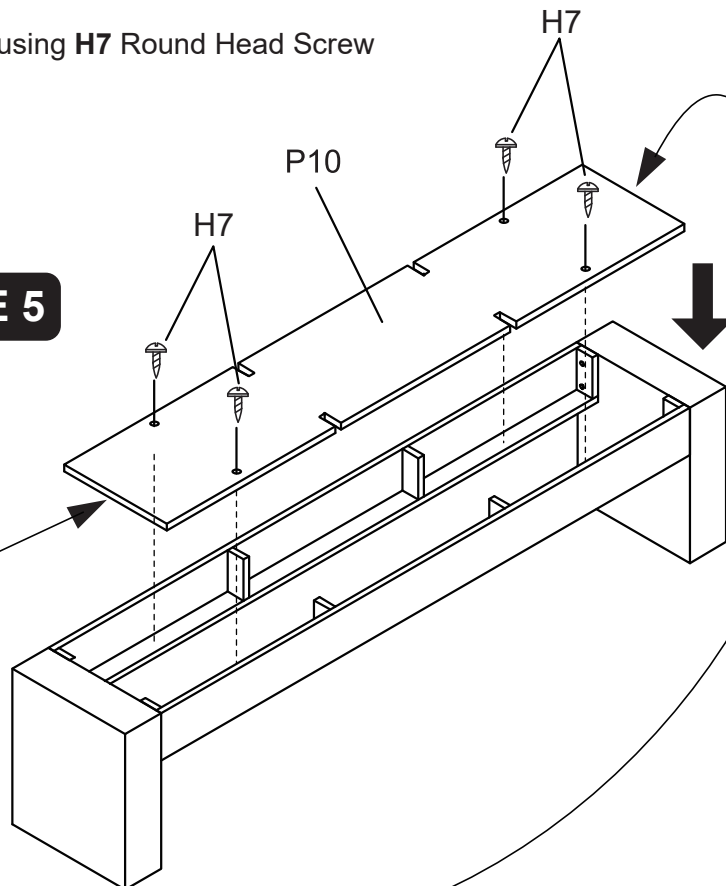
Keep **P7** Bench Supports flush with the edges of the **P6** Bench Legs.

STEP 5:

Attach **P10** Storage Board to the frame using **H7** Round Head Screw as shown in **FIGURE 5**.

Tighten all **H7** Round Head Screw.

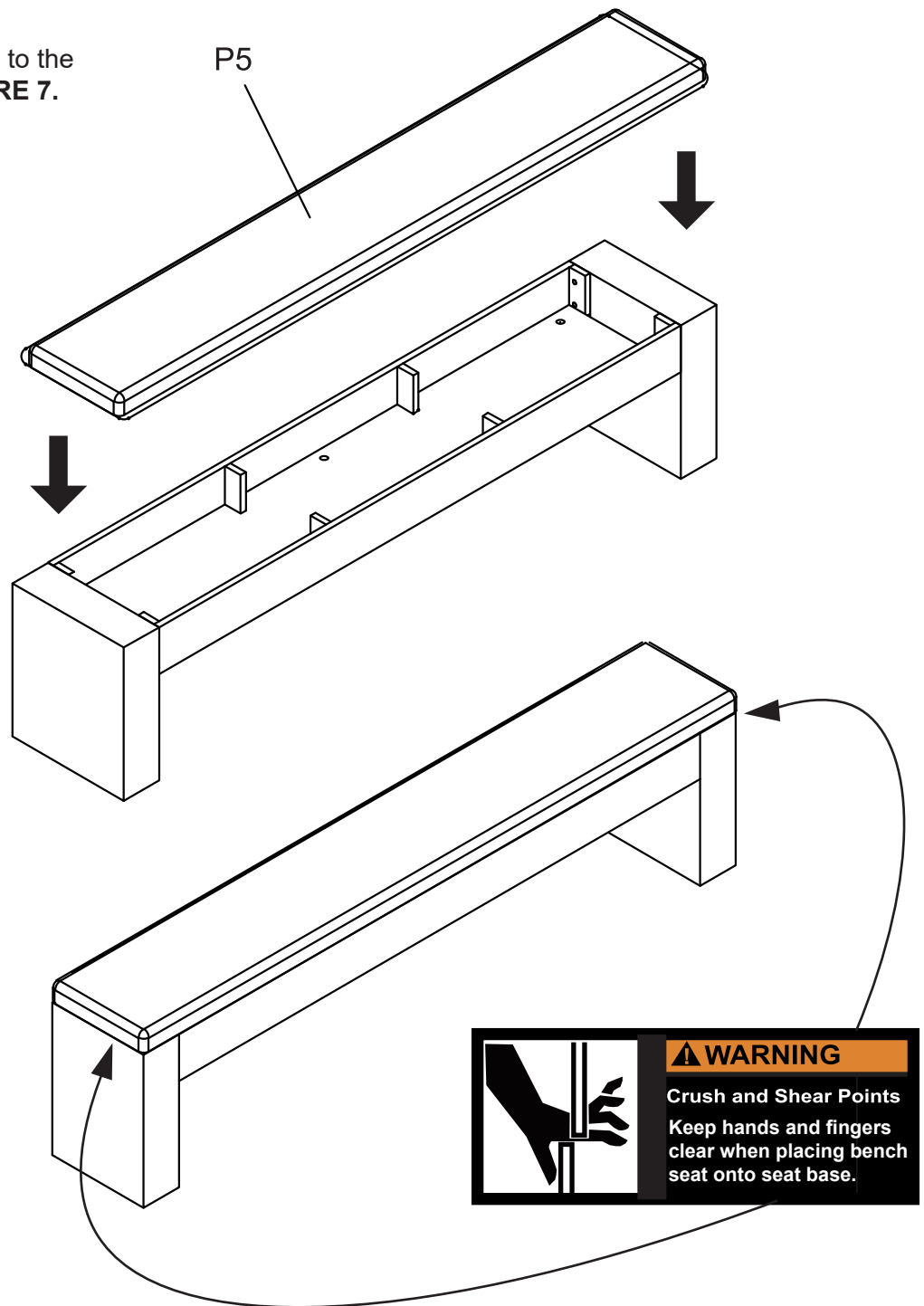

Place the P5 Bench Seat onto to the leg caninet as shown in **FIGURE 7**.



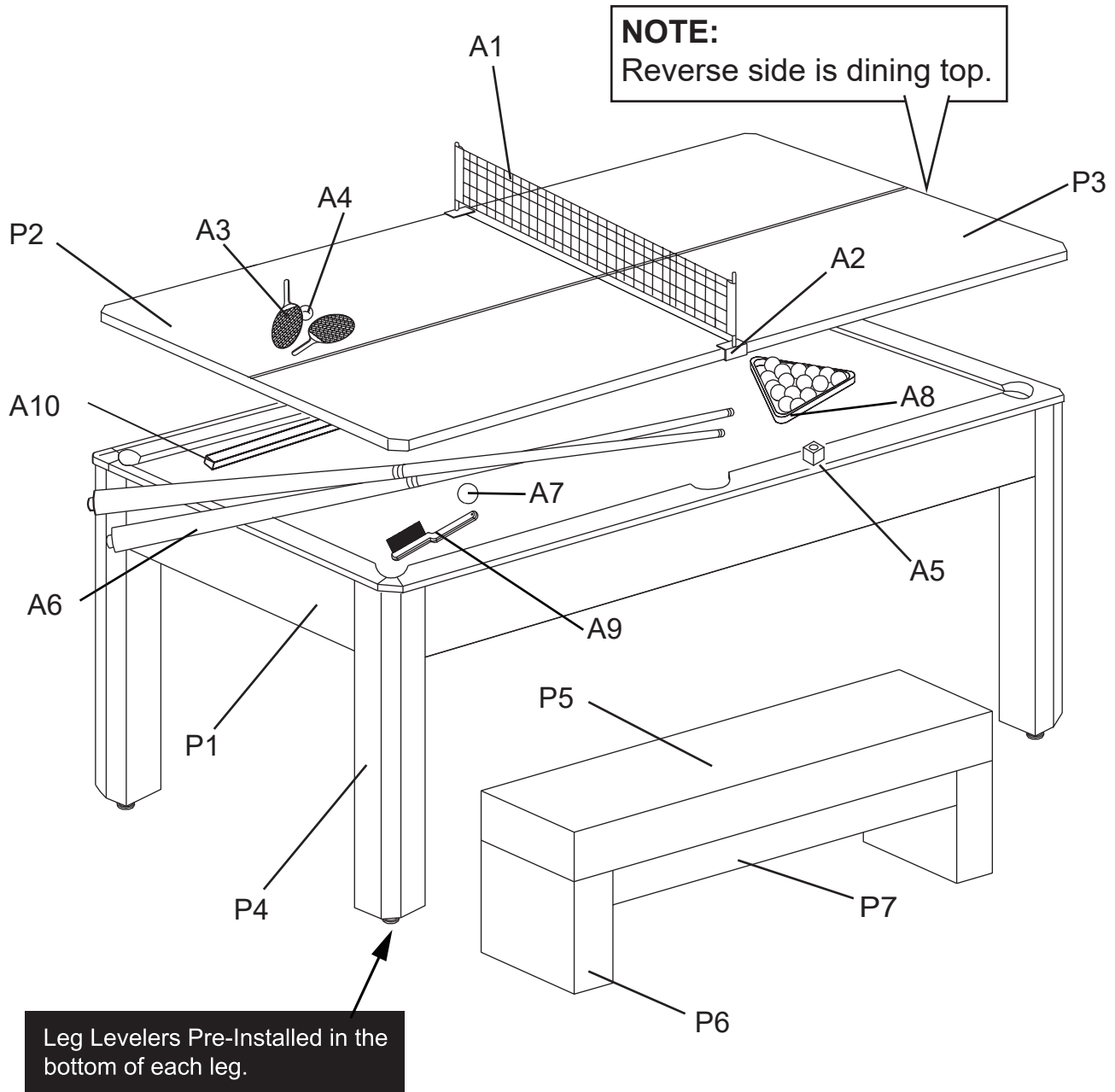

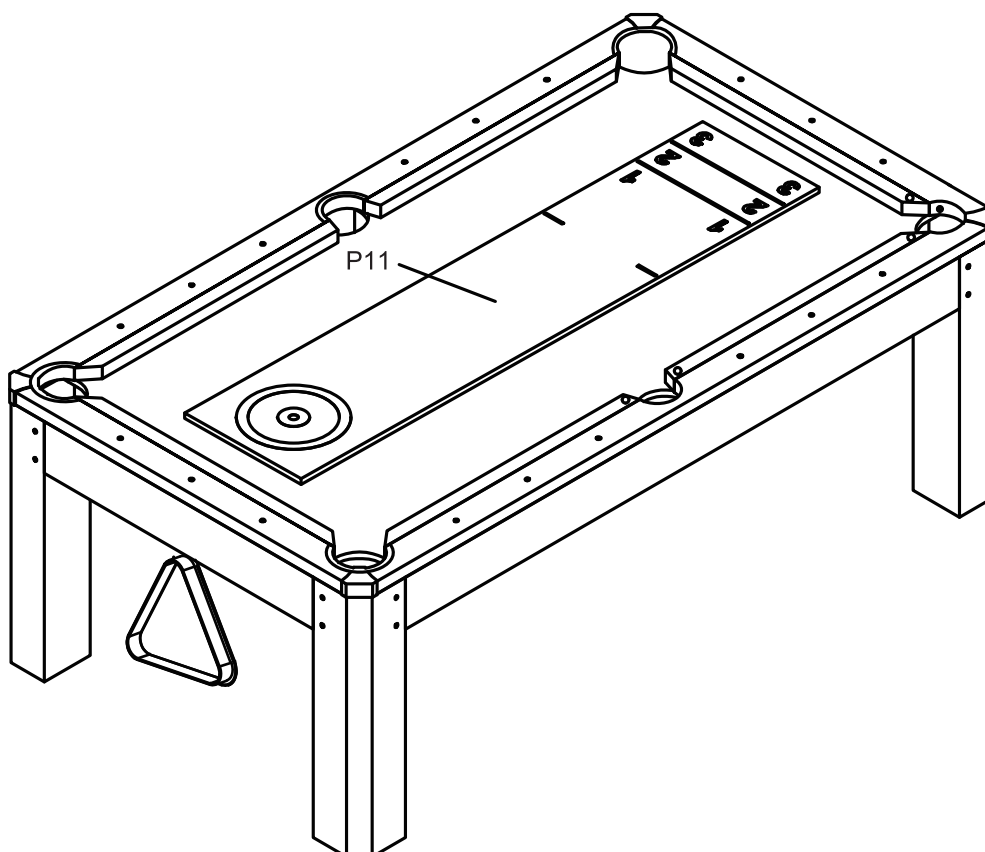

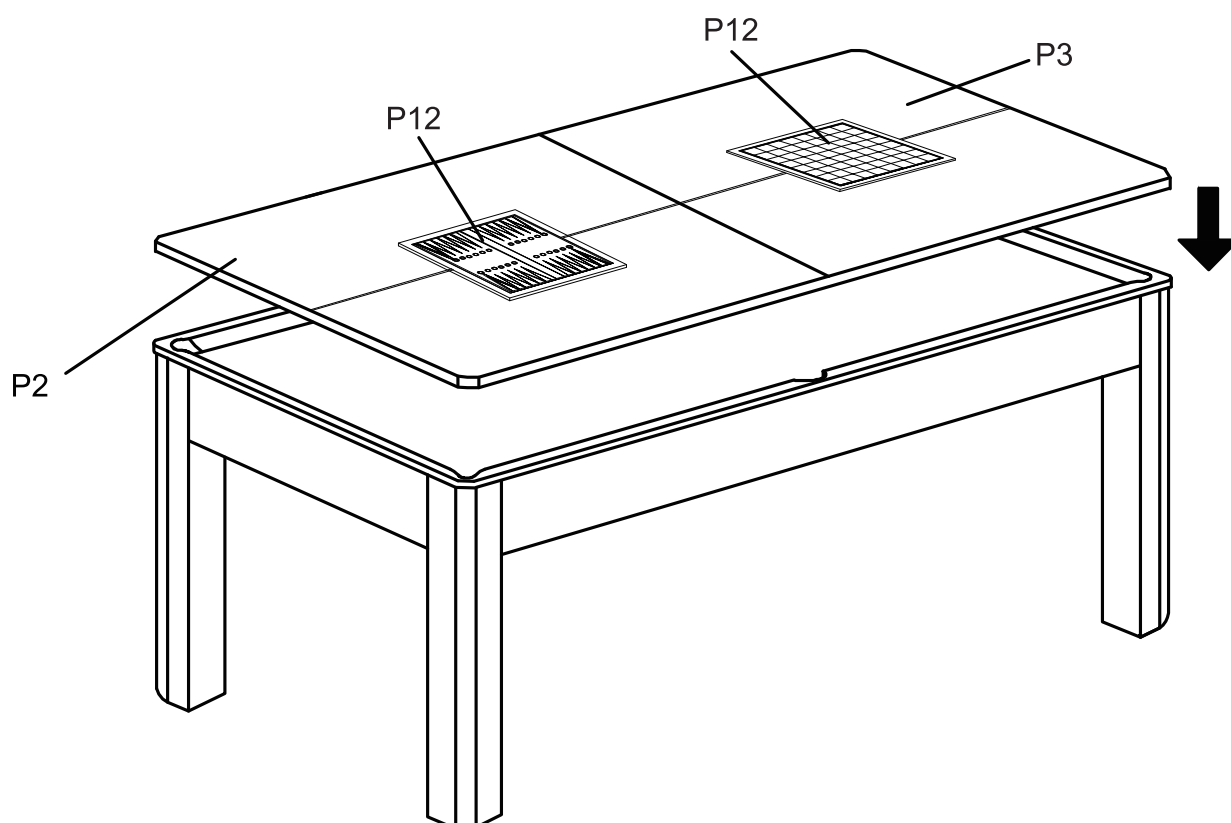
SHUFFLEBOARD / CURLING

CARE AND USE FOR YOUR TABLE

1. Use spray furniture polish to clean all exterior surfaces of your pool table.
2. Use the table brush provided to clean the cloth on the table.
3. Use only a slightly damp soft cloth to clean the table tennis top (do not use Furniture Polish)
4. This product is intended for **INDOOR** use only .
5. **DO NOT** sit, climb or lean on the table.
6. **DO NOT** drag the table when moving it. This will damage the legs.
7. **DO NOT** set drinks on the table.
8. The purchase of a pool table cover will both protect and help keep clean the entire top of the pool table.
9. Lastly, using a carpenters level and the leg levelers, level table for best play.
